Ramblers outgun rival Rayders

Boyne City 45, Charlevoix 14

CHARLEVOIX — Boyne City earned a return trip to the post-season with a convincing 45-14 win over rival Charlevoix, on October 11 at Charlevoix's Kipke Field.

Winners of six straight, the Ramblers upped their season record to 6-1 overall, 4-0 Lake Michigan Conference, while the Rayders dropped their sixth straight contest to slip to 1-6, 0-4.

The Ramblers struck first as they marched 70 yards downfield with Corey Redman calling his own number just under two minutes into the contest and rolling out to the right and sprinting to the end zone for a 25 yard score and a 6-0 Rambler lead as the point after attempt was blocked by the Rayders.

Boyne's Max Cuper would then recover a Rayder fumble on Charlevoix's next possession but were unable to punch it in as Redman was sacked on fourth and three from the 17-yard line, firing up the Rayder faithful.

The Rayders would then go four and out, but following their punt the Charlevoix defense would hold strong again stopping Boyne on fourth down and taking over on downs at the Rayder 10-yard line.

Shane Sutherland and quarterback Luke Klinger would then try and give Charlevoix some breathing room but both were stuffed at the line of scrimmage on second and third down as the Rambler defense sniffed out both plays.

On third and 10, Klinger went to the air and found a streaking Will Telgenhof down the right

sideline for a 90-yard touchdown pass and following a successful point after attempt; it was Charlevoix 7, Boyne City 6 with 2:28 remaining in the opening quarter.

In the second quarter, the Ramblers would get down to business as their defense recovered a fumble on the Rayders first play of

the quarter, and then following a Luke Sage touchdown run for Boyne; the Redman to Maceo Vroman connection took off, resulting in three touchdown receptions on gains of 69, 10 and six yards as the Ramblers scored 27 unanswered points for a 33-7 halftime advantage.

The third quarter would see Charlevoix try to claw back in as Sam Hovie pounded his way in from the 2-yard line with 2:56 left in the quarter and following the extra-point kick it was 33-14 Ramblers.

Boyne would tack on their final two scores of the evening the fourth quarter as Redman found a wide-open Cole Butler down the

right sideline as the tight-end took it in from 42-yards out after regaining his balance after stretching out for the ball.

Sage would add another Rambler score for the final 45-14.

The Rambler offense was led by Redman, as he finished 6-of-11 passing for 152 yards, four touchdowns and a pick. Vroman hauled in three catches for 85 yards, while Butler added 42 yards receiving.

Sage carried 25 times for 119 yards and Brad Fouchia chipped in with 70 yards on six carries.

Defensively for Boyne, Cuper led the Ramblers with 11 stops; Sage had 10 tackles and Vroman six. Cuper and Vroman each had

fumble recoveries, while Fouchia had an interception.

For the Rayders, Klinger went 4-of-7 passing for 115 yards and Nate Moon finished 6-of-10 for 120 yards through the air. Telgenhof finished with a game-high 176 yards receiving on five catches.

Shane Sutherland had 11 tackles to lead the Rayder defense, while Klinger added an interception.

Boyne City plays host to Elk Rapids on October 18 at Earl Brotherston field, while Charlevoix welcomes Harbor Springs to Kipke Field. Game times are 7pm.

The Charlevoix defense led by Bryan Noirot (21) and Will Telgenhof (3) wrap up Rambler running back Luke Sage for a loss.

DNR stresses tree stand safety

Take precautions when hunting deer from tree stand or elevated platform

As hunters head to the woods for the archery deer season, Michigan conservation officers are stressing safety for those hunting from tree stands or elevated platforms.

"Tree stands are popular with many hunters who want an increased advantage, but improper use of them can result in injuries and death," said Sgt. Tom Wanless, Hunter Education Program supervisor for the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. "We always stress safety when using a tree stand or raised platform."

The important things to remember when using a tree

stand for hunting are:

- * Buy a safe and comfortable stand and harness that's right for you. Safe and reliable equipment reduces your chance of injury.

- * Carefully read all instructions and warnings provided with your stand.

- * Practice setting up your stand and safety equipment at ground level first. Use all recommended safety straps and pins to secure the stand.

