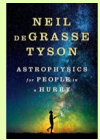

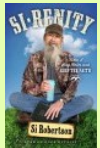

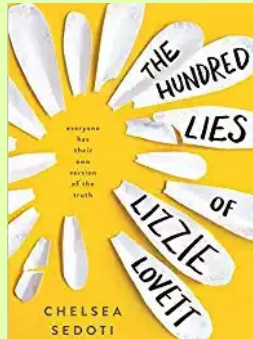
Killing England by Bill O'Reilly

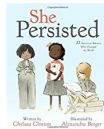


The Hundred Lies of Lizzie Lovett by Chelsea Sedoti.

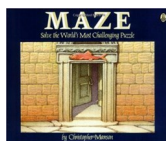


Touching Spirit Bear by Ben Mikaelson

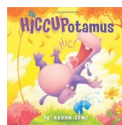

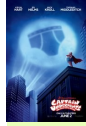


HiccUpotamus by Aaron Zenz
