Junior Guard Bradley Fouchia ignites Rambler offense early

EAST JORDAN — When he's on, he's on!
That's just what Boyne City junior guard Bradley Fouchia was in the opening quarter for the Ramblers. Fouchia hit his first three triples and made two free throws in sparking Boyne to an early 13-3 lead that they would not relinquish, as they defeated East Jordan 63-43 on February 8.
Boyne City improved to 7-7 overall, 4-6 conference with the win, while East Jordan slipped to 3-9, 1-8.
Rambler sophomore Corey Redman led the way with a game-high 28 points and nine boards, while Fouchia added 16 points, nine assists and five boards. Maceo Vroman and Ryan Carson finished with 10 and eight points

respectfully.
Boyne would lead at the quarter breaks 16-9, 32-22 and 46-32.
For East Jordan, freshman Jordan Weber finished with 10 points, while Isaiah Sladick added nine.
"We had some guys injured and sick this week and I am proud of them for stepping up and playing hard," Rambler coach Nick Redman said. "They came out in triangle and two face guarding Corey (Redman) and Maceo (Vroman). Bradley got us going by knocking down open shots."
East Jordan would close the gap early in the second quarter 16-12, but the Ramblers responded, highlighted by a Vroman four point play, where he sank a triple and was fouled. After that, Boyne would handle any run that the Red Devils mounted.
The Red Devils did show a glimpse of big play ability late in the contest as Noah Bacchus tossed a back door alley-ooop to a cutting Sladick for an easy basket.

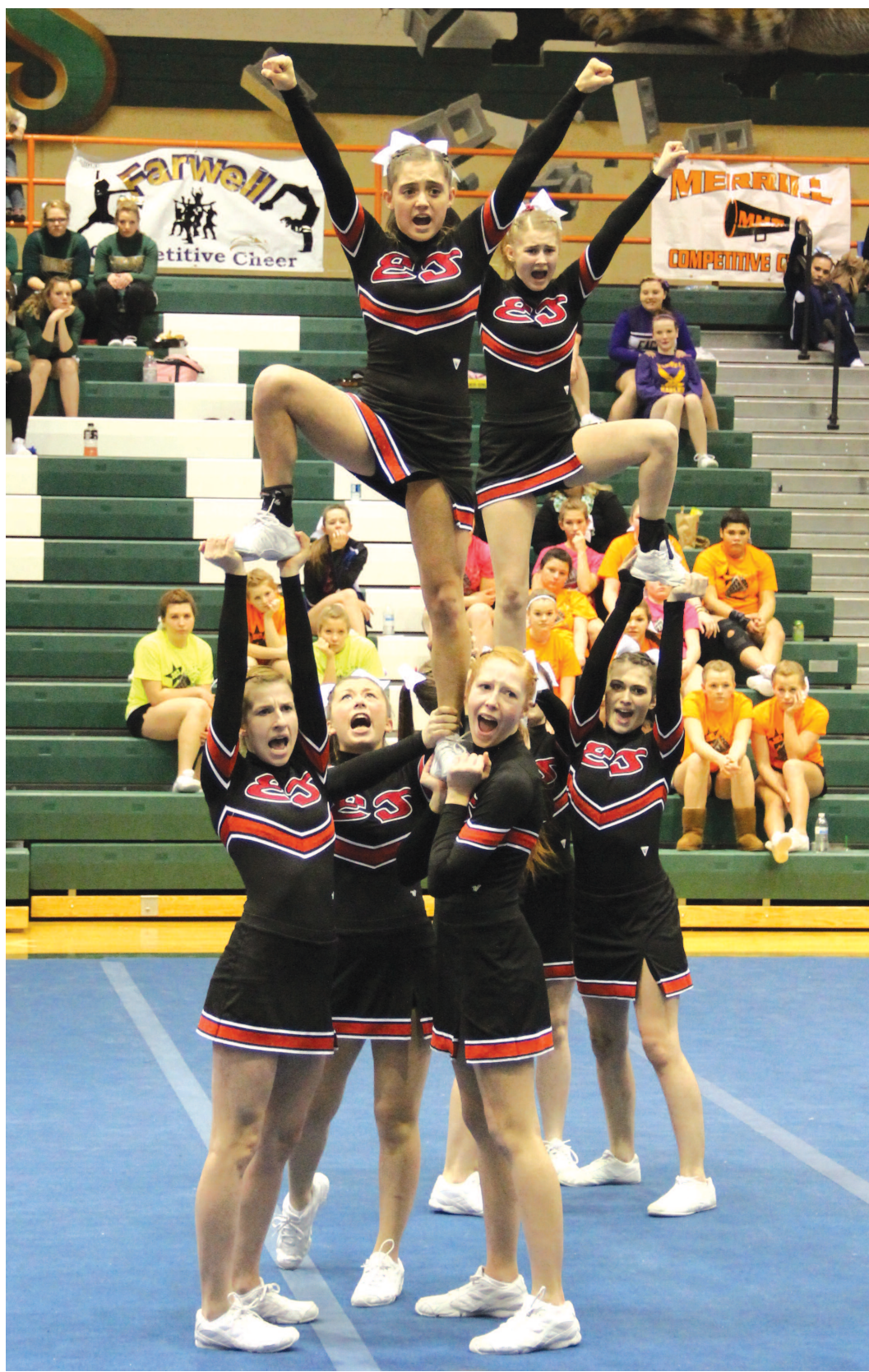
