Charlevoix wins its first ever Regional volleyball title

KALKASKA – Finish It! Two simple words, with a whole lot of meaning!

Those two simple words are the motto that the Charlevoix Rayders volleyball team has used to fuel the competitive fire that burns in each and every member of the team.

What a difference a year makes. After coming so close last season in the Class C regional finals, and falling in five sets to Leroy Pine River, the 2011 Rayder volleyball team made sure that history wasn't about to repeat itself, as they swept

the Bucks in three straight in the much anticipated rematch on November 10.

Down 22-16 in the first set, the Rayders overcame an uncharacteristically slow start and pulled out a 25-22 victory, Charlevoix then carried that momentum into the next two games, 25-10, 25-16, to stamp their mark in school history as the first-ever Class C regional volleyball champions.

With the victory, the No. 6 ranked (state coaches poll) Rayders improved to 48-4-6 and earned the right to advance to the quarterfinals against Houghton, 41-9-5 at their home court at Charlevoix High School on November 15.

For the third straight year, Charlevoix was in the regional finals, having lost to McBain in 2009, and dropping a heartbreaker last season to Pine River. The Rayders won the first two games and looked to close out the Bucks, but a momentum shift and three games later, Pine River was the team raising the trophy. "After last season, we came in focused and determined to win," Charlevoix coach Liz Shaw said. "To accomplish that is a great testament to the girls. They have stayed focused all season and kept their composure."

After being down 22-16 in the opening set, Shaw noticed that the team was very tentative and not playing their style of ball.

"We took a couple of timeouts and got the girls to settle in, start attacking and playing their style," Shaw noted. "Once that happened, there was no stopping them."

The second set saw the Rayders step on the accelerator and not let up as they went up 19-9, and finished off the Bucks 25-10.

Being in the same situation as the previous season, the Rayders dug deep and kept the pedal to the metal and in the third set, as they took a 20-10 advantage and finished off Pine River 25-16 and set off a long awaited Rayder celebration.

"Before the game we reminded the girls of positive talk on the court, and the biggest tool they have is their 'togetherness,'" said coach Shaw. "When they come together, they can accomplish anything." "We

have also gotten very solid leadership from both Kelly Greyerbiehl and Jenna Way."

"It was so exciting, making school history and being part of it," Greyerbiehl said. "It was great to see all the community members and we had a big student section, half the gym was ours."

Greyerbiehl also noted, "It was great to get our revenge on Pine River, I was a little worried the first game, but after we came to-

gether, it was really exciting." "I had butterflies before the game, a combination of nerves and excitement, but winning was the greatest feeling ever, I know I had tears of joy."

Jenna Way led Charlevoix with 22 assists, 15 digs, 12 kills and a pair of aces. Megan Peters had 12 kills; Kelsey Way chipped in with seven kills, eight digs and

three blocks; Madeline Boss added six kills and five digs.

"Losing to them last year, and hearing 'Pine River' announced was the hardest part," Rayder senior setter Jenna Way said. "Their student section went wild, it was heart breaking and we vowed that it was not going to happen again."

"There was a spark lit when we found out that we had the chance to play them

All-Area Football Team

Charlevoix's Andrew Potter is Player of the Year; Don Jess is Coach of the Year

The Charlevoix County News 2011 All-Area Football team has been announced, with Charlevoix's **Don Jess** being named Coach of the Year. Jess, in his ninth year at the helm, helped guide the Rayders to a 4-5 record, including Lake Michigan Conference victories over rivals Boyne City and East Jordan. Charlevoix overcame some key injuries and distractions throughout the season as the team battled tough in each and every contest. Three of the Rayders losses came to playoff bound teams (St. Ignace, Grayling, and TC St. Francis), while having another three losses decided by a total of 12 points, including an overtime defeat. On four occasions, the Rayders held their opponents to under 10 points, including back to back shutouts in weeks 6-7. Charlevoix outscored the opposition this season, 170-144.

Andrew Potter of Charlevoix was also named the 2011 CCNews All-Area Player of the Year. Potter a Rayder captain, played quarterback, fullback and free safety for Charlevoix. The versatile Potter, was the most athletic and unselfish player of the team, according to coach Jess. Andrew racked up 677 passing yards, going 46-for-85, with eight touchdowns; he also rushed for 318 yards on 74 carries and five scores, and caught one pass for 10 yards.

On the defensive side of the ball, Potter finished third on the team with 65 tackles, five interceptions and a fumble recovery.

