East Jordan ground attack too much for Tigers

East Jordan 42, Hillman 26

EAST JORDAN — It has been quite some time since the Red Devils could say they were 2-0, 10 years to be exact, as East Jordan used a balanced ground attack to chew up nearly 300 yards rushing, en route to a 42-26 non-conference football victory on September 6.

The Red Devils didn't waste much time in getting on the scoreboard as they crossed the goal line at the 8:00 mark, courtesy of a Ben Walton 2-yard run.

Just over a minute later, Red Devil speedster, Noah Bacchus returned his second punt in as many weeks for a touchdown, following a 2-point conversion, EJ lead 14-0.

Hillman would then get on the board at the 2:29 mark as Ty Jones found Mason VanPamel for a short TD pass; the conversion attempt was no good, to bring them to within 14-6.

The Red Devils then closed out the quarter with another scoring play as Dustin Hejka found Noah Raymond for a 53-yard scoring strike. The conversion attempt was no good, for a 20-6 lead.

East Jordan would outscore Hillman by a 15-8 margin in the second quarter for a 35-14 half-time advantage as Hejka scrambled for a 67-yard score and Michael Suess added a 3-yard touchdown.

"Our kids played very well against a very good team," East Jordan coach Allan Peterson

said. "We had a couple of injuries early that stalled us some but we held on late."

The Tigers would pull to within 35-26 with just under 10:30

remaining in the contest before EJ added their final tally of the night as Hejka found Tim Schut for a 7-yard scoring pass with 3:09 left in the fourth quarter.

"Hillman runs the spread well and it's tough to stop," Peterson added. "I am proud of all our kids for their effort and sure love coaching them."

The Red Devils piled up 394 yards of total offense, including the 272 yards on the ground.

Hejka led the ground attack with 86 yards on six attempts, while Tim Schut added 69 on eight carries, Bacchus chipped in with 66 yards on 15 carries, and Suess rushed 11 times for 31 yards.

Hejka also crossed the century mark passing, as he finished 3-of-4 for 101 yards, while Jordan Peterson was 1-of-3 passing for 21 yards. Raymond caught one pass for 53 yards including a TD, while Wyatt Crick had one reception

for 41 yards and Bacchus hauled in a 21 yard reception and Schut added a catch for seven yards.

Defensively, Suess led the Red Devils with 12 tackles; Bacchus added 11 and Schut had eight stops. Oscar Scheier added seven tackles, while Peterson, Hejka and Crick all had six stops apiece.

Hejka and Peterson also finished with an interception.

JV football Red Devils fall to Manton

The East Jordan JV football team fell to Manton 31-20 on September 5.

The Red Devils held a slim 20-19 lead in the third quarter, but saw that evaporate as the Rangers returned a punt for a

score.

"It was a well-played game in the first half," Red Devils coach Greg Kitson said. "Manton is a good football team with a lot of size up front. I am very happy with how our kids competed."

The Red Devils scoring came via a 15-yard scoring strike from Trey Peterson to Kaleb Raymond, a 9-yard run from Ryan Graham and a 5-yard run from Donny Cutler. Graham also added a two-point conversion reception from Peterson.

"We had 205 yards rushing with a lot of running backs getting some touches," coach Kitson added.

Cutler paced the team with 86 yards, while Hector Paz added 69.

On the defensive side, Defensively Skyler Schuler had 12 tackles, Graham had 11 and Bob Sherman chipped in with eight. Paz also added a fumble recovery for the Red Devils.

Redman to Vroman connection looking promising

KENT CITY — After a disappointing opening week loss, the Boyne City Rambler football team went back to work and were rewarded with a 35-14 non-conference victory over Kent City on September 6.

Corey Redman got the Ramblers on the board first on a 1-yard quarterback keeper.

Redman would also be part of the second Boyne City score, as he connected with his favorite target, fellow junior Maceo Vroman for a 26-yard touchdown and a 14-0 Rambler lead.

