## A Night at the 2012 Heisman Awards

New York City - Johnny Manziel, the Texas A&M University quarterback, won this year's Heisman Memorial Trophy on December 8, 2012. He was the 78th winner of this honor. Manziel made history, not only when he commandeered his team into beating perennial football powerhouse Alabama, 29-24, in November, but also when he became the first freshman ever to

win the Heisman.

A panel composed of former Heisman Trophy winners and media members gave Manziel 474 first place votes in naming him for college football's most prestigious annual honor. Upon receiving the award, Manziel noted, "I have been dreaming about this since I was a kid, running around the backyard pretending I was Doug Flutie - throwing 'Hail Marys' to my dad. I wish my whole team could be up here with me."

Because I was fortunate enough to attend the Heisman Trophy press conference (this was my third one), held at the Marriott Marquis in holiday-bustling Times Square, I participated in some of the hype surrounding the awarding of the cast bronze statue of a football player, striking a much-copied pose, to Manziel.

At this press event, reporters from as far away as the Honolulu Star-Advertiser and as near as the New York Times were there, as well as popular bloggers, like the Heisman Pundit. All were armed with microphones, laptops, or smart phones, ready to nab a soundbite from or snapshot of the three candidates nominated for the 2012 award. Besides Manziel, Collin Klein, quarterback for Kansas State University and Manti Te'o, linebacker for the University of Notre Dame were the other two nominees fea-

tured at the Heisman Trophy's presentation on ESPN, televised live, from the Best Buy Theater near Broadway.

Quick impressions: Johnny Football, as Manziel is nicknamed, has an energetic, engaging personality. Klein is a stoic, yet mature leader. Te'o is in a class by himself with the interesting background of being a Samoan Hawaiian Mormon, who has become the face of the Fighting Irish.

After a traditional-style press conference, during which the three candidates stood on a stage and fielded questions, the media was invited to sit at small tables while each young man held court. Due to the buzz surround-

ing Manziel as the likely winner, I elected to sit first with Te'o and second with Klein.

Since I am a feature writer, I asked Te'o, who was adorned with large leis, about his volunteer work, as this young man has visited homeless shelters and pediatric hospitals. He shared that he participated in the Relay for Life event, as he wants to be a warrior against cancer. As many who have heard his story know, Te'o lost his sweetheart, Lennay Kekua, to leukemia and his maternal grandmother, earlier this year, around the time Notre Dame played the University of Michigan and Michigan State University.

Te'o, who elected to not miss a

game, told the reporters at our crowded table that he attributes everything he accomplishes to "his Heavenly Father." Still, the upcoming BCS national championship game, in which undefeated Notre Dame will play against Alabama in the Orange Bowl on January 7, 2013, is at the forefront of his consciousness.

"My mind is all on the national championship," said Te'o.

On that note, I made my way to the quietest table in the room, that of Collin Klein. I was more interested in chatting with the 6'5 QB about his home-schooling background and his commitment to wait until his wedding day to kiss his bride (Klein recently married Shalin Spani, a former K-State hoops player.) than in hearing how he scored a touchdown in an impressive 21 straight games. His willingness to freely talk about 'the Lord' and praise his upbringing and his parents was uplifting. Klein, an accomplished pianist, was asked what his favorite music genre to play is. He replied: "Praise and worship music."

Such responses are what make the Heisman press conference such a fascinating event, as the conversation often transcends talking about touchdowns and tackles.

## Northern Michigan Ski Academy Season Starts Soon

Northern Michigan Ski Academy race training sessions start Wednesday, January 2nd at Boyne Mountain and Thursday, January 3rd at Boyne Highlands. Training sessions take place from 6:30 to 8:30 PM on Wednesdays at Boyne Mountain and Thursdays at Boyne Highlands. A meeting for parents will take place at both locations during the first sessions.

This year the Northern Michigan Ski Academy (NMSA) is celebrating its 34th anniversary. The NMSA is a non-profit organization that is run by a Volunteer Board of Directors and Coaches. The program is designed to teach area youth the fundamentals of ski racing.

Training sessions are held for nine weeks beginning in January. During the Wednesday and Thursday night sessions, skiers ski in small groups with a NMSA coach. Skiers practice the fundamentals of ski racing with racers of their own age and capability. Friday nights are open gate nights only at Boyne Mountain and Boyne Highlands with courses set that the skiers can run as they wish. All of the Sunday club races bring together the "Highlands" and "Mountain" skiers for combined racing. Throughout the season, club races are scheduled at Boyne Highlands and Boyne Mountain. This year two all day races will be held at Boyne Highlands. Racers are ranked for participation in the NMSA Racing Team that participates in the "Northern Michigan Junior Racers Cup" which brings together skiers from across Northern Michigan. The "Championship Race" will be held on Sunday, March 3rd at Boyne Highlands.

## This Holiday Season, give young children the gift of social and emotional language

Rather than spending money on the hottest gadgets for young children this Holiday Season, the Health Department of Northwest Michigan suggests that parents, grandparents, aunts and uncles consider giving gifts that promote social and emotional interaction among toddlers and youngsters.

"We can begin learning to express ourselves and understand our own emotions before we reach age five," said Natalie Kasiborski, Community Health Coordinator for the Health Department. "Parents often have trouble knowing what words to use, or how to help young children identify and deal with their emotions. For most of us, the Holiday Season is a time of increased social activity, and emotions may be running high as well, so it makes perfect sense to consider age-appropriate gifts

that can help with social and emotional language development."