Joining Potter of the first team are fellow Rayders **Andrew Robarge**, **Charlie Hamilton** and **Coby Herriman**. Robarge was the hard-nosed, play-making linebacker for Charlevoix, making a team 72 tackles in eight games. Hamilton was the team's offensive MVP. A fast, athletic, big play guy, Hamilton led the team in scoring with 54 points, including eight touchdowns and six point after touchdowns. He caught 31 passes for 488 yards, including a season high 71 yarder. Herriman, yet another unselfish Rayder veteran made the switch from Tight End to the Offensive line this season and was credited with doing an outstanding job. Coby, his hard working, hard-nosed play also earned him ample time at linebacker for the Rayders where he made 58 tackles.

Four Boyne City Ramblers also make the cut, led by senior **Jay Redman**. Redman was the Ramblers quarterback and free safety, and a close runner-up for Player of the Year. He was in charge of making the defensive checks and was the team's offensive leader as well. His leadership and talent led Boyne to their victories and kept them close in the others. He maintained a positive attitude and focused on the play at hand, helping those around him to do the same. Coach Don Nohel had this to say about Redman, "His importance to our team can't be overstated; he was the glue on the field, an awesome young man to coach and be around." Jay completed 60 passes for 727 yards and six touchdowns; he also rushed for 43 yards and three more scores, and recorded 29 tackles and two interceptions.

Joining Redman is **Kerey Kuheana**, fullback and strong side linebacker. Kuheana was a transplant student from England this past season, with his father a Rambler alumni, his parents wanted Kerey to have the opportunity to play "American" football in the states. Kuheana was blessed with good speed and was a physical force to be reckoned with on the field. He excelled on defense right out of the gates, while it took him some time to adjust to the offensive side of the ball.

Coach Nohel noted that Kerey is a very polite and courteous young man that represented himself and Boyne City very well. Despite suffering a foot injury in the middle of the game 7, Kuheana still managed to lead the team in solo tackles with 25 and added 18 assists, which includes four sacks and 10 tackles for a loss. Kerey also rushed for 398 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Boyne inside linebacker/offensive guard junior, **Trey Reinhardt** is also a first team selection. Reinhardt was the Ramblers leading tackler; he tallied up 21 solo tackles and 52 assists, including seven for losses. A physical ball player who makes the most of his 175 pounds, made many plays where he didn't record a tackle, but helped the defense work. Also for the Ramblers,

Keegan LaBlance was selected. Keegan played split end and was a key element on the Boyne City special teams. Lablance is an explosive athlete that was fun to watch him weave his way among the defenses. Keegan was on the receiving end of 24 passes for 275 yards and two touchdowns; he also returned five kickoffs for 95 yards and eight punts for 121 yards and a score.

East Jordan junior center, **Zach Shepard** helped the Red Devils of defense move the ball. A big kid that

moves well uses great technique and was credited with being a good blocker and a very good kid by East Jordan coach Allan Peterson. Shepard recorded 45 tackles on defense for the Red Devils. Joining Shepard are three more Red Devils, **Ben Walton**, **Wyatt Werner** and **John Richards**.

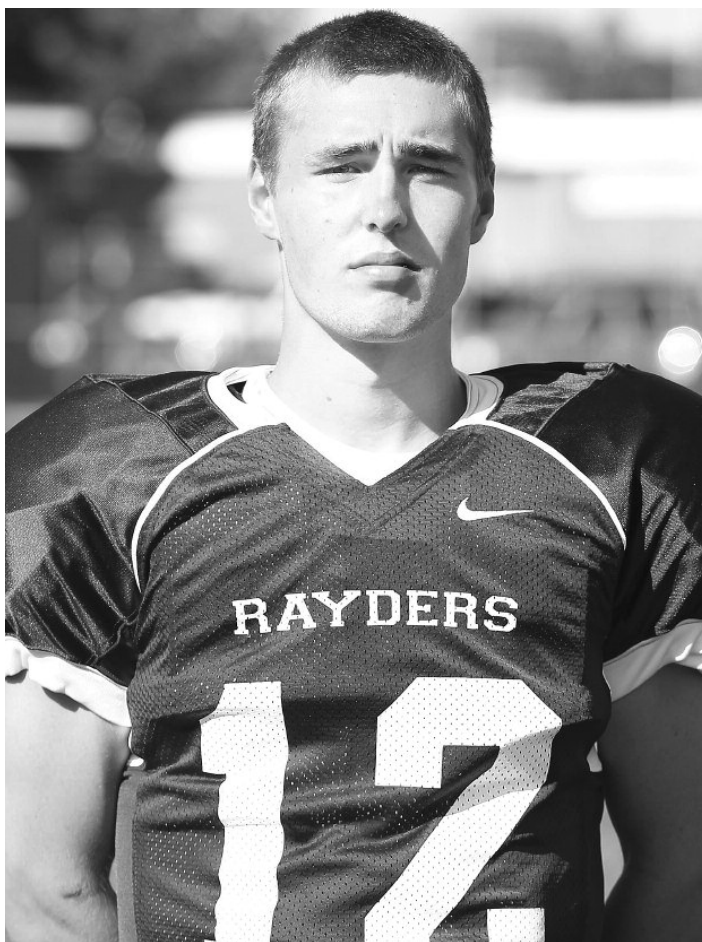
Walton, a sophomore nose guard/offensive guard, is a very quick, very strong individual. Ben led the East Jordan squad with 94 tackles. Werner, a senior, recorded 41 tackles and picked off three

