Charlevoix's Zipp is Player of the Year Rayders Telgenhof is Coach of the Year

CHARLEVOIX COUNTY - With the 2013 area baseball season coming to a close just about two weeks ago, after examining all the nomi-

nations from the area coaches and weighing the strength of schedules and head-to-head match-ups, it has been determined that the Charlevoix Rayders hard throwing senior right-handed

pitcher/center fielder Tommy Zipp is the Charlevoix County News 2013 Player of the Year.

Zipp, the Rayders senior captain and clean-up hitter, had a .354 batting average with 28 hits in 79 at-bats; finished with eight doubles, two triples and a home-run; knocked in 30 RBIs, finished with a .594 slugging percentage. Tommy also scored 19 runs, walked three times and stole eight bases.

He played a flawless centerfield, committing zero errors for the second consecutive season.

Zipp led the Charlevoix pitching staff with a 9-1 record had a 1.93 earned run average, 65 strikeouts in 58 innings pitched, allowing 44 hits and 16 walks.

Tommy was voted the Rayders team MVP and along with Co-captain Shane Sutherland, helped instill a strong work ethic in the Charlevoix baseball program.

"I've had a lot of fun, it's hard to believe this was the last season of high school ball," Zipp said. "I also wanted to thank my dad for being a big influence, and glad I had the opportunity to have him as a coach."

Zipp will be attending Glen

Oaks Community College in the fall, and is penciled in to play centerfield for the Vikings. Tommy plans to concentrate his studies in the Health Field as he is currently undecided on a major. He will also be summer ball for the Petoskey Royals.

Coach Allen Telgenhof had this to say about Zipp. "They are cliches for a reason - before the season I said we'd go as far as our pitching and our seniors took us. Tommy took care of both of those things - as one of our two seniors and our #1 pitcher. To be honest, Tommy started the season as our #2 pitcher in my mind but he left no doubt that he was #1 all season long. He pitched our toughest games and was pretty much unbeatable. His only loss was a 2-1 loss in regionals - the first two batters he faced scored but after that he didn't give them anything. He was our cleanup hitter and our #1 starter and a tremendous centerfielder. He had a great season and a great career. His bases loaded double against Harbor Springs in the district was one of the biggest hits in school history - and it came with all the pressure on. I'm so happy

that he has achieved his goal and will be keeping his baseball career alive playing down at Glen Oaks Community College next season."

Joining Zipp on the All-Area baseball team are fellow Rayders Shane Sutherland, Nate Moon, Noah Certa and Will Telgenhof; Boyne City is represented by Elliott Hausler; Cody Elzinga, Jordan Fair and Nick Vellis; Boyne Falls boasts Marcus Matelski and Andrew Stevens; while the East Jordan trio of Matt Bolser, Tim Schut and Zach Shepard round out the team.

Charlevoix

Shane Sutherland, a junior co-captain, was the Rayders number two starting pitcher behind Zipp. Prior to tournament play, Shane was a perfect 7-0 on the mound, recording 49 K's in 47.1 innings of work with a 2.66 ERA. Allowing 48 hits and walked 22.

He also manned the shortstop position when he wasn't striking batters out. Shane finished with a .918 fielding percentage, only committing six errors all season.

He hit a respectable .346, finishing with 27 hits, including five doubles and a round-tripper; knocked in 24 RBIs, scored 29 runs, walked 11 times and had a .434 on-base percentage and stole 19 bases.

Noah Certa, a sophomore outfielder, led the team 37 hits in 92 at-bats for a .402 batting average from the leadoff spot, while also recording 24 RBIs. He doubled 11 times and scored 38 runs (school record), swiped 22 bases and walked 10 times finishing with a .452 OBA and a .513 slugging percentage.

Certa also only fanned three times in 92 plate appearances and did not commit an error in the outfield this season.

