Rayders roll in Homecoming contest

CHARLEVOIX — Sometimes things just seem to click.

That just so happened to be the case for the Charlevoix football team in their 35-0 homecoming victory over rival East Jordan on October 10 in front of a big crowd at Kipke Field.

“We keep getting a little better, a little bit at a time,” Charlevoix coach Ron Bindi said. “We’re playing much better, the kids came in and took care of business and did the things that needed to be done.”

The Rayders wasted little time in setting the tone for the contest, with quarterback Nate Moon taking their second play from scrimmage on a keeper, running off tackle on the right side before weaving his way through traffic for a 46 yard touchdown run and a 6-0 Charlevoix lead just over two minutes into the game at the 9:50 mark.

The long run would be one of many big plays on the night for Charlevoix.

East Jordan’s Ryan Graham would take the Red

Devils next offensive play and rumble 10 yards for a first down, but EJ would not be able to move the chains much after that before punting on fourth down.

Charlevoix would take possession following a punt out of bounds at the EJ 40 yard line and six plays later, the Rayders would find the end zone, courtesy of a 7-yard run by Ben Boss. A successful two-point conversion run by Sam Hovie and Charlevoix was up 14-0 with about five and a half minutes to go in the opening quarter.

Following the Boss touchdown, both defenses would tighten, not allowing another point for the first half.

“Our kids battled hard in the first half,” East Jordan coach Allan Peterson said. “I’m very proud of the way they handled themselves the whole game.”

After the halftime break, neither team would get anything going until 3:36 of the third quarter, when Moon found a seam and used a block from linemen Spencer Bruce to spring him free into the open field for a 59 yard touchdown run. A successful two-point conversion pass from Moon to

Bryan Noirot and Charlevoix’s lead expanded to 22-0.

The Rayders would add two more scores in the fourth quarter as Boss took off on a 75-yard run and Hunter Cox booted the extra point attempt and Forrest Noirot added a 1-yard score for the 35-0 final.

Offensively for Charlevoix, Moon finished 6-of-6 passing for 70 yards, while adding 88 yards on six carries for two scores.

Boss totalled 114 yards on seven rush attempts and a pair of touchdowns in leading a 300 plus yard team total; Malcolm Williams finished with 68 yards on four carries, including a big 43 yard gain late in the contest, setting up Boss’s final score.

Sam Hovie also rushed nine times for 46 yards. Austin Putman hauled in three passes for 49 yards, while Bryan Noirot added two receptions and Will Telgenhof had one for 16 yards.

On the defensive side of the ball, Justin Adkins had eight tackles to lead the Rayders, while Williams added seven. Moon also finished with an interception.

Charlevoix totaled seven sacks on the night as well.

For East Jordan, Graham finished with 42 yards on 15 carries, while Marco Mata added 36 yards on six attempts.

Jordan Peterson finished 2-of-8 passing for 20 yards, with Noah Raymond grabbing both passes.

The Red Devil defense was led by Wyatt Crick with nine stops, Bob Sherman and Mata finished with six tackles each.

“Charlevoix has a bunch of very good athletes and Ron (Bindi) has done a good job with them,” coach Peterson added. “We are getting better and the kids are still working hard, so we’ll see what the last two games bring.”

The Rayders, 4-3 overall, 2-1 conference, travel to Frankfort against the 6-1 Panthers, while the Red Devils, 0-7, 0-4, host Harbor Springs. Both games are October 17, 7 p.m.

“We need to keep playing as a team,” Bindi added. “We saw a lot of positives the last few weeks, we just need to continue to build. We have a tough challenge ahead of us.”

Charlevoix wins Tri-meet with Elks, Eagles

CHARLEVOIX — The Rayder volleyball team keeps on rolling. Charlevoix improved to 29-7-4 on the season, with wins over Elk Rapids and Bellaire.

"It was a good team effort on the offensive and defensive side tonight," Rayder coach Audra Randall said. "Some girls really stepped up in various roles, shining nicely."

In the match against Elk Rapids, Charlevoix was victorious 25-5, 25-13, 22-25 and 25-9.

