Drenth Memorial and Ryan Shay Mile Race Results

CHARLEVOIX — The much anticipated and competitive Ryan Shay Mile once again had a field full of top notch competition. Defending race winners Daniel Clark of Jackson, MI and Heather Kampf of Indianapolis, IN and formally of Minnesota looked to compete once again for their respective titles.

When it was all said and done (and rather quickly too) Clark, with a time of 3:56.85, and Kampf, 4:30.96, stood at the top of their classes once again.

"It's great to win it, especially in honor of Ryan because I knew him," Clark said. "He was an in-

spiration to me in high school, then I went to the same college (Notre Dame) so I saw him a little bit as a freshman when he came back as a professional. It's great to run in his honor.

Both Clark and Kampf bested their times of (Clark - 3:58) and (Kampf - 4:31) from a year ago.

Clark is a graduate of Notre Dame, the same University that Ryan Shay attended, while Kampf runs for Team USA Minnesota.

When asked how it felt to win it for the second consecutive year Kampf replied, "Genna Gall and I were back and forth a lot throughout the years in college and professionally, and I didn't know how close she was going to

be so I had to really give it my all at the end, but it was a good race."

Runners up in the men's race were Macklin Chaffee - 3:57.83; followed by Tony Jordanek in 3:59.08; Josh McAlary, 4:00.08; Dey Dey, 4:00.09; Daniel Stockberger, 4:15.25; and Tony Filapek, 4:15.59.

In the women's race, following Kampf was, Geena Gall in 4:31.49; then Shannon Osika, 4:34.24; Lauren Johnson, 4:38.64; Chemtai Ri-onotukei, 4:44.49; and Sara Barron, 5:05.75.

In the Drenth Memorial 5K, George O'Connor of Crosswell, MI was the overall men's winner in 15:52, while Kelsey Duerksen of Ann Arbor, MI crossed the finish

line in 17:19 to pace the women's portion.

Top five overall finishers in the 5K were; Men's - (2) Benjamin Reed of Hemlock, MI - 16:02; (3) Luke Hawley of East Jordan in 16:05; (4) Tommy Osika of Waterford, MI - 16:15; and (5) Andrew O'Connor of Crosswell, MI in 16:17.

Women's - (2) Kelly Schubert of Free Soil, MI in 17:37; (3) Kali Dent of Midland, MI - 17:55; (4) Amber Way of Charlevoix in 18:03; and (5) Tina Smith of Hillsdale, MI - 18:58.

In the 10K portion, Colin Riley of Northville, MI won the men's race in a blistering 34:22, while Kirsten Olling of Breckenridge,

MI was the women's winner in 37:06.

Top five overall winners in each division were; Men's - (2) Tim McClure of Charlevoix in 34:23; (3) Kyle Barnes of Eastport, MI in 34:36; (4) Brock Eves of Hillsdale, MI - 36:06; and (5) Murphy Reese of Charlevoix in 37:05.

Women's runners up were; (2) Xavier Donajkowski of Hubbard Lake, MI - 37:58; (3) Cassidy Clark of Grand Rapids, MI in 37:59; (4) Michelle Weymouth of Washington, MI in 41:57; and (5) Julie Hoopes, Denver, CO - 42:17.


Olympic medalist swimmer, Amanda Beard will offer public presentations in Charlevoix this weekend

MDHA introduces 2013 duck stamp

Proceeds from sale of waterfowl stamp benefit MDHA projects with 10 percent matching DNR funds for purchase of wetlands



The Michigan Duck Hunters Association (MDHA), in cooperation with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR), has introduced the 2013 collector-edition Michigan duck stamp and prints.

The 2013 Michigan duck stamp, by wildlife artist Richard Clifton, features a beautiful black duck displayed in a swimming pose. For information about pricing and how to order duck stamps and prints, see Michigan waterfowl stamp order form, available online at www.michigan.gov/waterfowl (click on the Waterfowl Stamp Program link).

Proceeds from stamp and print sales will be used to fund MDHA projects, with 10 percent used to match DNR funding for purchasing wetlands.

"The waterfowl stamp program is a valuable partnership between the DNR and the Michigan Duck Hunters Association, and helps ensure continued acquisition of wetlands and programs to improve habitat," said Barbara Avers, DNR waterfowl and wetland specialist. "Buying stamps and prints is a great way for waterfowl hunters and others to contribute to wetlands conservation."

Purchase of these collector-edition stamps is voluntary and does not replace the state waterfowl hunting license. MDHA will mail those who purchase a 2013 waterfowl hunting license a free copy of the stamp (subject to availability) if they send a self-addressed, stamped envelope with a copy of their Michigan waterfowl hunting license to: Michigan Duck Hunters Association, Waterfowl Stamp Program, P.O. Box 20, Midland, MI 48640.

Established in 1976 and coordinated by the MDHA in partnership with the DNR, the Michigan Waterfowl Stamp Program has become an icon for waterfowl hunters and wetland conservation enthusiasts. During the past 31 years, the program has gained popularity with collectors and conservation groups throughout the United States.

Richard Clifton is a self-taught wildlife artist who has painted 30 duck stamps for various states, as well as the 1996 Australian duck stamp and the 2007-2008 federal duck stamp.