Nate Moon, a sophomore infielder/pitcher. Moon made the opposing pitching staffs pay if they left something close to the plate as he pounded out 35 hits in 92 appearances for a .380 average, with nine doubles, two triples and left the yard on three separate oc-

casions, including what coach Allen Telgenhof referred to as the longest home-run he had seen at the Charlevoix baseball field. Nate also scored 35 runs and added 28 RBIs. He also stole 19 bases, had a .422 OBA, and a .568 slugging percentage.

He also played solid defense on the left side of the infield at either shortstop or third base by only committing five errors for a .914 fielding percentage. On the mound he was 4-0, with 17 K's in 22 innings pitched for a 2.91 ERA, including a no-hitter vs Pellston.

Will Telgenhof, the Charlevoix sophomore catcher, and recognized by many as the best defensive catcher in the Lake Michigan Conference, committed only two errors for a .985 fielding percentage and threw out 17 runners attempting to steal.

Will had 23 hits, including four doubles for a .307 batting average with 16 RBIs on the season; he only fanned four times in 75 plate appearances, walked 10 times and finished with a .388 OBA. He crossed the plate 14 times and stole eight bases.

Elliot Hausler. The senior right-hander finished 5-3 with six complete this season for the Ramblers. He had a 1.49 ERA, fanning 52 batters in 47 innings.

At the plate Elliot batted .328 with 20 hits in 61 at-bats, including seven doubles and a triple. He also finished with 16 RBIs.

Hausler plans on attending North Central Michigan College in the fall, and is currently looking at travel ball options while working for the City of Boyne City.

"Everything went by so fast, I wished it would have slowed down (in reference to the last four years)" Hausler noted. "Baseball is by far my favorite sport."

Cody Elzinga. The senior

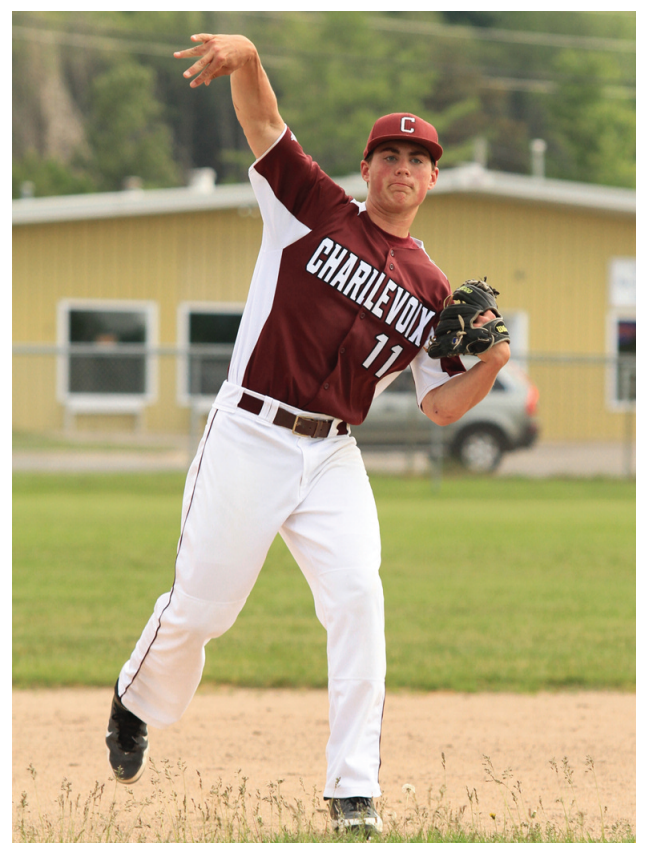
pitcher/first basemen, hit .322 with 12 RBIs. Cody recorded 19 hits in 59 at-bats, including three doubles.

On the mound Elzinga went 4-1 in 33 2/3 innings. Striking out 41 and walking 11.

Jordan Fair. Fair led the Ramblers with a .414 batting average, pounding out 29 hits in 70 at-bats. He led the team with 24 runs scored and hit seven doubles and two triples along with knocking in 13 RBIs.

Jordan was 2-0 pitching for Boyne this season, working 13 innings, and striking out 13, while allowing 10 hits. Fair had an on-base percentage of .488 and a slugging percentage of .571, tops on the team.

