Rayders Topple Ramblers

Charlevoix pulls away down the stretch as Catt leads charge with 16 points

CHARLEVOIX — It was a playoff type atmosphere in another Lake Michigan Conference rivalry showdown between Boyne City and Charlevoix, and for the second time this season, the Rayders came out on top in a 56-47 hard-fought victory on February 1.

Leading the Rayder charge was senior Tanner Catt, as he dropped 16 points, while fellow senior Charlie Hamilton added 10, and Zach Hankins chipped in with eight and 12 rebounds.

"What a great game from start to finish by both teams!" Rayder coach Adam Wood said. "It was a typical Charlevoix vs Boyne City rivalry game in front of a great crowd and each quarter found the game either a one or two point differential, until the final score"

The back and forth contest saw

the Rayders take a 15-14 advantage after one quarter of play, and extend that to a 29-27 lead at the half and 41-39 headed into the final eight minutes of play.

With the win, Charlevoix improves to 8-2 overall, 6-1 conference, while Boyne slips to 6-6, 3-5.

With both teams battling foul trouble, it was the benches that took center stage, and while each played well, it was the Rayders that would buy enough time to get their big guns back into the contest with the game on the line.

"Good rivalry game, good crowd and student sections and two teams playing hard every possession," Boyne coach Nick Redman said. "We had guys step up when Corey and Ryan got in early foul trouble, Mike Dohm and Dalton Gardner played great defensively."

"As always, both teams fought hard on every possession and we were just fortunate to get a couple stops at the end of the game, but it could have gone either way," Wood added. "It was tough sledding for both teams through-

Having a complete home inspection will help to rule out any problems and point out any areas of concern. However, even as you're browsing homes, buyers can start to make note of the key areas that Walker mentioned, such as the foundation.

Foundation

Walker says a four-year-old home he inspected recently was already showing trouble signs which could result in a costly repair project. "It was a model home. What [the homeowners] did was plant trees for shade to make it look really nice, but they planted the wrong trees and they're going to crack the foundation and it's going to cut the property value down by \$50,000," says

Walker says in the case of that home, the trees were causing micro-fractures in the tile in various locations of the home. "As you walk through the house, 21 feet in and 30 feet deep, there's just too much root invasion and it's going to ruin their tile," explains

Walker.

He says some tell-tale signs with this home were the minor cracks in the foundation that were causing a lifting and separation of the foundation. Also, the windows were not opening and closing properly, "which means the foundation is moving."

However, just because you see cracks doesn't mean there is a foundation problem. "Most people don't understand that there are natural cracks in a house. That's why when we do an inspection report we have to look at it and say 'Okay, this is a typical crack and this one is an untypical crack," says Walker. He says some cracks may lead to other problems while others won't.