passes from his safety position. Wyatt also led the Red Devils in all-purpose yards. Richards is a first team repeat from last season, the senior team MVP, played tight end and middle linebacker for East Jordan. Coach Peterson noted that Richards did an outstanding job of blocking from his tight end position and as a powerful hitter, was second on the team with 87 tackles.

Also making the first team is **Jake Seaney**, Ellsworth-Central Lake. Seaney, a two-sport athlete

for the Lancers/Trojans, returned six kickoffs for 180 yards and a score, and one punt for 24 yards.

Area athletes making the second team were: TJ Douglas, Zach Wandrie and Bradley Fouchia, of Boyne City. Josh Hogan, Clay Heise and Tanner Catt of Charlevoix, Noah Bacchus, Tim Schut and Marcus Wingate of East Jordan, along with Trevor Papineau and Gus Meriwether of Ellsworth - Central Lake.

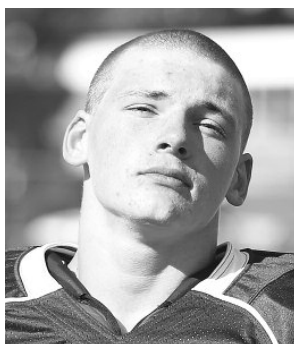

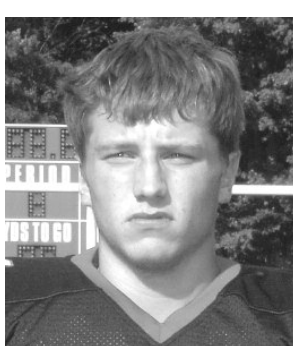

Rayders Jenna Way signs to play volleyball at Ferris State

CHARLEVOIX – What did you do last week?

I know a lot of people, sometimes including myself, that have a difficult time answering that question.

But I am pretty sure if you ask that very question to Jenna Way; the first thing she will greet you with is a smile, a very “Big” smile.

The Charlevoix senior setter not only helped lead her record setting volleyball team to a regional semi-final victory on Tuesday November 8, she was back at it again in Kalkaska on Thursday, November 10 to once again help lead the Rayders to their first ever Class C regional title, and on Friday, November 11, she decided to fill in some time by signing her national letter of intent to play at Ferris State University next season.

Jenna is the daughter of Mike and Chris Way of Charlevoix.

She plans on entering the dental hygiene program at Ferris State.

The decision to sign with Ferris State was one that Jenna did not take lightly, she had put together packages for other colleges, sent numerous emails but it came down to feeling comfortable and she felt wanted by FSU.

Her grandfather Dean Davenport also served at the Athletic Director for FSU from 1970 – 1992.

“There were so many positives for me to go to Ferris State,” Jenna said. “I could not find any negatives.”

Jenna noted that it had been a goal of hers since the second grade to play in college. She witnessed her older sister Sumer go through the recruiting process with Hillsdale.

“I am a visual learner,” said Jenna. “I had the opportunity to watch college ball at a young age, and seeing my sister play at such a high level really helped me.”

“My dad always was putting together highlight tapes of our family too,” she added. “I liked that a lot, and it helped me develop my game and to work hard.”

Jenna has attended multiple camps at Ferris State, including a setter’s camp when she was in the 7th-8th grade that helped her experience the college atmosphere at a young age. During that time, she had the opportunity to practice with the FSU team. “Playing with college girls was an awesome adrenaline rush,” Jenna said. “I was nervous, but it was a lot of fun.”

Charlevoix coach Liz Shaw had this to say, “It shows that hard work has paid off

for her.” “I’m so proud to be part of her high school experience, she will be the first Division II player that I have had the opportunity to coach, and I know she will do well.”

Jenna had nothing but praise for her high school coach as well, “It will be very different next year playing for another coach,” “We’ve been together for about six years, I look up to her a lot, she is such a good person and a good coach, I wouldn’t be the person I am today without her, she’s awesome!”

She also noted that the two of them can read each other without saying anything

and that they have a very good relationship, and they always make time for feedback.

Jenna also wanted to thank God for her accomplishments. “I believe he has laid everything out for me, I’m a firm believer in its either black or white, not any gray area, he has been a big part of my life, and had a positive impact on me.”