Nick Vellis. Vellis saw some action on the mound for BC this season. He went

2-3 in 21.1 innings of work, fanning 19 in the process.

At the dish, Nick hit .328 with 22 hits and 10 RBIs. He hit six doubles and two triples. His on-base percentage was .403.

Boyne Falls

Marcus Matelski. The Logger freshman in his second season on the varsity went 16 for 28 in the team's limited schedule this spring for a .571 average.

Matelski played first base when not on the mound for BF. Once on the mound though, Marcus tossed 17 innings for the young club, striking out 10.

"He has a live fastball and throws strikes," coach Bill Montgomery said. Andrew finished 16 of 27 for a .593 batting average.

Stevens pitched and played catcher for the Loggers. Tossing 18 innings, and fanning 13.

Behind the plate, Stevens would change the game, by throwing out would be base stealers, and fielding his position well.

He was also credited by coach Montgomery with how well he managed the game from the position.

East Jordan

Matt Bolser. The lefty pitcher/outfielder kept teams off balance with his mixture of pitches this season. He ended up 3-3 with one save. Matt tossed 50 plus innings of ball for the Red Devils, striking out 51 and carried an ERA of 3.78. Matt plans to attend

Northwestern Michigan College in the fall and seek a degree in business administration.

A highlight this season came when Bolser toss 10 innings in a 5-4 win over TC St. Francis, a game in which he fanned 13 batters.

Matt hit .366 with a pair of doubles and a triple to go with nine RBIs, scored six runs and finished with a .463 slugging percentage.

“Matt will most definitely be missed as he graduates this year,” EJ coach Tom Reid Jr. said. “He is a very mature young man who has led this team by example. Matt has put a lot of extra work in by attending pitching and hitting clinics and it has all come together for him this year. He has relished his role as the pitching staff ace...always giving our squad a chance to win.”

Tim Schut. A junior outfielder for the Red Devils, led the team in a high percentage of every offensive

category.

Tim hit .450, including seven doubles, a triple and a pair of home-runs. Schut also drove in 14 runs and scored 17 more of his own. His slugging percentage is .825 and he also swiped five bases.

“Tim has provided us with a lot of pop hitting out of the three hole,” coach Reid Jr. said. “He draws a lot of walks as well and always finds a way to get on base. Defensively, he has been solid in his first full year in the outfield. He has a very strong arm and has cut down a few base runners over the season. Tim is a legitimate five-tool player who has quietly put together a great season for us. I can’t wait to see what his senior season brings next year after he attends a camp or two this summer and adds that to his already impressive arsenal.”

Zach Shepard. The hard hitting senior first-basemen was another important piece to the puzzle for the Red Devils.

Zach has held that position on the right side of the infield for the past three seasons for EJ.

Shepard was the clean-up hitter all season, batting at a .381 clip with two doubles and a home-run.

Zach had 10 RBIs, scored five runs, swiped three bases and had a .500 slugging percentage.

“He has been the mark of consistency for us as our true power hitting first baseman. Quietly leading by example, Zach’s bat is far from quiet,” coach Reid Jr. said. “Zach is the one guy who seems to square up the little round ball every time he connects. The underclassmen watch in awe when Zach hits batting practice.”

Coach of the Year

Allen Telgenhof, Charlevoix.

This wasn’t a difficult decision as the Rayders and their coach enjoyed the best season in school history, finishing 27-3 overall, 14-0 in the Lake Michigan Conference.

Charlevoix seemed to get in a groove right off the bat so to speak, and kept connecting pretty much every time they came up to hit and the coach was right there all along to help keep the ship moving in the right direction.

“I would just say that it’s funny, this season was probably the easiest coaching job that I had. This team was very special - they came to practice every day knowing our system, knowing how we want to practice and how we want to play and they continued a great work ethic that will be with us for years to come,” coach Telgenhof said. “When it came to game time, they were true gamers. They never thought they’d lose any game and even when we were ranked and the target was on our backs, they didn’t back down. They almost reveled in it. I am so happy that they will have those memories forever. 14-0 in our league is tough to do - I can’t remember the last time someone did that. They are a very,

very special group of guys.”

