Lady Ramblers clinch share of Lake Michigan Conference Softball crown

Shumaker fans 17 in the twinbill

Boyne City 11-9, East Jordan 2-3

BOYNE CITY — The Boyne City High School softball team captured a share of the Lake Michigan Conference title (with co-champ, TC St. Francis) with a sweep of East Jordan on May 20, winning 11-2 and 9-3.

In the opener, after sending the Lady Red Devils down in order, Boyne City got right to work as Emma Shumaker led off with a single, followed by both Rainy McCune and Celena Brzezinski reaching on errors and a Paige Hornbeck walk, Boyne was up 1-0. A two-run double by Hannah Hoth followed by walks to Katelyn Banner and Jordan Weiss. Emma Vondra drilled her second home run of the year, a two-run shot, to give the Ramblers an 8-0 cushion headed into the second.

East Jordan wasn't about to roll over as they pushed across a pair of runs on singles from Lindsey Graham, Sydney Drew and Madi Peterson, but that's all the offense the Red Devils could muster over the next four innings of play.

Boyne was able to add three more runs over the final five innings, highlighted by Shumaker's second round tripper of the year in the bottom of the fifth.

Shumaker earned the win in the circle, going the distance, striking out eight, while allowing four hits and walking one.

Offensively for the Ramblers, Shumaker finished with two hits, including the home run, while Vondra added her home

run, McCune tripled, Hoth doubled and Hornbeck singled.

For East Jordan, Graham singled twice, with Drew and Peterson chipping in with one hit apiece. Peterson picked up a pair of RBI's as well.

Tori Goodrich started and took the loss for EJ, striking out one, while allowing four hits and three walks, with Tommie Outman coming on in relief, fanning four, striking out three and walking three.

"We had a tough first inning, but after that, we settled down and played great," East Jordan coach Meg Kitson said. "Tommie Outman pitched very well for us today."

In the nightcap, each team took turns scoring a run in the first inning, Outman reached on a walk for the Red Devils and came across to score, while Boyne countered with Brzezinski scoring on a Hornbeck double.

The score would remain that way until the Ramblers struck again in the bottom of the third, scoring six times as Shumaker and Brzezinski both singled and Hornbeck followed with the third Boyne home run of the night. Hoth and Banner would each single and Jordan Weiss added a double. The Ramblers would add solo runs in the fourth and fifth innings to close out their scoring.

East Jordan came back with two runs of their own in the top of the fifth as Haley Goodrich reached on an error and Asya Sitzema singled and eventually came around to score.

Shumaker picked up the win once again for the Lady Ramblers, limiting EJ to a pair of singles, striking out nine and walking three.

The BC offense was led by Hornbeck with a home run and double, Weiss doubled, Shumaker, Brzezinski, Hoth and Banner all added one hit each.

Outman took the loss for the Lady Red Devils, allowing seven hits, walking two and striking out three.

Sitzema and Graham finished with the two hits for EJ.

Boyne City improves to 15-6 overall, 13-1 conference, while East Jordan slips to 7-15, 3-9.

CHARLEVOIX — The No. 7 ranked (Michigan High School Soccer Coaches Association Division IV poll) Charlevoix Rayder soccer team showed just why deserve they deserve that ranking as they downed Harbor Springs 5-0 in the opening contest of Division IV district play on May 27.

Senior forward, Katie Kiteley got the Rayders on the board first, scoring at 24:14 of the first half on a pass from freshman forward Julia Duskoch, a lead that Charlevoix would carry until halftime. In the second half, sophomore forward Kelsey Engstrom found fellow sophomore Kylee Scholten, who would nail a kick to the

upper right corner of the net for a 2-0 Rayder lead at 23:33. Less than three minutes later, junior midfielder Elizabeth Way strung a pass to Engstrom who found the back of the net at 20:21. Junior midfielder Leah Davis scored unassisted from well outside the 18 with 11:49 remaining, giving Charlevoix a 4-0 lead. Scholten then found Davis for her second goal of the game with 36

seconds left in the game. Charlevoix finished with 16 shots on goal, and junior keeper Gloria Greene recorded 12 saves on goal for the Rayder shutout. "As pleased as we were with our offensive attack, our defense played a key role in the victory. Olivia Storm, Isabel Hess, Kaitlin Hinkley and Shelby Robinson did a great job tonight against an explosive Harbor attack,"

Charlevoix coach Pete Scholten said. "Everyone stepped up and denied many potential opportunities. I was pleased with how fast we were to the ball and we were able to keep it out of the middle." The Rayders improve to 17-5-1 and advance to play Boyne City on Thursday, May 29 in a district semi-final match up at 5:00 at Charlevoix High School.