"I'm very proud of the girls," said Randall. "They had a tough set three with the Elks and the Elks momentum was rising, but the girls stayed on focus in the fourth set, shutting them down 25-9."

Against the Eagles, the result was the same, too much of the Rayders as Charlevoix downed Bellaire 25-10, 25-16 and 25-19.

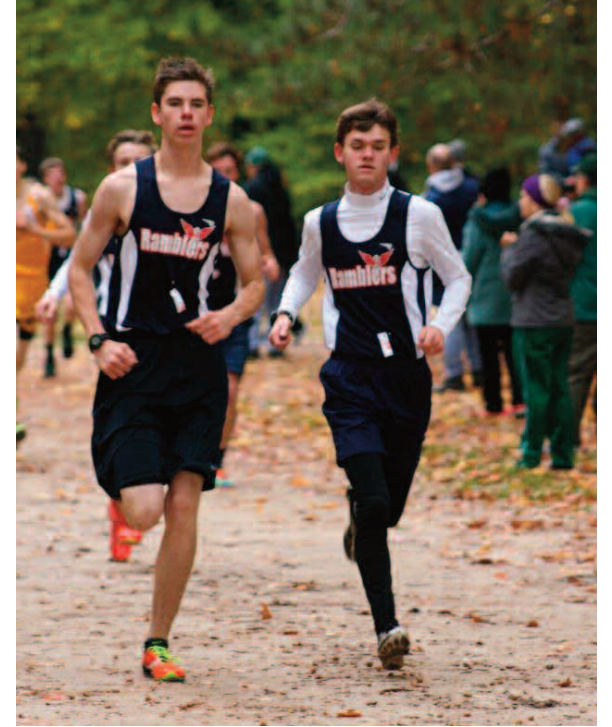

Since its launch in September 2012, the 365-horsepower, twin-turbocharged Ford Explorer Sport is proving it's capable of far more than hauling families on their next cross-country adventure with performance and style. Research suggests Explorer Sport is also hauling younger, more affluent, better-educated buyers into Ford showrooms.

Nearly one-quarter of Explorer Sport customers are under 35 years old, while 54 percent are 44 and younger, according to the Maritz Research New Vehicle Customer Study, which covers data from October 2012 through April 2014. For buyers of standard Ford Explorer models, 3 percent are under 35 and 32 percent are 44 and younger. "We aren't surprised by the luxury brand trade-ins for Explorer Sport," said Zuehlk. "It offers world-class performance, comfort and technology at a more affordable price than traditional luxury competitors, especially in largely import luxury markets like New York and Los Angeles."

New York and Los Angeles are the biggest markets for Ford Explorer Sport, followed by Detroit, Dallas, Chicago, Denver and Houston, according to Polk new vehicle registration data from IHS Automotive through the first half of 2014. 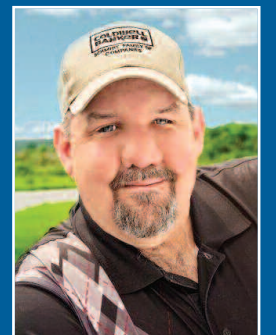

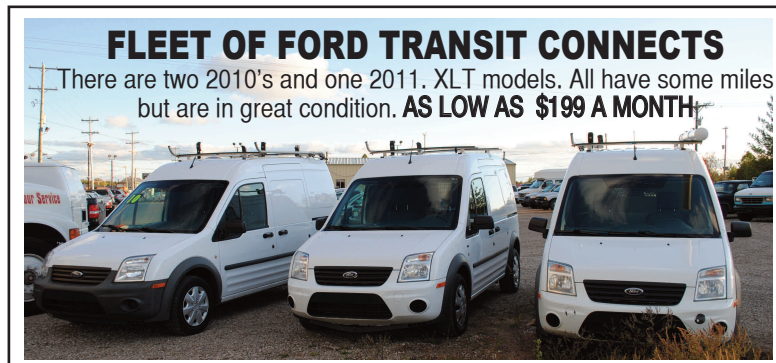