With the loss of two seniors, Zipp and Tag McCreadie, look for the Rayders to once again make some more noise next season and they don’t

care if the other teams know it, they will be ready.

The All-Area team is selected based on coach nominations, the student-athletes character and statistical data.

Coaching program helps reduce abusive behaviors

More and more men and women are becoming aware of the pervasive societal problem of violence against women and girls, yet what can concerned community members do to help reduce intimate partner/dating violence and sexual assault?

One solution may exist with the coaches of our recreational and school sports programs. A year-long study that appeared recently in the American Journal of Preventative Medicine showed that a program called Coaching Boys into Men (CBIM) is effective in reducing abusive behaviors among male athletes toward their female partners.

The study looked at more than

2,000 male high school athletes that participated in the coach-led CBIM program that aims to prevent abuse toward women and girls. Results showed youth that participated in the program were less likely to support peers' abusive behavior and showed a significant relative reduction in abuse perpetration.

The CBIM program, created by a national non-profit organization called Futures Without Violence, works with coaches because they are in a unique position to positively influence and teach male athletes about building healthy relationships and how to intervene when witnessing disrespectful and abusive behaviors among their peers.

CBIM is a program that has

been presented to coaches and educators, locally, via workshops and teacher in-service programs by representatives of the Women's Resource Center of Northern Michigan (WRCNM) and members of the agency's volunteer community Violence Prevention Team.

Coaches utilize a "playbook" to help integrate lessons of respect and relationships into their coaching program to positively impact how young men think and behave on and off the athletic field. The playbook provides "teach-easy" tactics and teachable moments to help illustrate ways to role model and promote healthy choices and relationships among youth. The curriculum guides coaches on how to

build character and promote positive bystander behavior (skills to interrupt peers' abusive behaviors) in young men through teamwork, sportsmanship, integrity, and respect.

"The key to this program is respect—teaching players to be aware of how they treat women and how to deal with all people in general," said Mike Alberghini, head football coach at Grant Union High School in Sacramento, California, a participating school in the study. "The experience has brought us together as a stronger, more responsible group."

The CBIM program is one proven tool we can use in the effort to end violence against women and girls. Every parent,

school administrator, counselor, teacher, athletic director and coach should strive to implement this valuable program to help build respectful, non-violent relationships among young people in our communities. These young people will help influence their peers and go on to influence others as adults.

At the conclusion of the tournament, 13 fishermen caught their five bass limit and all but two weighed in.

