## The 2013 Freedom Festival starts June 16th in East Jordan

It's a celebration of freedom that takes place each year in the Jordan River Valley just a few weeks before the Fourth of July holiday; drawing attendees from every corner of Northern Michigan. Right on schedule for 2013, East Jordan will once again celebrate our freedoms with the 2013 Freedom Festival beginning Sunday, June 16th, and continuing through Saturday, June 22nd. Shannon Fender, president of the East Jordan Freedom Festival board, states, "There is always plenty of fun for those of

every age to enjoy at the Freedom Festival. This is one of the first summer celebrations of freedom here in Northern Michigan. Many of the much loved traditions of the festival will be returning this year, and there is always something new going on for attendees to enjoy." As always, the 2013 East Jordan Freedom Festival will offer plenty for the kids to enjoy. A highlight is the return of "Old Time Kids Games"; taking place at Memorial Park on Wednesday, June 19th from 5 to 7 pm. At this free event there will be classic and timeless games such as Pick-a-Duck, Treasures in the Saw



Dust, Bean Bag Toss, and sidewalk chalk, face painting and much more. Twister Joe, Balloon Artist Extraordinaire will be there to create balloon animals and balloon hats for everyone. "There will be old fashion kids

games, such as three-legged races and the challenge of searching for prizes in a sawdust pile," notes Fender, "along with games and events such as a Wii Dance Competition at Memorial Park and "Glow Bowling" at Gemini Lanes on Wednesday. We also have lots of kid's activities for Saturday at Murphy's Field, with a petting zoo, pony rides, inflatables to bounce on, and a

'Water Cannon Recon' event, which will utilize big squirt guns filled with colored water." There will be a Talent Show on Thursday, June 20th at the Memorial Park Band Shell stage, and a Friday Night Block Party in downtown East Jordan on Friday.

day, June 21st with music, food, games and a Youth Parade beginning at 6 pm in the Marina parking lot, heading north to Main Street, to Williams Street, down the hill to Spring Street and back to Memorial Park.

The Freedom Festival Grand Parade will take place on Saturday, June 22nd starting at 3pm, and will proceed from the west side of the bridge on Main to Watson Field. The 2013 Grand Marshals will be "Our United States Veterans". All veterans are invited to join in the parade and there will be transportation provided for any veterans that cannot walk the parade route.

Fender states, "It will truly be an honor to salute our veterans as the 2013 Freedom Festival Grand Marshals and this is our way to say "Thank you for their service to our country."

Other events taking place during the East Jordan Freedom Festival will include a Farmers Market and a Crafts and Things exhibit at Sportsman's Park, and carnival rides by Schmidt Amusements on Main and Easterly Streets from Thursday through Saturday.

The always popular Prize Raffle, with over 40 prizes this year, will be held on Saturday, June 22nd at Memorial Park beginning at 6 pm and drawings will take place throughout the Lip Sync Contest. You must be present for the drawings to win. Other prize-winning opportunities during Freedom Festival include the Button Drawings during the Block Party on Friday, June 21st, at 7, 8 and 9 pm. Purchase a commemorative East Jordan Freedom Festival Button to be worn during

Beginning at dusk next Saturday evening, June 22nd the skies over Lake Charlevoix will be filled with a "Fabulous, Gigantic, and Spectacular Fireworks Display."