The announcement of the 2013 waterfowl stamp continues the celebration of the Michigan Waterfowl Legacy (MWL) "Year of the Duck." DNR postpones sale of Wolf hunting Licenses

The Department of Natural Resources today announced that it has postponed the sale of wolf hunting licenses - originally scheduled to begin Aug. 3 - until Sept. 28 to ensure that license-sales technology is able to handle the expected high demand.

"We anticipate that there will be a lot of people trying to buy a very limited number of licenses in a short timeframe," said Adam Bump, DNR bear and furbearer specialist. "This is a first-come, first-served purchase, unlike other limited-license hunts that require an application and drawing process, so it presents a new chal-

lenge for our retail sales system. We want to make sure the system is equipped for the high volume so sales go smoothly and everyone has an equal chance to get a wolf license."

Bump said that, in addition to ensuring that technology is up to speed, the DNR is working to put adequate Saturday staffing in place to make the license-buying process as fair and efficient as possible.

A total of 1,200 wolf licenses will be available for purchase beginning Sept. 28 at noon EDT (11 a.m. CDT) until Oct. 31, or until the license quota is met. Wolf licenses

cost \$100 for residents and \$500 for nonresidents.

Wolf hunting season still will begin on Nov. 15. For more information about regulations, see the 2013 Wolf Hunting Digest, available online at www.michigan.gov/dnrdigests or at any location DNR licenses are sold.

Why you should practice yoga: Psychological Benefits

The word yoga comes from the Sanskrit for Yoke, or union. In practicing yoga, the goal is to unite the body and mind. More than 18 million American practice yoga, either in classes or at home.

The regular practice of yoga will have numerous physical benefits, including increased flexibility, muscle strength and tone and increased bone density. Yoga can also improve joint range of motion, posture, balance and cardio and circulatory health. Yoga can reduce high blood pressure, normalize sugar levels, and improve both energy levels and sleep. Yoga is effective for pain management, boosting immunity and in preventing osteoporosis. In addition to the many physical benefits, yoga can also improve mental health. Working both physical and mental aspects simultaneously, a yoga practice helps to create balance in the body and mind.

Stress reduction. In yoga, the focus is on breathing and maintaining and advancing the various poses to the best of ones ability. By limiting the mental focus, you are encouraged to clear your mind of other thoughts. Yoga is found to reduce levels of cortisol, the stress hormone.

Lisa O'Keefe, 36, who experienced near-constant pain following a severe car accident in 2005, talks about how beneficial it is to focus on her breathing during yoga. "I love that yoga brings focus to the breath, so that even when a pose is difficult, being mindful of my breathing helps me to hold the pose without paying attention to how hard my muscles are working. This is also helpful when I'm having a lot of pain; if I can focus on my breath, I can breathe through the pain and relax into it instead of fighting against it. This is helpful with all types of pain: emotional, physical, mental . . . breathing deeply from the belly helps us detoxify, de-stress and energize our bodies."

Improved mental sharpness and learning efficiency. Regular practice of yoga has been found to improve memory, concentration, and learning efficiency. Researchers have also found that yoga can be effective in treating Alzheimer's disease. Yoga has been found to reduce test anxiety and improve academic performance in elementary school students.

Improved mood, decreased anxiety and reduction or elimination of depression. The regular practice of yoga is linked to an increase in serotonin, the "feel good" hormone. Researchers have found increases in the neurotransmitter GABA following an hour of yoga. Yoga has also been found to be beneficial as a treatment for post-traumatic stress disorder. Research on soldiers with PTSD returning from Afghanistan and Iraq used a nine-week, twice weekly yoga-based program. At the end of the program, participants reported reduced insomnia, depression, anxiety and

fear and an increased sense of control over their lives.

Nancy Beaver, 55 years old, has been practicing yoga regularly for 15 years. She purchased DVDs at first, then took classes at a local gym to reassure herself that she was had the poses correct. What does she find most useful about yoga? "Centering. Focusing. Moving from the inside out." These became particularly important to her after two major events: the car accident that nearly took the life of her daughter, Lisa, and the death of her son, Brian.

Nancy explained, "I've always worked out, but after Lisa's accident and then Brian's death, I didn't work out much at all. I was mad. I was sad. I wanted an-

swers. I realized my main goal in working out was more to look good than to feel good. It didn't matter how I looked if I was sad. I made a decision: to find answers, to make sense of things, to be happy again."

She fixed up a room in her house, her yoga room. She covered the walls in pictures of the people she loves. She feels "surrounded by love and peace there," as she practices daily meditation and yoga.

If all of that is not enough, remember that yoga is non-competitive and low-impact. Anyone can start at any time and everyone proceeds at their own pace. Improvement is entirely specific to the individual.

Nancy's recommendations to anyone just starting out, "Truly listen to your own body. Don't push yourself to keep up with the instructor or your classmates. It's your practice. Trust in yourself."

How frequently is "regular" yoga practice? Experts say that some is better than none, but three thirty-minute sessions per week will have you noticing improvements right away. Shorter sessions (around thirty minutes) more frequently are better than fewer, longer sessions. If you are ready to get started, those in the Gaylord area can attend classes taught by Sharon Wegmeyer in the community room at Saturn Books. Beginners are welcome at any time.




