

Rayders set sail under new, but very familiar, name

Early-season injury sets back Charlevoix's Hankins



By Andy Sneddon There was no get-acquainted period required. Bret Erskine took the reins of the Charlevoix High School boys

basketball program heading into the 2013-14 season. Often, a change at the top means wholesale changes throughout.

Not so in Charlevoix, where the personable Erskine has been a fixture on the Rayder bench for more than a decade and a half, both as an assistant coach in the boys program and as an assistant and then head coach for the girls.

Erskine spent the past two seasons as an assistant to Adam Wood, who left to become the athletic director and head boys basketball coach at Harbor Springs. The transition was seamless.

Then, a little adversity.

Rayder big man Zak Hankins re-injured his foot during a preseason practice and will miss at least the first month of the season. Hankins, a 6-foot-9 senior, has signed with Ferris State University and, naturally, was – and still will be – a major component in the Rayders' potential success this season.

"We're going to have to regroup and see how much magic we can work," Erskine said. "Guys that would not have played as much behind Zak are going to play a ton more minutes now. It might be a little blessing in disguise. It gives those young guys a chance to step up and see what

they can do."

The temporary loss of Hankins will, naturally, be felt. But Charlevoix was far from a oneman team, and the Rayders have plenty of talent and experience back from last year's squad, that finished 14-6 overall, 10-4 (third) in the always-tough Lake Michigan Conference.


Senior Shane Sutherland, a 6-1 forward, returns to his starting spot, while senior guard Justin Pearl, a sometimes starter a year ago, is also back.

Matt MacKenzie, a 6-6 senior, also returns, giving Hankins a very capable frontcourt running mate. That duo is joined in the post by the likes of 6-3 junior Nick Plude, 6-foot senior C.J. Rice, 6-1 sophomore Austin Putman, and 6-1 junior Adam Michaud, giving Erskine plenty of talent and depth up front.

"When you have a kid of Zak's caliber, you're going to look to go inside as much as you can," Erskine said. "We're going to have a little better opportunity to go inside-outside more. We have some good ball handlers, we have some good outside shooting, we have some good post players. We're just trying to feel it out right now."

Joining Pearl in the backcourt are seniors Nick Snabes and Jackson Buday, along with juniors Kenen Borths, Noah Jeakle, Ryan Joy, Nate Moon and Will Telgenhof.

As usual, the Rayders have the luxury of a deep bench, and Erskine said he will not hesitate to call upon any of his reserves.

"I think we have a little deeper team than we had last year," he said. "We're going to try to keep the tempo up like we always did in the past. I think we have a lot of athletic kids throughout the team. We're going to try to press as much as we can. It's going to be a good mix of height and speed. We're really looking forward to seeing how it's going to turn out."

Getting a healthy Hankins back in the lineup, obviously, will be key. Erskine said he is eager to see how much his big man has improved after a rigorous offseason. Like many rangy high school players, Hankins has taken time to develop, and Erskine said he expects much out of Hankins.

"He's just turned himself into a basketball player," he said. "You can work a kid so much, but until that light bulb goes off ... He's really got that passion for basketball. I think now he's really developed his coordination with his body. He's only 17. He's still young. I think his ability finally caught up to his potential.

"If we can keep him healthy he has the potential to have a great year. It's just not one player that'll make our team, it's our whole team. We can't just put our eggs in one basket. He gets hurt, and now what do you do?"

Erskine is preaching a teamfirst philosophy, which is something that has seemingly forever been ingrained in the Charlevoix program. The Rayders long made their hay with an uptempo offense and aggressive fullcourt defense, the better to take advantage of not only talent, but depth.

Buying into that, top to bottom, is critical, said Erskine, who was an assistant under Keith Haske for years when Charlevoix was among the premier Class C programs in Northern Michigan, and long state-tournament runs were the norm.

"I really think it's getting them

to believe in each other, and believe in what we're trying to do this year," said Erskine, who, during his three-year stint at the helm of the Rayder girls program produced a 48-20 record, two Class C district championships, and two appearances in regionalchampionship games. "I think that will go a long ways toward bringing the community back to Charlevoix basketball.

"They have to be focused, they have to be ready to go and put in those two, three, four minutes that they get. That's one thing that I have talked about with (my players) since the first day of practice. It's never the quantity of minutes you put in in the game, it's the quality of minutes you put in when you're in the game.

"That's a challenge to them if they want to play. Having 15 (players on the roster) is just a great asset because now you have to compete for playing time."

EAST JORDAN — The East Jordan boys basketball program is looking to build off a successful summer program that saw the Red Devils go 21-4 in three team camps, winning a couple of them.



Its luxury-minded Denali model, which came to market in mid-2010, has widened this midsize crossover's appeal to customers looking for a high level of style, power and functionality.

In 2014, the Acadia focuses on safety with the addition of Forward Collision Alert and Lane Departure Warning, crash-avoidance systems that use a camera and sensors to help detect when the driver is getting too close to a vehicle ahead, or when the vehicle enters another lane without the use of a turn signal. The systems alert the driver with visual cues on the dashboard, as well as audible signals. They complement Side Blind Zone Alert and Cross Traffic Alert, which were added in 2013.

The new model year also brings an additional convenience feature: two charging-only USB ports on the rear of the center console to power up electronics from the second row.