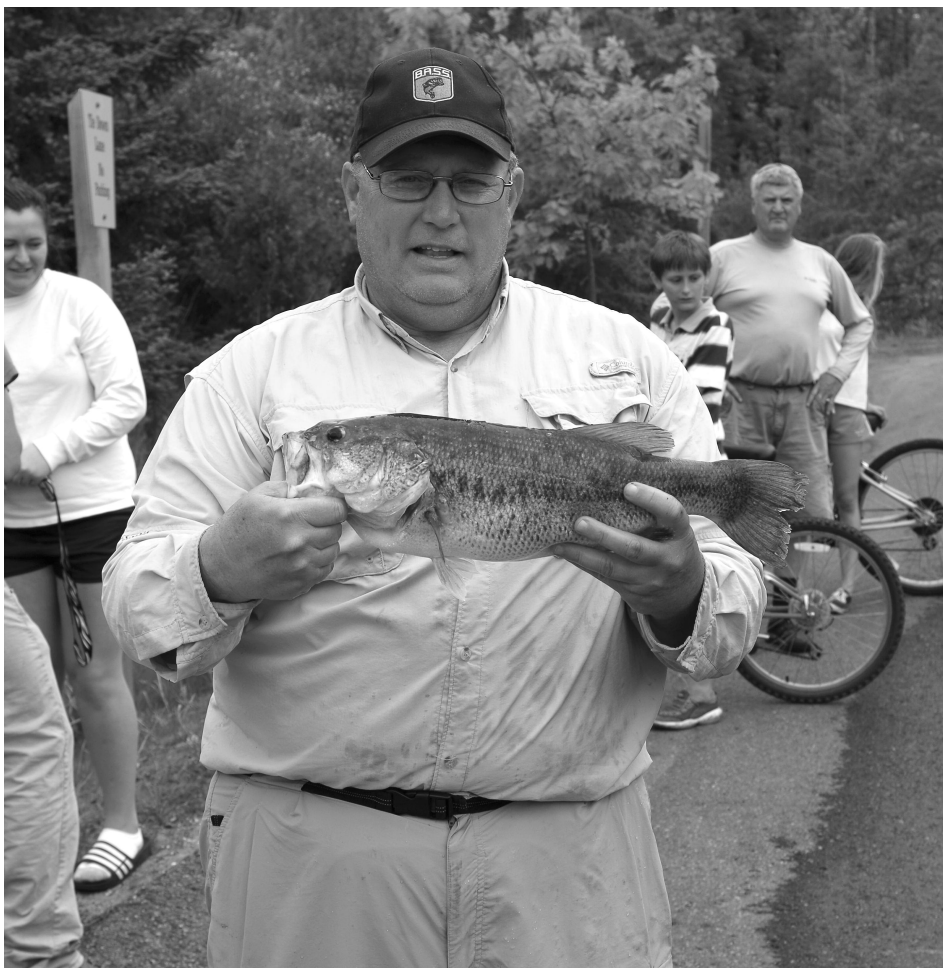

DNR NEWS: Protected forest land in Charlevoix County

DNR announces that 750 acres of forest and Thumb Lake frontage in county will be protected under Forest Legacy program

CHARLEVOIX COUNTY — The Department of Natural Resources announced this week that approximately 750 acres and nearly three-quarters of a mile of Thumb Lake frontage in Charlevoix County will be protected, available for public use and managed as a working forest thanks to a Forest Legacy Program grant award.

The project, known as the Gitcha-ninj Nebish Forest (Ottawa for "Big Finger Water"), includes the state acquisition of a

conservation easement on 750 acres of rolling northern hardwood forests that is strategically positioned to connect larger blocks of protected lands and habitats. The property is adjacent to state forest land on three sides and contains the Thumb Lake frontage on the fourth side.

Bill O'Neill, chief of the DNR's Forest Resources Division, said state acquisition of the conservation easement means that the property will stay in private ownership, but will be open for public recreational use and will be managed as a working forest under a forest management plan approved by the state forester.

"Whether you enjoy hunting, fishing, bird watching, hiking or

one of the many other recreational opportunities our forest land has to offer, this project ensures this area will be sustainably managed for the enjoyment of current and future users," said O'Neill, who also serves as Michigan's state forester. "In addition to protecting the recreational values of the land, this project also takes into account protection of wildlife habitat and ensures sustainable timber management continues on the property. This is great news for all forest stakeholders."

Along with sustainable forest management and public recreational access, the Gitcha-ninj Nebish Forest project will:

- * Help to protect a portion of

the tri-county fall color tour area along Thumb Lake Road (County Road 48);

- * Protect the drinking water quality in the area, as the property is located in a high-ground water recharge area; and

- * Offer the potential for hikers on the North Country National Scenic Trail, located on nearby state forest land, the opportunity to hike to Thumb Lake.

The purpose of the Forest Legacy Program, which is providing 75 percent of the funding for this project, is to ascertain and protect environmentally important forest areas that are threatened by conversion to non-forest uses. The Forest Legacy Program seeks to promote forest-

land protection and other conservation opportunities. The program, nationally competitive and administered by the U.S. Forest Service, is funded through the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

O'Neill said that with the grant funds now awarded, the DNR will begin the detailed work with the landowner and project partner, Little Traverse Conservancy, so that the project can be successfully completed.