Jenna is also the youngest member of her family, and said that she has cherished the time she has had with both of her parents. “I’m the baby of the family, so I got a lot of time together with them, they are so supportive and they will get to come to my

games next year.

She also said her grandparents, brother and sisters are also very supportive and encouraging, and again wanted to mention the support from coach Shaw.

If you happen to see Jenna in the near future, feel free to ask her about her amazing week, be prepared to hear how passionate she is about her own and the Rayder volleyball teams accomplishments, and all the hard work they have all put in.

again. Jenna noted. “It was so awesome to see our student section, the parents and the community come together.” “It’s unbelievable, I feel like I’m smiling all the time.”

Also for the Rayders, Anna Way finished with three kills and five digs; Karley Pearsall had three

kills; senior libero Greyerbiehl finished with 20 digs, was 20-of 22 on serve receive and scored 18 points with no errors. Fellow seniors Chelsie Hoffman and Madison Zimmerman finished with 18 and six digs respectively.

Leroy Pine River closed out their season at 41-13-5.

With the quarterfinal game being played in their own back yard, Charlevoix will have the advantage of not having to travel, whereas Houghton will have to travel from the

northwestern U.P. for the meeting. With the winner advancing to the state semifinals on Friday, November 18 at 3:45 pm at Kellogg Arena in Battle Creek and the Class C finals scheduled for Saturday, November 19 at noon.

When asked about the upcoming quarterfinal match, coach Shaw noted, “We have worked hard to get here; we have a home court advantage, and whichever team plays the best ball and rises to the occasion will come out on top.” “Were ex-

cited for it, and I expect the girls to play their best ball.”

“I’m excited to play in Charlevoix, it will be loud and there will be a lot of energy on the court.” Greyerbiehl said. “We will come together, and we want it so bad, we know we can do it.” “The regional title was

just another thing we got to check off our goal list,”

Jenna Way said. “Whatever our team puts their minds to, we can accomplish, we focus on what we have to do and don’t worry about the other team.” “Everyone has fun, we are very versatile, with only Kelly and I play-

ing the same positions, it’s been a long journey, and an awesome experience.”

An awesome journey and experience indeed, one that has seen these young ladies put their mark on school history, only one thing left for them to do, “Finish it!”

How Much Insulation Do I Already Have?

Look into your attic. We start with the attic because it is usually easy to add insulation to an attic.

Look into your walls. It is difficult to add insulation to existing walls unless:

You are planning to add new siding to your house, or

You plan to finish unfinished space (like a basement or bonus room).

If so, you need to know whether the exterior walls are already insulated or not. One method is to use an electrical outlet on the wall, but first be sure to turn off the power to the outlet. Then remove the cover plate and shine a

flashlight into the crack around the outlet box. You should be able to see whether or not insulation is in the wall. Also, you should check separate outlets on the first and second floor, and in old and new parts of the house, because wall insulation in one wall doesn't necessarily mean that it's everywhere in the house. An alternative to checking through electrical outlets is to remove and then replace a small section of the exterior siding.

Look under your floors. Look at the underside of any floor over an unheated space like a garage, basement, or crawlspace. Inspect and measure the thickness of any insulation you find there. It will most likely be a fiberglass batt, so multiply the thickness in inches by 3.2 to find out the R-value (or the R-value might be visible on a product label). If the insulation is a foam board or sprayed-on foam, use any visible label information or multiply the thickness in

inches by 5 to estimate the R-value.

Look at your ductwork. Don't overlook another area in your home where energy can be saved - the ductwork of the heating and air conditioning system. If the ducts of your heating or air-conditioning system run through unheated or uncooled spaces in your home, such as attic or crawl-spaces, then the ducts should be insulated. First check the ductwork for air leaks. Repair leaking joints first with mechanical fasteners, then seal any remaining leaks with water-soluble mastic and embedded fiber glass mesh. Never use gray cloth duct tape because it degrades, cracks, and loses its bond with age. If a joint has to be accessible for future maintenance, use pressure- or heat-sensitive aluminum foil tape. Then wrap the ducts with duct wrap insulation of R-6 with a vapor retarder facing on the outer side. All joints where sections of

insulation meet should have overlapped facings and be tightly sealed with fiber glass tape; but avoid compressing the insulation, thus reducing its thickness and R-value.

Return air ducts are often located inside the heated portion of the house where they don't need to be insulated, but they should still be sealed off from air passageways that connect to unheated areas. Drywall to ductwork connections should be inspected because they are often poor (or nonexistent) and lead to unwanted air flows through wall cavities. If the return air ducts are located in an unconditioned part of the building, they should be insulated.

Look at your pipes. If water pipes run through unheated or uncooled spaces in your home, such as attic or crawlspaces, then the pipes should be insulated.
