Boyne Bandits capture Soo 16U softball tournament

SAULT STE. MARIE — The Boyne Bandits, a first year 16 and under travel Boyne City team out of the Boyne City area, went 2-1-1 to take first place in the annual Sault Ste. Marie travel team tournament over the July 20-21 weekend.

In the opening contest Boyne outgunned the hosting Soo team with an 8-2 victory.

Katelyn Banner picked up the win going the distance, allowing two earned runs on three hits, walking five and striking out four.

At the plate, Emma Vondra supplied the big blow, going yard for a two-run homer at LSSU's softball field. Vondra also added a double.

Celena Brzezinski chipped in with three hits including a double, while Rainy McCune tripled among her two hits, and Hannah Hoth doubled.

Game two saw the Bandits edge the Petoskey Blaze 4-3.

Petoskey took a 3-0 lead after one half inning of play only to see Boyne come roaring back with a three spot of their own.

Rainy McCune picked up both of Boyne's hits in the game, a single and the game winner, a solo home run.

Emma Shumaker earned the pitching win, allowing seven hits, six walks and fanned six.

In game three Boyne City tied the Blaze 7-7 as Petoskey scored in the final inning to force the tie.

Shumaker allowed 11 hits, walked two and struck out six.

Offensively, Banner and McCune each pounded out three hits, Brzezinski added two and Hoth singled. Sarah Longcore hit the third Boyne home run of the tournament with a blast to straight away center.

In their final contest of the tourney, the Bandits fell 8-3 to the Soo.

Shumaker started and worked two innings, striking out three and walking four. Banner finished the game, allowing five runs on two hits and walked five.

The Drenth Memorial Foot Race and Ryan Shay Mile

CHARLEVOIX — The 35th annual Jeff Drenth Memorial Foot Race will take place at 9 a.m. on Saturday, July 27. The 5K and 10K races will begin at the corner of State St. and Park Ave.

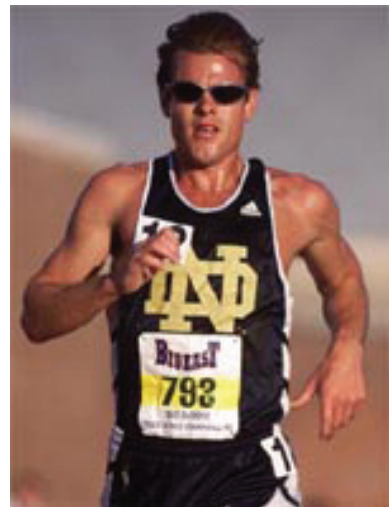
The 5K and 10K courses are fast, unique courses and bring to the runners the beauty that is Northern Michigan. The participants will run through many beautiful areas along the channel of Lake Michigan to Lake Charlevoix, including many of the scenic and historic houses, East Park, along the Belvedere Club to the finish line in front of a crowd awaiting the beginning of the Venetian Festival Parade.

The Memorial race is held in memory of Jeff Drenth who attended Charlevoix High School, graduating in 1979. He competed in cross-country and track while in school earning All-State status in the former during his senior year. Jeff continued his running career at Central Michigan University, twice winning the individual MAC conference championship in cross country, and earning All-American status in cross country in 1982. He remains a school record holder in the 10,000-meter event.

After graduating from C.M.U. with a teaching degree, Jeff embarked on his professional running career. He competed for the Nike-sponsored Athletics West club based in Eugene, Oregon. He represented the United States on three different occasions as a member of the world cross-country team. He also competed at the 1984 Olympic Trials in the 10,000-

meter event.

Jeff passed away at the Athletics West headquarters in 1986. The cause of his death was unknown.

Jeff was a mentor and friend to many in his hometown, and around the country.

Also featured is the "Family Mile" which starts and finishes in downtown Charlevoix. The event can be enjoyed by all those interested in participating from walkers to joggers with strollers. All participants in these events will receive a medal.

The 6th annual Ryan Shay Mile follows the previous events and is an "invite only" event. The race is a top race priority for many top distance runners.