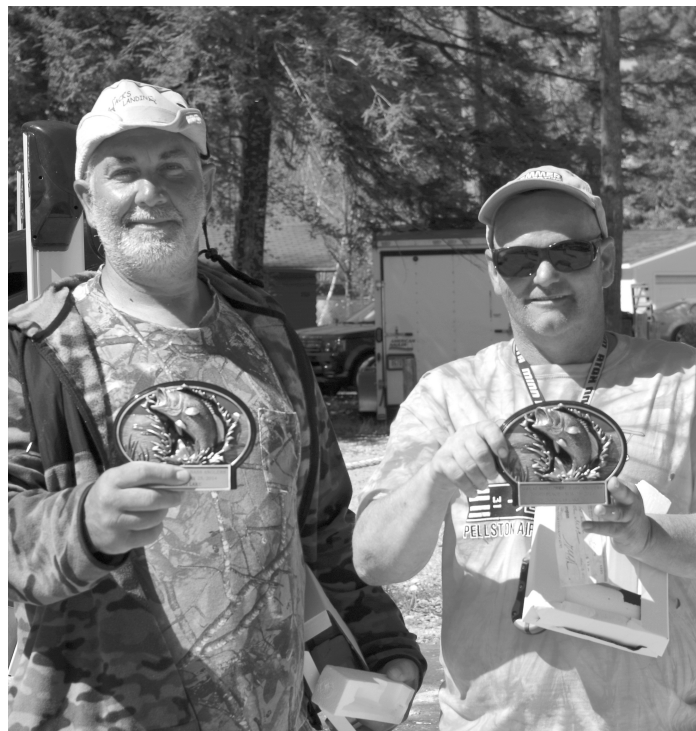
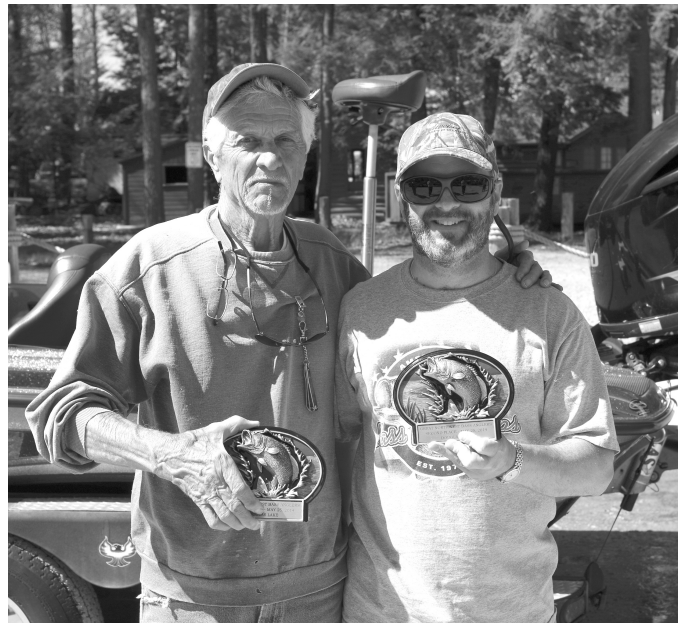
Douglas Lake Bass Fishing Tournament Winners

Douglas Lake, MI – The Great Northwest BASS Anglers open another season of bass fishing on Douglas Lake, in Cheboygan County. With the longer than normal winter and certainly not having lots of warm weather it was predicted to be a pre spawn event. So the potential was there for some really big fish to be brought into the scales at the season opener.

The day was almost perfect as the water temp on the lake hovered in the high 50's to as high as 60 degrees. The wind started out from the west southwest as a very light breeze but built stronger as the day progressed. As the wind increased it also kept shifting from southwest to almost due north. The changing conditions also mean the anglers must adapt to the changing winds and conditions. Where it may have been dead calm early in the day the wind may have either come up or changed direction so that you spot you are fishing is now different. Seven boats fished the club event and as always someone always figures out the fish. This event was very close due to the fishermen catching what has to be the lake average.

