Lady Ramblers bow out to the Braves

TRAVERSE CITY — It was uncharted territory for the young Boyne City Rambler roster as they ran into the No. 5 ranked and last season's Division III runner-up Gladstone Braves, where the Braves took advantage of some early miscues and held on to earn a hard-fought 8-2 victory over the young Ramblers on June 8.

Gladstone then advanced to the state quarterfinal with a 4-1 win over Tawas in the championship contest.

The Braves, 28-1 capitalized on a few Rambler errors in the second inning, and eventually took a 6-0 lead, highlighted by a Jordan Kowlaski two-run home run.

"We got beat by a good team," Boyne City coach Sandy Clausen said. "The second inning was rough for us, but my team did not quit."

Gladstone would add another run in the top of the third for a 7-0 cushion.

The Ramblers got on the board in the bottom half of the inning as sophomore Katelyn Banner singled and was forced out at second on sophomore Brooke Fouchia fielder's choice. Boyne freshman catcher Hannah Hoth then hit a bomb to straight-away center (her third of the season) to pull BC to within 7-2.

The score would remain that way until the Braves added a solo run in the top of the seventh to make it 8-2.

Christine Sharon picked up the win for Gladstone, tossing the final six innings in relief of starter Alison Austin. Sharon allowed two run on four hits, walked one and struck out eight.

For the Ramblers, Emma Shumaker took the loss allowing eight runs (two earned) on seven hits, walking 11 and fanning two.

The Boyne City offense was limited to four hits as senior Jes-

Rayders record setting season comes to an end

Lose hard fought contest in Regional Semifinals

TRAVERSE CITY — They say all good things must come to an end.

In this case, it would be the record setting season for the 2013 Charlevoix Rayder baseball team.

In their Division III regional semifinal contest against Negaunee, the No. 9 ranked Rayders fell to the Miners 2-1 on June 8. Whittemore-Prescott would down Negaunee 7-2, for the championship.

Over the last three months, Charlevoix set a new record for wins and added some hardware to the trophy case during this weather challenged spring sports season.

The Rayders finished the season 27-3, breaking the old record of 23 wins.

The first piece of hardware Charlevoix collected was their first conference championship since 1982 by going a perfect 14-0 in the always tough Lake Michigan Conference.

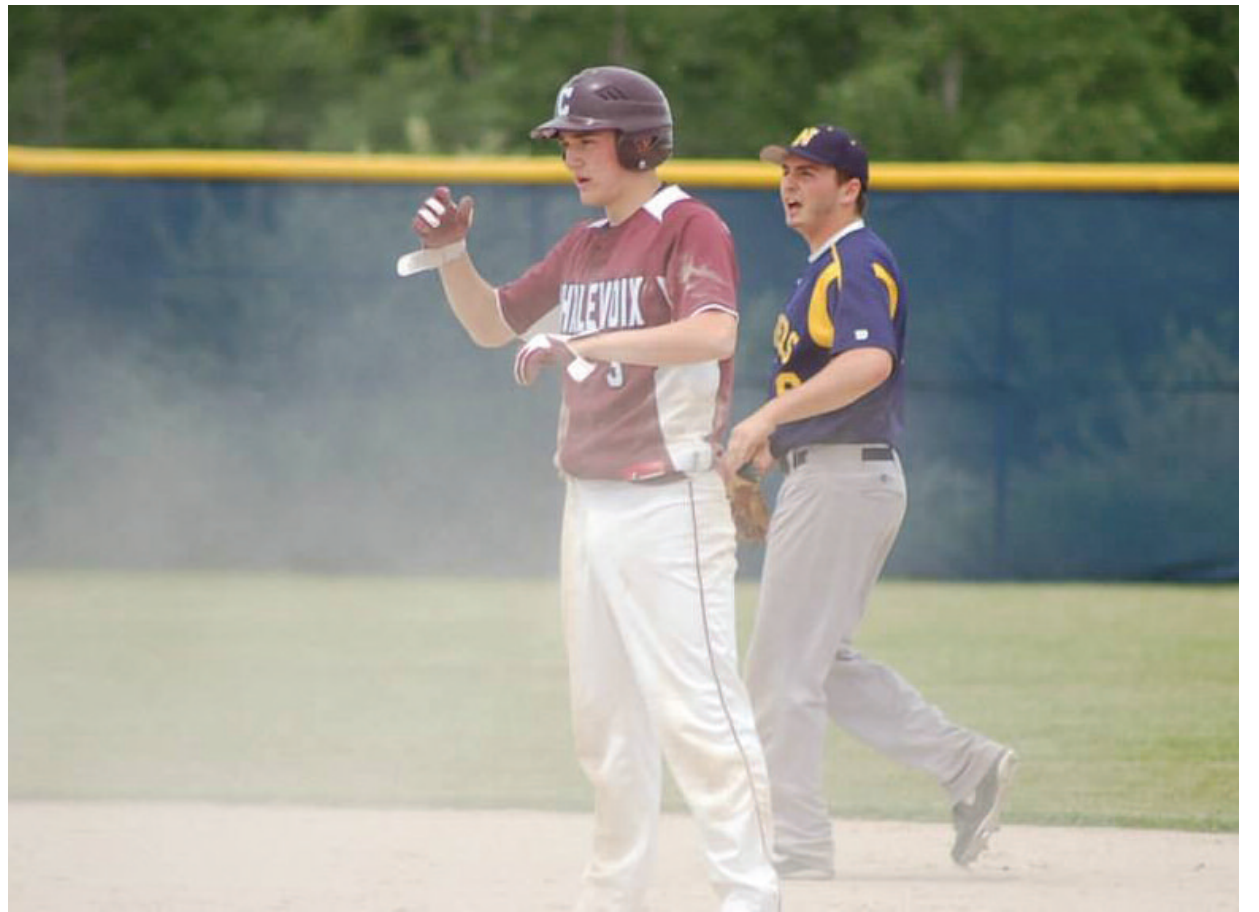
They weren't done their though as they picked up three more wins to earn their first district crown since 1988, by beating Elk Rapids in a pre-district contest 7-5, used a come from behind thriller to defeat Harbor Springs 9-5 in the semifinal to advance to the championship game where they defeated East Jordan 12-6.