The Ryan Shay Mile started in the summer of 2008 to honor the memory of Ryan Shay. Ryan passed away on November 3, 2007 while competing in the 2008 U.S. Olympic Marathon Trials in New York City. Ryan was from Central Lake, Michigan about thirty minutes south of Charlevoix. A talented runner, who through hard work and persistence, won championships in high school, in college while at Notre Dame, and in the professional ranks. Ryan was

and is a role model for many young people in Northern Michigan and around the country.

Why you should practice yoga

The term “yoga,” as commonly used in the West, refers to a series of poses or postures, known as asanas. Yoga has its origins in the East, but is becoming increasingly popular in the West. In the US, it is estimated that the numbers of those practicing yoga rose from 4 million to 20 million between 2001 and 2011. Do you practice yoga? If not, here are some reasons why you should!

Increased Flexibility and Improved Joint Range of Motion. This is an obvious one and a primary reason for doing yoga. Flexibility is referred to as the third pillar of fitness. Flexibility, strength training and cardiovascular activity are all important for balanced fitness. Often aches and pains related to stiffness will diminish as flexibility improves. Tightness in the hips can disrupt the alignment of the thigh and shin and strain the knee joint. Inflexibility in muscles and connective tissues can result in poor posture. Persons with arthritis or others with a limited range of motion stand to benefit the most from yoga. Participants are encouraged to listen to their bodies and do what they can - yoga is not a competitive sport! Each attempt at a yoga pose is an opportunity to do more. Poses that seem impossible the first time you do yoga will become more easier each time you practice.

Increased Muscle Strength and Tone. Yoga doesn't use barbells or dumbbells. Instead, yoga uses the weight of the body to increase muscle strength. Adults begin to lose muscle mass as early as age 25. Without continued activity, the body will weaken. Yoga is particularly beneficial for strength training as the movements combine strength training with flexibility, reducing the risk of injury and helping to achieve better overall balanced fitness.

Increased Bone Density. Weight bearing exercise like yoga increases bone density, helping to reduce the risk of osteoporosis and bone fractures. Yoga poses such as downward and upward facing dog require putting substantial weight on the arms, helping to maintain and improve the density of bones in the arms.

Improved Cardio and Circulatory Health. Yoga is more than just a series of poses. Yoga incorporates controlled breathing and calming the mind throughout the practice. Cardio health is improved through gently working the muscles and deep breathing slows the breathing rate, lowers blood pressure and calms the sympathetic nervous system, reducing the production of stress hormones. Yoga improves circulatory health by increasing blood flow to the muscles.

Yoga is appropriate for people with all levels of physical ability. Those with physical limitations can also benefit from yoga. Lisa O'Keefe was seriously injured in 2005 when the vehicle she was driving was struck by a drunk driver. She has been practicing yoga for nine years. Following her accident, she had to significantly reduce the intensity of her yoga poses to avoid further injury to her spine. She discontinued yoga entirely two years ago due to slipped disks in her back. She resumed yoga six months ago and finds it “gentle and fluid yet requiring great strength and flexibility,” and helpful for remembering to be mindful of her body and its limitations. She finds the Downward Dog pose helpful for lengthening the spine and stretching the shoulders.

These are just a few of the physical benefits of yoga. If you are ready to get started, and in the Gaylord area, can attend classes taught by Sharon Wegmeyer. Cool tips for hot weather

□ Turn your air conditioner off during a power outage. Turn it back on only after power is restored to avoid overloading electrical circuits in the home as other appliances come back on.

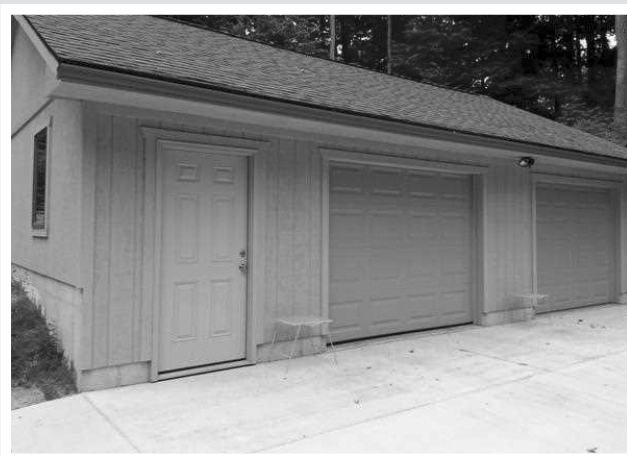