The team of Ryan Koehn-Lofts and Jeff Devantier took 1st place with a winning weight of 30lb 2oz. Ryan, also sticking the big bass of the event at 3lb 15oz won him \$70.00 in addition to the 1st place winnings. Second place went to the team of Jerry Hepner and Matt Konchel with 27lb 11/2oz. Third place was awarded to the team of Ed Schlosser and Mike Searles with 21pounds.

Almost all of the fish were caught in 3 to 6 feet of water. The key thing was moving baits fast to trigger reaction strikes. Top producers were spinnerbaits, lipless rattle baits and jerk baits moved at a very fast pace. If the baits weren't moving fast enough the fish would just follow the bait presentation towards the boat. The big females were just not ready to chase fast moving baits as they were never showing themselves throughout the day. The next event for the club is on June 8, at Hubbard Lake.

**FISCAL YEAR 2014/2015 ADOPTED BUDGET
CITY COMMISSION MEETING MAY 6, 2014**

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS OF THE CITY, AND SETTING FORTH THE AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED TO DEFRAY THE EXPENDITURES AND SETTING FORTH A STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REVENUES BY SOURCE IN EACH FUND; TO ADOPT THE CITY'S BUDGETS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014/2015; TO ADOPT THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR PUBLIC RECORDS AND SERVICES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014/2015; AND TO ADOPT WATER AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL RATES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014/2015.

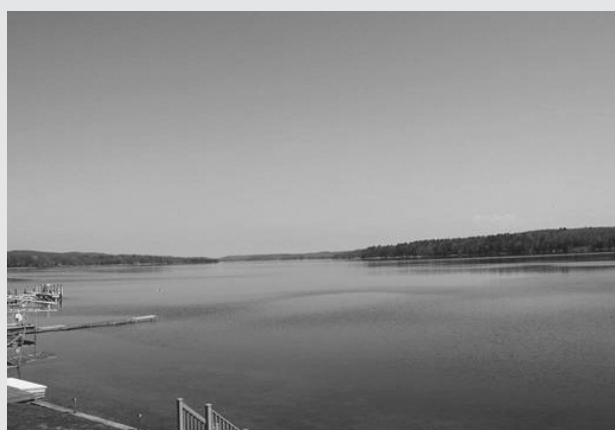

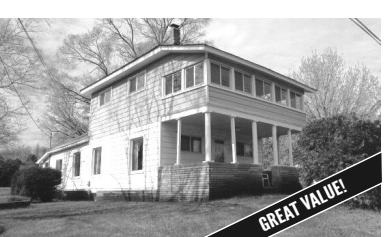

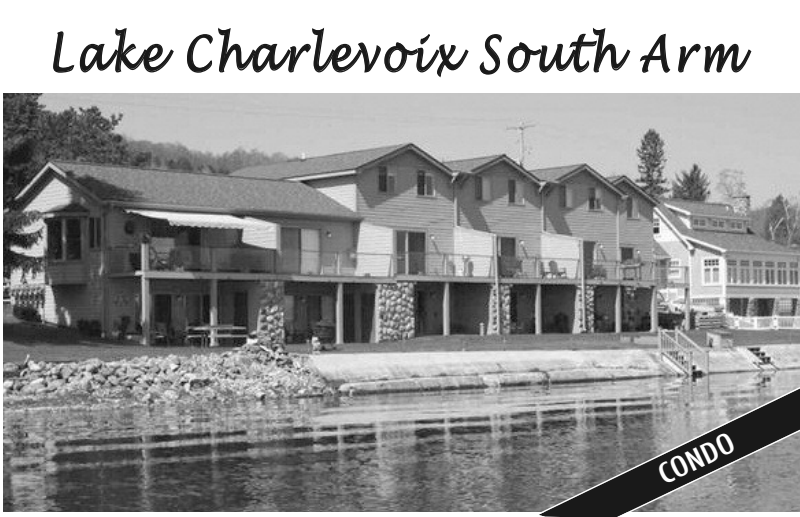