Not to be upstaged, the Rambler defense got into the scoring

column as Mac Alexander picked off a pass and returned it 15-yards for a score and a 21-0 cushion headed into the break.

Bradley Fouchia got the second half scoring started for Boyne as he took off like a bolt of lightning for a 30-yard run and a 28-0 lead.

In the fourth, Redman once again found Vroman for a 23-

yard scoring strike to push the Rambler lead to 35-7.

Redman finished the game 6-of-9 passing for 113 yards and two touchdowns, and ran for 10-yards and a score.

Vroman finished with 67 yards receiving with three receptions and a pair of TD's, sophomore workhorse, Malik Smith rumbled for 94 yards on 26 carries

and Fouchia chipped in with 42 yards on five rush attempts.

On the defensive side, Luke Sage had 12 tackles, while Max Cupper and Cole Butler each finished with nine stops.

The Ramblers improve to 1-1 with the win and play at Kalkaska on September 13, in their Lake Michigan Conference opener.

Rayders unable to overcome miscues

CHARLEVOIX — Well, it wasn't the way they wanted to perform in front of the Rayder faithful in their home debut, as Charlevoix fell to Glen Lake 28-0 on September 6 at Kipke Field.

The Rayders committed turnovers and had a few mental breakdowns and missed assignments, which allowed the Lakers to take advantage of and that they did.

"That's a good football team we played, and you just can't give them extra opportunities," Rayder coach Ron Bindi said. "We didn't cover our responsibilities and we just did not take care of business."

With the loss, the Rayders slipped to 1-1 on the season.

Besides the turnovers and miscues, the Rayders were able to move the ball at times.

After forcing the Lakers to punt on their opening drive, the Rayders took over at their own 20-yard line at the 8:28 mark and following a 1-yard keeper by Luke Klinger, the quarterback found Shane Sutherland for a 23-yard pass.

The Rayders then looked to move the ball further downfield, following a 20-yard run, the Lakers stripped the ball on the Rayder back and recovered on their 40-yard line, ending the Charlevoix drive.

The Rayder defense would hold once again as the Lakers would move into field goal range, only to see the ball sail wide of the goalpost, giving Charlevoix the ball near the 20.

Following a 5-yard gain on first down by Nate Moon, the

Rayders were assessed a false start penalty, and very little positive yardage would come out of the next play as they were forced to punt.

That punt would be returned to the Rayder 25, and then Laker quarterback Carter Lee took off on a keeper and was off to the races as he went in virtually untouched for the first score of the game. The point after attempt was blocked, giving Glen Lake a 6-0 lead with 1:44 left in the opening quarter.

Rayder return man, Ty Telgenhof would take the kickoff at the

five yard line and scoot his way 22-yards to the 27-yard line, giving the Rayders some breathing room.

But before the first play of the drive could get off, Charlevoix was whistled for a false start, moving them back 5-yards.

The quarter would end 6-0 Lakers.

After holding Glen Lake on their next drive, Charlevoix went to the air, only to see Klinger's pass attempt picked off at the 35-yard line.

A few plays later, Glen Lake running back Travis Wiltjer would take off on a 23-yard run and not much later Lee connected with receiver Thomas Waning on a 32-yard touchdown toss, giving the Lakers a 21-0 halftime cushion.

"We moved the ball well at times, only to pick up a penalty or turn it over," Bindi said. "Also, we didn't tackle well and take care of our assignments."

The Lakers would add their final score with another Lee touchdown, this time to receiver Logan LaCross, and following a successful point after attempt, it was 28-0.

Klinger finished the night on the sideline due to injury, but managed to go 3-of-10 passing for 57 yards and two picks. Sam Hovie led the ground attack with 119 yards rushing, while Moon added 36 yards on 11 carries.

Defensively, Bryan Noiroit finished with nine tackles to lead the Rayders, while Sam Eakes added eight tackles.

How are you coping with stress?