In the regional semifinal though, Charlevoix struck early with a one run, three hit first inning, then Negaunee junior southpaw Tyler Jandron took over and shut the door on the Rayders.

Jandron held the Rayders to three hits, walked two and fanned 11 to pick up the win, he retired 15 batters in a row at one point.

"You have to give Negaunee all of the credit. After the first we couldn't really get anything going at the plate and that hasn't happened to us much all season," Rayder coach Allen Telgenhof said. "I was so proud of our guys - we couldn't buy a break, we were down and had a few calls go against us but they stayed in it and nearly pulled it out."

The visiting Rayders got on the

board first in the top half of the opening inning as Nate Moon, Shane Sutherland and JJ Bottomley all singled, Tommy Zipp walked just before Bottomley. Moon came home on Bottomley's hit. Charlevoix nearly added another run in the inning as Sutherland was called out trying to score on a wild pitch on a close play at the plate.

Negaunee would come right back in the bottom half of the inning as they capitalized on a few Rayder errors to take a 2-1 lead.

That would be all the scoring the rest of the way as the pitchers took over.

Charlevoix, down to their last at-bat in the top half of the seventh, and like so many times before this season, kept calm and let

the game come to them.

Bottomley was hit by a pitch to start the inning; he was lifted for pinch runner Hunter Cox. Cox was forced out at second as Jandron made what coach Telgenhof called the "play of the game" as he knocked down a hard-hit line shot up the middle by Will Telgenhof, and hustled off the mound to the ball and made a diving force-out at second to get Cox for the second out of the inning.

Will Telgenhof then moved up two bases and stood at third, just 90 feet away from tying the ballgame when Jandron recorded his 11th strikeout of the afternoon to secure the Miner victory and ending the Rayders season.

"It was a great season, and it's tough to see it end," coach Tel-

genhof said. "Tommy (Zipp) and Tag McCreadie, our two seniors, had great seasons and careers. They have a lot to be proud of."

"We'll be back next year with another solid team with a very good nucleus returning," the coach added. "They learned what it takes to win and hopefully can take the next step in 2014."

Zipp took the loss for the Rayders as he allowed two runs (one earned) on seven hits while walking one and striking out three. He finished the season with a 9-1 record.

Bottomley, Moon, and Sutherland had the only hits for Charlevoix.

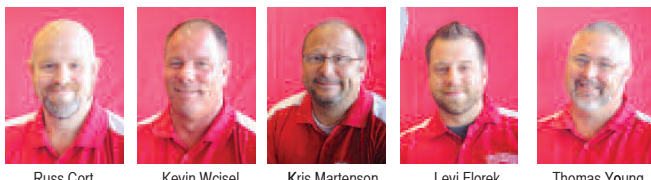

MUSKEGON — It didn't take long to figure out that the Muskegon West Michigan Christian Warriors were all business as they got on the board just 15 seconds into the contest en route to a 2-1 Division IV regional semifinal victory over the Rayders on June 5.

Forum will discuss Safe Routes to School

EAST JORDAN – Safe Routes To School (SRTS) proponents are hoping the program's four E's will earn all A's with parents, students and the entire community.

The SRTS Action Plan – whose elements include Education, Encouragement, Enforcement and Engineering – is to be presented during a forum at the East Jordan Middle School Library on Wednesday, June 12 from 6:00 until 7:30pm, and parent involvement is strongly encouraged. SRTS is a strategy recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to encourage children to walk and bike to school, and to ensure their communities are equipped with carefully-planned routes and other resources to help them do it safely. It was made possible in East Jordan through a grant from the Charlevoix County Community Foundation. The purpose of the forum will be to educate the community about SRTS objectives, development and implementation, according to Jim Harrington, the Safe Routes to School Consultant for the Health Department. The forum is open to anyone.

"East Jordan Elementary and Middle Schools have completed their walking audits," Harrington reported. "The schools have also completed surveys of students and parents on walking and biking behav-

iors and attitudes, which will be shared at the Forum. Our action plan calls for us to educate the public, encourage students and parents to participate, enforce controls that will keep kids safe, and engineer new solutions to overcome obstacles to these healthy behaviors."

East Jordan Middle School Principal Matt Stevenson said the process, to date, has been lengthy but worthwhile. "I am excited to be moving forward with our Safe Routes To School grant," said Stevenson, "and to hopefully be able to provide a safer environment for kids who want to walk to and from school on a daily basis."

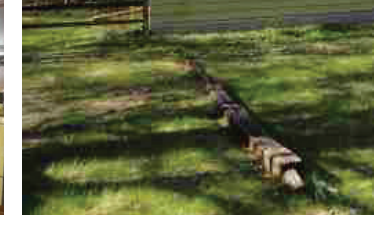

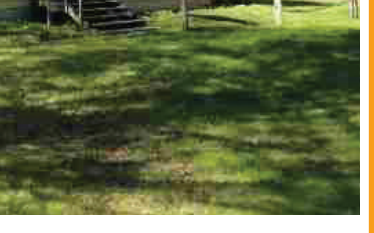