- * Wear the safety harness at all times when climbing, hunting and descending.

- * Choose a harness with a quick-release system that will hold you right-side-up and not restrict your breathing should you fall.

- * Maintain your equipment — look for wear, stress points and loose fasteners. Fix or replace worn equipment immediately.

- * Choose as straight a tree as possible, and watch for dead, overhanging limbs and rotten wood.

- * Use extra care when hunting from a smooth-barked tree (such as aspen, maple, hickory and beech) because if it rains, they get

slippery.

- * Use extra care when hunting from a frozen tree. Avoid using elevated stands when it's icy.

- * Always use a haul rope to bring gear, firearm or bow to and from the ground.

- * Always unload your gun before hauling.

- * If hauling a bow, tie your line to the top limb of the bow when climbing and the bottom when descending to avoid snagging arrows in tree branches.

- * Be extra alert when climbing or descending from the stand. These are when most tree-stand accidents occur.

These fish often stay in deeper water longer than other panfish — and they also tend to move around more as they target large schools of baitfish. If you use baits that imitate a crappie's food of choice you'll be more likely to find them.

Keep in mind that crappies will get less and less active as the water cools off and they slow down. You'll then want to slow your presentation and offer smaller baits to keep seeing success.

Red Devils back on the winning track

ALMA — In a season of ups and downs, the hardworking East Jordan Red Devils got back on the winning track after dropping their previous three straight contests with a 42-30 non-conference victory over Marion at Alma College on October 11.

The win pushed the Red Devils back over the .500 mark at 4-3 overall.

“(Marion) is a very good football team,” East Jordan coach Allan Peterson said. “I can’t believe this team has only won one football game.” “We wore them down, they only had 15 players and we just wore them down. Our kids never stopped playing hard and we outscored them.”

East Jordan got on the board first as Dustin Hejka found Wyatt Crick for a 25-yard touchdown with 9:18 to go in the opening quarter.

It took Marion only three plays and less than two minutes later to respond as they went to the air as well with quarterback Tyrel Hall finding Ethan Russell for a 65-yard scoring strike and with the conversion, Marion took a 8-6

lead.

Following turnovers by both squads, the later an interception by E.J.’s Jaden Hoffman at the Marion 25 yard line; the Red Devils bounced right back, as Hejka scrambled in from five yards out to put East Jordan back on top 12-8 with 4:55 left in the first quarter as the conversion attempt failed.

After the Red Devil kickoff, Marion marched 65 yards for another score, highlighted by a 45-yard pass completion from Hall to Brad Fall, giving Marion a 14-12 lead as the point after attempt was no good.

East Jordan added another pair of scores in the second quarter, as Hejka and Ben Walton both found the endzone from about three yards out for the Red Devil touchdowns, while Marion was able to claw their way in for eight second quarter points.

The Red Devils took a 26-22 lead into the half.

“We had some very good play from our offensive line with Oscar Scheier and Weston Swanson as well as Jaden Hoffman and Nick Holt,” coach Peterson added. “Tim Schut and Noah Bacchus ran very hard and Ben Walton was super tough inside.”

Marion went back on top in just

under halfway through the third quarter 30-26, but that would be the last time Eagles would hold the lead.

Schut would find paydirt with 3:44 left in the quarter as he rumbled in from 10 yards out, and added the conversion run for a 34-30 East Jordan advantage.

He would then add a little more breathing room late in the fourth quarter for the Red Devils as he found his way for another score with just under two minutes remaining in the game, tack on the conversion pass from Hejka to Bacchus and the finally tally of the night, 42-30 E.J.

“I am very proud of this bunch; they will always work hard and never quit,” Peterson noted.

Bacchus rushed for 103 yards on 14 carries to lead the Red Devil ground game, while Walton added 98 yards on 11 rush attempts and Schut carried 11 times for 69 yards.

Hejka finished 3-of-8 passing for 45 yards and picked up 31 yards rushing.

Schut was the leading receiver with 20 yards on two receptions.

On the defensive side, Walton finished with 10 tackles, while Bacchus had seven stops and an interception. Jordan Peterson, Crick, Michael Suess and Hejka

each added six tackles. Hejka and Hoffman also had interceptions.