The Department of Human Services and partners announce new measures to safeguard vulnerable adults

The Department of Human Services is pleased to announce the Michigan Model Vulnerable Adult Protocol, or MI-MVP. The new protocol becomes the standard for the joint investigation of vulnerable adult abuse, neglect and exploitation statewide. MI-MVP was officially unveiled by DHS Director Maura Corrigan at the Michigan Summit on Elder Justice/At-Risk Adults held today in Grand Blanc.

MI-MVP is a collaboration involving DHS, the Michigan Attorney General's office, The Michigan State Police and the Office of Services to the Aging. The new protocol is mandated under PA 175 of 2012, Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.11(b).

Elder abuse and adult victimization is increasing across Michigan.

In fiscal year 2012, Adult Protective Services (APS) received over 25,000 referrals alleging abuse, neglect or exploitation of individuals over the age of 18. These residents may be unable to protect themselves due to dementia, mental illness or physical disability.

APS anticipates that number of referrals to climb closer to 30,000 in fiscal year 2013.

None of those calls take into account contacts made by law enforcement, emergency medical services, and others that don't come directly into APS.

By using the new protocol, MI-MVP will help local communities protect and serve older and vulnerable persons. The investigation of cases involving the victimization of these individuals will follow by increased collaboration

and communication among agencies. Ideally, the protocol will also allow for local communities to customize and adapt it, as needed, based on their own unique resources and needs.

"Prior to this protocol, the law mandated that Adult Protective Services investigate and give its report to the prosecutor, not necessarily to law enforcement, and vice versa," said Corrigan. "Now, we have streamlined the process, and will share information from the beginning in these cases. That's a great start toward helping safeguard this vulnerable population."

MI-MVP will also allow, for the first time, protective services workers to take photographs during their investigation with the consent of the client. The goal will be to increase overall awareness between law enforcement and APS in reviewing a situation for criminal activity, so that more and better prosecution occurs thanks to better communication and partnering in all cases.

"Protecting seniors and our most vulnerable requires a team effort," said Bill Schuette, Michigan Attorney General. "We're pleased to announce this new approach to guide those who protect and serve our seniors every day."

DHS remains dedicated to working closely with our partners, public and private, along with local communities to ensure protection and improved services to our vulnerable adult population.

West Nile Virus Activity Detected in Michigan

As the weather warms up and people begin to spend more time outdoors, Michigan residents should protect themselves from mosquito bites. The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) would like to remind people, especially those spending time outdoors and children at camps, to protect themselves from mosquito illnesses by taking a few precautionary steps.

Mosquitoes in Michigan can carry illnesses such as West Nile Virus (WNV) and Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE). Mosquito-borne diseases can cause mild symptoms, severe infections requiring hospitalization, and even death. West Nile virus was recently detected in a wild turkey from Gratiot County. The turkey, which was reported to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, and confirmed positive by the Michigan State University Diagnostic Center for Population & Animal Health is the first WNV positive animal detected in Michigan for 2013.

The Culex species of mosquito that transmits WNV in Michigan thrives in hot, dry climates because it breeds in stagnant water that has not been flushed out by periodic heavy rain. With the drought conditions last summer, there were a large number of human WNV cases throughout the nation and in Michigan. Last year, WNV was responsible for 202 illnesses and 17 fatalities reported in Michigan. Nationally 5,674 WNV cases and 286 deaths were reported to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).



"One bite from an infected mosquito can lead to a severe and possibly life-altering illness. We know that prevention is key to protection," says Dr. Matthew Davis, Chief Medical Executive at the MDCH. "Taking a few minutes to protect ourselves and our loved ones from mosquito bites can make a big difference."

Protection is as easy as remembering to take these simple steps:

1. Avoid mosquito bites: Use insect repellent when outdoors especially from dusk to dawn. Look for EPA-labeled products containing active ingredients, such as DEET, Picaridin, or oil of lemon eucalyptus. Apply more repellent, according to label instructions, if mosquitoes start to bite.
2. Mosquito-proof homes: Fix or install window and door screens and cover or eliminate

empty containers with standing water where mosquitoes can lay eggs.