Patty Clark, Infant Mental Health Specialist with North Country Community Mental Health, has recommended a number of books aimed at giving parents and younger children the vocabulary they need to explain and cope with everyday emotions. "Young children experience an array of complex emotions, yet they lack the means to express themselves or to identify what they're feeling," Clark explained. "This is frustrating for them, and for their families. Books like these offer important ways to connect with children, including those who suffer from anxiety, fear, anger, or who may have gone through a traumatic experience, such as the loss of a loved one or a parental separation. They're often as help-

ful to parents and other adults as they are to the children."

Clark added that the development of social and emotional language is important not only for children who have experienced trauma or loss, but for all children to be able to communicate their daily range of emotions.

## Causes and Treatments for High Triglycerides

Triglycerides are the main form of fat found in the blood which is important in keeping you in good condition - this is because its main function is to give the body energy. However, high triglyceride levels might be a sign of metabolic syndrome which could increase a person's risk when it comes to diabetes, heart diseases and stroke. Metabolic syndrome is a combination of medical disorders that includes high blood pressure; high blood sugar; high triglycerides, low HDL ("good") cholesterol and too much fat around the waist.

In order to measure your triglycerides, a blood test must be conducted. To get an overview on your triglycerides level, the normal level would be less than 150 while borderline-high is 150 - 199. High triglycerides level is 200 - 499, and very high would be 500 above.

### CAUSES OF HIGH TRIGLYCERIDES

The various causes of high triglycerides are usually attributed to conditions relating to age; an underactive thyroid (hypothyroidism), drinking too much alcohol, eating food that is high in fat, heredity, kidney disease, obesity (or weight gain), poorly controlled diabetes and regularly eating more calories than you can burn.

Certain medications may also contribute

to increasing the triglycerides to an unhealthy level. These include beta-blockers; birth control pills, diuretics (water pills), estrogen, steroids and tamoxifen.

### SYMPTOMS OF HIGH TRIGLYCERIDES

High triglycerides symptoms are virtually non-existent; although those due to genetic conditions may find fatty deposits under the skin. These are called xanthomas.

However, there are very few cases in which people with high triglyceride levels experience inflammation of the pancreas (pancreatitis). This may result to fever; loss of appetite, nausea, severe abdominal pain and vomiting. Apart from that, a person might develop conditions such as liver and spleen enlargement as well as having visible fatty deposits in the skin. This can possibly increase the risk of having a heart attack or stroke.

### HOW TO LOWER TRIGLYCERIDE LEVELS

A healthy diet as well as lifestyle changes can lower your triglyceride levels. This means that you should try to be more active; limit your alcohol intake, limit fats and sugars in your diet, quit smoking and

consistently maintain a healthy weight.

In lowering your cholesterol, you will also reduce your triglyceride level in the process. You may include certain supplements that can help you lose weight. The ingredients of these supplements should include some of the following: Omega 3 fatty acids (Fish Oil), Guggul, Policosanol, Red Yeast Rice, Green Tea, L-Carnitine, and Niacin. These can all help normalize and reduce your triglyceride levels which leaves you feeling healthier and better about yourself. So with the combination of exercise, proper diet and using the right supplements, you are on your way to improving your lifestyle and well being.

## Widespread flu virus sends kids home from school, prompts flu shot reminders

The Health Department of Northwest Michigan has received reports of a significant increase in flu activity statewide. This has prompted health officials to re-issue an urgent message to the public: Get your flu shot, and make sure school-age children get theirs, too.

Suzette Daly, Family and Community Health Supervisor for the Health Department, emphasized that flu shots are especially important for the kids. Last week, the local health department in Calhoun County, Michigan was informed of a sudden increase in upper respiratory illness, resulting in an absenteeism rate of as much as 30 percent among school-

age children in one district.

"Kids should be in school, learning, rather than at home trying to recover from the flu," Daly said. "Those who haven't received a flu shot are far more likely to come down with the virus, and spread it to others." She added that flu viruses spread quickly in schools and day care settings, where students and adults are in close contact, and getting a flu shot before the virus reaches our area can save days missed from school and work, and prevent holiday illness.

The Health Department stocks vaccine, and offers appointments for flu shots and other vaccines at its offices in Bellaire, Mancelona,

Charlevoix, Petoskey/Harbor Springs and Gaylord. The cost for seasonal flu vaccination is \$25. Medicaid and Medicare are accepted, as well as private insurance, or clients may pay by cash or check. Call the Health Department at (800) 432-4121 to schedule an appointment.

Flu vaccinations offer protection throughout the entire flu season, which can last as late as May. There are two types of flu vaccines: the flu shot, approved for use in people six (6) months of age and older; including healthy people, people with chronic medical conditions and pregnant women; and the nasal-spray flu vaccine, approved for use in

healthy people from 2-49 years of age who are not pregnant. Babies six (6) months of age and under are at risk for the flu, but cannot be given the vaccine; their best defense is parents, siblings, grandparents, and daycare providers being immunized.

Mortgage giants Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac announced last week that they will temporarily halt all bank repossessions and evictions beginning in mid-December until Jan. 2, 2013.

The temporary foreclosure suspension goes into effect

beginning Dec. 17 and Dec. 19, respectively. The moratorium will not affect the filing notices of default or the scheduling of auction sales.

“The holidays are a chance to be with loved ones and we want to relieve some stress at this time of year,”

says Terry Edwards, Executive Vice President of Credit Portfolio Management, Fannie Mae.

Bank of America also recently announced that it is halting foreclosure evictions for the holidays for loans it owns and for those it serv-

ices for investors. JPMorgan Chase, Wells Fargo, and Citibank have yet to release a statement on whether they'll follow suit, although they have done so in the past for the holidays.