The Red Devils (1-3 in the LMC) will host Grayling (4-0 LMC) at Boswell Stadium for their homecoming game on Friday, October 18. Game time is 7pm.

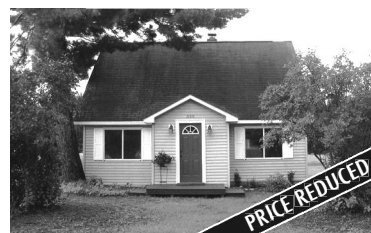

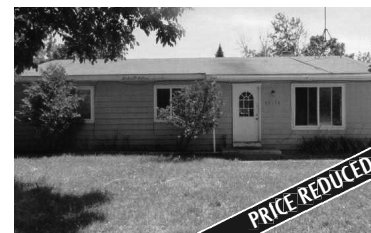

Young Soldier Home for Now, but Plans future Return to Afghanistan

East Jordan Amends Dog Law

EAST JORDAN — When grabbing the leash to take Fido for a walk in the city of East Jordan, dog walkers are advised to grab a disposable bag, as well. An ordinance was introduced at the city commission meeting on Aug. 3, to amend Section 6-36 of the Code of Ordinances, Section 6-36 addresses removal of dog feces if a dog happens to decide a neighbor's lawn is the perfect place to find relief. But the new ordinance adds the language that states: Anyone walking their dog on property other than their own shall be required to have a disposable bag... Also at the meeting, the city administrator updated the commission on the construction of the Emergency Services Facility. The main part of the building and the EMS wing were under a roof, allowing the electrical and plumbing contractors to begin their portion of the work. There is still some flooring to be poured in the Fire Wing, the concrete walls are in place and the roof trusses on this portion of the building will be up soon. The completion target date is early fall. Mary Faculak, president of the East Jordan Chamber of Commerce, gave a presentation to commissioners that informed them of what the Chamber does for the city and updated them on events the Chamber has sponsored. She said she is excited about the Main Street Program.

Patrol Sgt. Troy Drebenstedt is riding his bicycle from South St. Marie to the Gulf of Mexico with his father Bob Drebenstedt and his younger brother, Regan Drebenstedt. The adventure is to raise awareness of the plight of disabled veterans.

Sitting across from the 27-year-old soldier at a summer day, observing his quick smile and steady calmness, it is surprising to find out that he was nearly killed in Afghanistan when the truck in which he was riding hit an Improvised Explosive Device and blew up. Patrol Sgt. Troy Drebenstedt said he was thrown into the side of the vehicle, hitting his head and suffering other injuries. The next thing he knew he was on his feet heading down the road, intent on finding whomever planted the IED. "I was extremely angry," Troy said. A medic who had noticed signs of a concussion came to get him and his superior officer ordered him back to the truck. The other four men riding with him also sustained injuries, but no one was killed. The explosive device was made with the intention to kill everyone in a large radius anywhere near it. "It was 300 pounds of explosives. Forty to 100 pounds is the usual size," Troy said. "It cut a hole six feet deep across the road." He is blessed, he says, and credits his character to his Christian faith and his upbringing. His anger dissipated and he separates the Afghan people from the terrorists. "Being angry with a whole race is burying into their bigotry," he said. "Troy's job in Afghanistan was one of the most dangerous. He was part of the Combat Engineering Unit, known as SAPPERS. He performed 'route clearance,' that is, his job was to find IEDs planted by the terrorists and clear the area of them for safer travel by the military. "It's one of the toughest jobs, but the number one threat to our troops are the IEDs," Troy said. Troy served in Afghanistan for 10 months and prior to that he served in Iraq for 14 months. He is now home in Marquette, undergoing treatment for his injuries and attending Northern Michigan University. But he sees himself back in Afghanistan within the next two years. Troy is the son of Marlys and Bob Drebenstedt of Charlevoix. Troy's father is a county commissioner who retired from the military and Troy grew up knowing that a career in the military was a

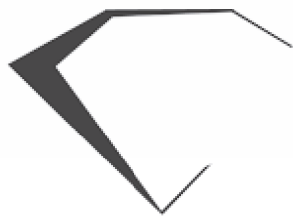
