this year with so many new runners was to gain experience and improve. We are greatly improved."

Kayla Keane paced the East Jordan girls team with a 19th place finish in 19:59, Tess McNitt was 68th in 24:06, while Ellen Brandell and Casey Keane finished 81st and 84th, respectively.

In the boys race, Kirk Acharya earned All-Region, finishing 4th overall in 16 minutes, 18 seconds to lead Charlevoix to a second place team finish to host Benzie Central with 92 points, Kingsley finished third with 93.

Andrew Plude, Jackson Buday and Nicholas Plude crossed the finish line 21-22-23 in 17:12, 18:13, 17:22, respectively for the Rayders, while Will Jeakle was 27th in 17:30, Tristen Rudolph finished 37th in 17:54, and Alex Gooch was 42nd in 18:02.

"Both teams ran the way they have all year, they remained patient at the beginning of race, which went out very fast," Charlevoix coaches Ken and Mary Plude said. "They were confident in their racing style and in each other to perform as needed, the second halves of their races were great to coach and watch, and we are very proud of both squads and look forward to the state finals."

East Jordan's Josh Wojan qualified as an individual as he finished 11th overall in a time of 16:33. Teammate Luke Hawely was 17th in 16:50; 23-Tyler Nachazel, 17:33; 41-Gabe Hawely, 18:01; 50-Tyler Galmore, 18:15; 73-Rob Nemeck, 19:49; and 74th Alex Moses in 20:07.

Boyer City had a pair of individual runners competing as freshman Garrett Fogo ran a personal and new freshman record in 17:34, finishing 30th overall, while two-sport athlete Jon Calo ran his best time of the season in 19:25, finishing 70th overall.

"Garrett has improved over the year, as he maintains focus and runs aggressively throughout the entire race," Place noted. "Jon also played soccer and is one of the few athletes that can compete at two sports dur-

ing the same season and make a positive contributions to both teams."

The Division III State finals sched-

ule has the girls running at 10:30am and the boys run at 11:30am.

The new GE Optima CT660 was installed Tuesday, October 18 at CAH, and it is currently available

ditionally, the technology requires user authority checks and it enables specifically-defined pediatric and adult alert values.

CAH believes that doctors and patients should receive the valuable information provided in their scans as soon as possible. Thanks to pre-set protocols for trauma situations, the hospital will be able to scan patients more quickly than previously. In addition, they can provide same day results for other CT services including CT Angiography (Renal, Carotid, Mesenteric, Aorta Run-offs), Advanced Vessel Analysis, Brain Perfusion, and Lung Nodule Analysis.

"This technology was introduced a few years ago in Europe, but was only recently approved for use in the U.S. We were due to renew our contract or upgrade our equipment, and this was a perfect opportunity to acquire this new system," says Joe Schodde, Vice President of Finance at CAH. "This means better imaging capabilities and better safeguards for our patients' health."

The Optima CT660 is a 64-slice scanner and is also among the world's most energy efficient CT systems, using approximately 60% less energy than the previous scanner. It can also offer more detailed images of patients up to 500 lbs., and it has faster scan times and a 12-inch display screen that shows relaxing videos or cartoons to increase patient comfort during the exam.

Charlevoix Area Hospital Imaging Department provides the highest quality images and technology to

Insulation keeps your home warm in the winter and cool in the summer. There are several common types of insulation — fiberglass (in both batt and blown

forms), cellulose, rigid foam board, and spray foam. Reflective insulation (or radiant barrier) is another insulating product which can help save energy in hot weather.

When correctly installed with air sealing, each type of insulation can deliver comfort and lower energy bills during the hottest and coldest times of the year.

Insulation performance is measured by R-value — its ability to resist heat flow. Higher R-values

mean more insulating power. Different R-values are recommended for walls, attics, basements and crawlspaces. Insulation works best when air is not moving through or around it. So it is very important to seal air leaks before installing insulation to ensure that you get the best performance from the insulation.

To get the biggest savings, the easiest place to add insulation is usually in the attic. A quick way to

see if you need more insulation is to look across your uncovered attic floor. If your insulation is level with or below the attic floor joists, you probably need to add more insulation. The recommended insulation level for most attics is R-49 (or about 15-18 inches, depending on the insulation type).