3. Help your community: Report dead birds to Michigan's West Nile website (www.michigan.gov/westnile) to help track WNV and support community-based mosquito control programs.

4. Horse owners should vaccinate their horses. Horses can be infected too. Vaccines for WNV and EEE are readily available and should be repeated at least annually. Talk to your veterinarian for details.

"When seniors and individuals with disabilities become eligible for Medicare they are presented with a huge number of choices. Our counselors are trained and certified under standards established by Medicare to provide help to beneficiaries in making these important decisions, stated Verville."

Verville said, "all of our staff, whether paid or volunteer, have a big heart for seniors and want to

give of their time and expertise to help them". MMAP team members are not affiliated with any insurance company and provide a list of plan options that are available to beneficiaries based on their particular set of circumstances. In addition, help is provided to beneficiaries on billing issues, fraud and abuse complaints, appeals, and countless other areas of concern. There are 45 MMAP counselors located throughout Region 10 that includes the counties of Antrim, Benzie, Charlevoix, Emmet, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, Leelanau, Manistee, Missaukee, and Wexford. MMAP services are al-

ways free to beneficiaries.

The regional MMAP effort is hosted by the Area Agency on Aging in Traverse City and sponsored locally by the various County Commissions and Councils on Aging and other private care giving organizations. 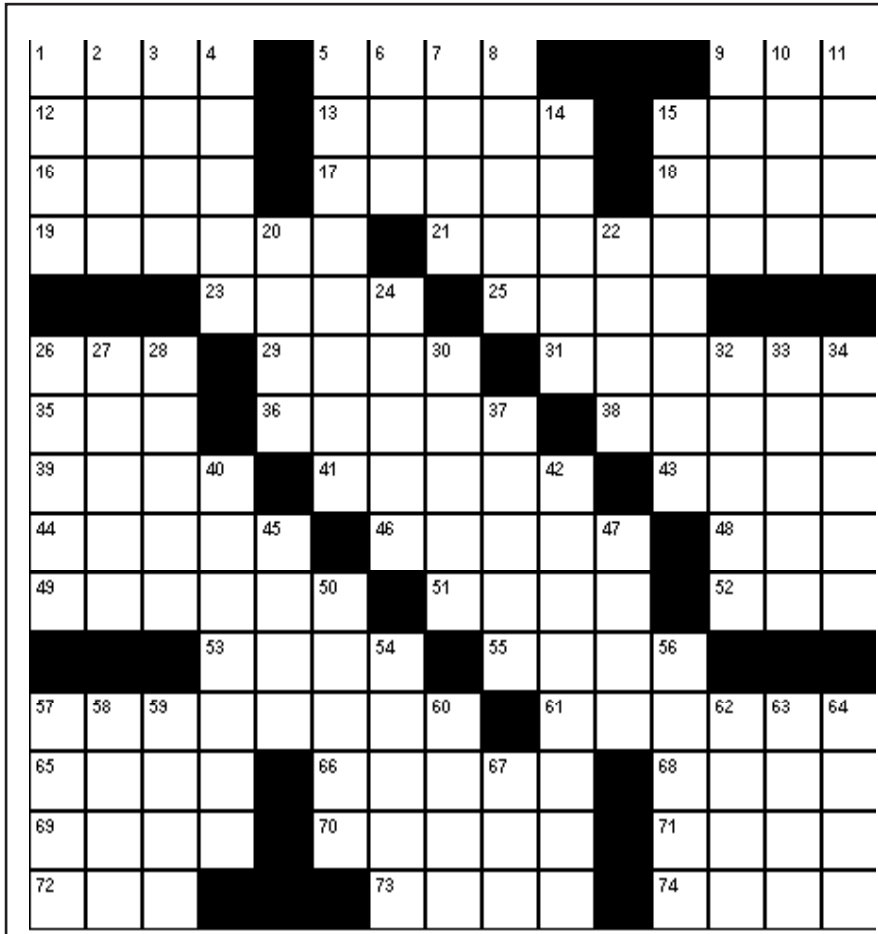
