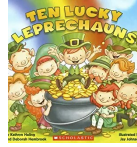


Technology by Roger Bridgman

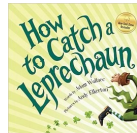

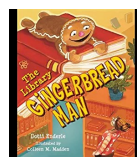


Library Lily by Gillian Shields