It is estimate that 75 to 90 percent of doctor visits are stress-related. The stress you feel is sending you a message - something has recently changed, is about to change, or needs to change. For some people, stress is a part of daily life. Stress can be both positive and negative. Stress can motivate and improve performance. Chronic stress can be detrimental, both physically and psychologically. What is considered stressful and how one responds to stress will vary from one person to another.

When we are under stress, our bodies respond as though preparing for battle or escape. When stress continues at a high level for an extended time period, our nervous system is activated over and over. If we don't take steps to reduce the stress or reduce the intensity of the response, our immune systems are less able to defend our bodies from infection and we are at risk of a variety of illness. Stress can also increase our risk of illness by leading to sleepless nights and poor dietary habits. Stress is one of the leading causes of insomnia and stress can lead people to overeat or eat very little. Chronic stress can damage blood vessels, increase inflammation and result in atherosclerosis. Stress increases the risk of headaches, high blood pressure, digestive problems, diabetes, and a range of other health issues.

When stressed, we want to do something to relieve the feelings connected with the stress. This could be a racing heartbeat, feelings of fear or anxiety, insomnia, headaches, stomach problems or feeling powerless and out of control. We want to take action to eliminate these feelings, but the actions we take could hurt or help. Coping strategies are a range of things that help us to minimize or manage stress. These can be positive and reduce stress levels or negative, leading to an overall increase in stress.

Coping skills are learned behaviors. Most often, through our own experiences, we learn what coping skills are effective for us. We may have learned that using food, alcohol or tobacco helps relieve stress. In the short-term, the substance might distract us from the stressor. This relief is not long lasting. We find we need

more of the substance as we continue to use this strategy and we have the added stress of the consequences of substance abuse. The substance keeps the body in distress. We might also try to forget about the stressor rather than attempt to face it head-on. This might feel good for a time, but if we haven't dealt with the stress, it will return. We also have the additional stress from being unhealthy from overeating or use of tobacco, alcohol or other drugs. For the sake of our health, it is best to de-

velop positive coping strategies. Next week, steps that can help you be prepared for stress before it happens and react to stress in ways that reduce the feeling of stress and deal with the stressor itself.

5. Fill in bald spots

Autumn is also a great time of year to fix any bare, bald spots in your lawn. The quickest, easiest way to do this is with an all-in-one lawn-repair mixture. Sold at most garden shops and home centers, this ready-to-use mixture contains grass seed, a special quick-starter lawn fertilizer and organic mulch.

Use a garden rake to scratch loose the soil at the bald spot in your lawn. Then spread a thick layer of the lawn repair mixture over the area. Lightly compact the mixture, then water thoroughly, and continue to water every other day for two weeks.

6. Control the weeds

If broadleaf weeds such as dandelions have taken over your lawn, now's the time to fight back. Weeds,

like most plants, are in the energy-absorbing mode during the fall. They're drinking in everything that comes their way, including weed-killers. Apply an herbicide now, and the weeds won't return in the spring.

Read the package label before use. Most herbicide manufacturers recommend applying the weed-killer in early to mid autumn, when daytime temperatures are consistently above 60 degrees.

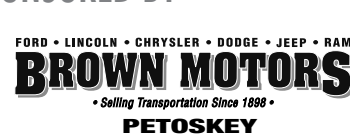

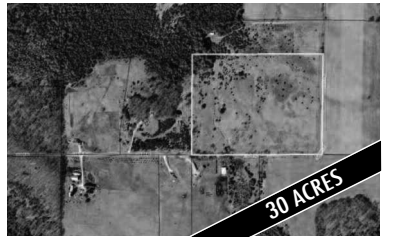

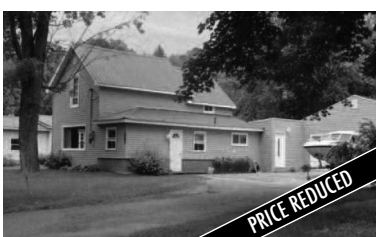
