CHARLEVOIX COUNTY – From the opening kickoff this season, Northern Michigan football looked to provide something special, and that it did.

The Boyne City Ramblers put together one of the best fall seasons ever and pushed defending Division 6 champion Ithaca to the limit in their state semifinal matchup. The Charlevoix Rayders hit their stride mid-season and earned a trip to the playoffs, their first postseason appearance in five years, and nearly got past Negaunee in their opening round contest. The East Jordan Red Devils went through some growing pains with a young team progressed as the season went on and showed promise for the future.

But all that aside, there were a number of very talented area athletes from each squad that performed as big playmakers in key situations and those athletes have been selected to the 2014 Charlevoix County News All-Area Football "Dream Team".

Leading this pack of athletes are offensive Player of the Year,

Joining Vroman on the offensive squad are fellow Ramblers; Malik Smith, Cole Butler, Will Calo, Lee Rainey and Carter Wilmot. The Rayders boast Adam Michaud, Austin Putman, Devin Largent and Sam Hovie. The Red Devils are represented by Herschell Sutton and Jordan Peterson.

The All-Area defensive team consists of Boyne's Sage, Tanner Kruzel, Mac Alexander, Dalton Gardner, Max Cuper and Connor Beebe. Charlevoix offers Justin Adkins, Ben Boss, Nate Moon and Spencer Kilpatrick. East Jordan showcases Bob Sherman and Wyatt Crick.

Maceo Vroman, senior (#10) Boyne City.

Even though the Ramblers had multiple weapons at their disposal, no one was more dangerous than the speedy Vroman. The senior halfback scored 28 combined touchdowns this season, a

Maceo could and would change the game just by being in the contest as defenses had to be aware of his location at all times. The fleet-footed speedster racked up 1,567 yards on 160 carries, good for a 9.79 yards per carry average and 24 touchdowns on the ground.

Vroman also hauled in nine passes for 161 yards and three scores. He also returned six punts for 110 yards (18.33 avg) and a touchdown. Maceo also returned seven kickoffs for 124 yards (17.71 avg) and scored five two-point conversions.

He recorded 50 tackles as a defensive back, including four interceptions.

Malik Smith, junior (#28) Boyne City.

Malik, a fullback for the Ramblers, finished another successful campaign for Boyne as he tallied 969 yards on 147 attempts, a 6.59 rush average, while hitting paydirt 18 times.

The combination of Vroman's speed and Smith's power, had defensive coordinators choosing which to try and contain as there was no stopping them.

Smith recorded 33 tackles from his safety position and recovered a fumble.

Cole Butler, senior (#82) Boyne City.

Butler was another threat for the Ramblers from his tight end position. Whether it be springing a teammate for a big gain following a block or hauling in a pass, the senior played his role well.

Cole caught three passes for 59 yards, a 19.67 average per catch and one touchdown.

Butler was also a defensive presence for Boyne, tallying 71 tackles, including three sacks.

Will Calo, senior (#54) Boyne City.

The senior tackle was another key piece to the Rambler running game and keeping opponents out of the Boyne backfield Will also made 62 tackles for the Ramblers, including four sacks and one fumble recovery.

Devin Largent, senior (#55) Charlevoix.

The senior guard was a key element for the Rayder offense. Regarded by the coaching staff as their best technique lineman.

He also recorded 19 tackles, including a sack from his defensive line position.

Adam Michaud, senior (#70) Charlevoix.

other key to the Charlevoix offense, handling snapping responsibilities and never had a mishandled snap the entire season out of the Rayder pistol set.

Adam made nine stops on the Rayder defense, including two for a loss.

Herschell Sutton, senior (#65) East Jordan.

The senior lineman helped the young Red Devils hone their craft. "Great young man and hard worker," EJ coach Al Peterson

said.

Peterson was the team leader for the Red Devils this season and great all-around athlete.


DEFENSE

The hard hitting inside linebacker, set the tone for the Rambler defense. The junior leader led Boyne with 146 total tackles, including six sacks, five fumble recoveries, one interception, a safety and a blocked punt.

"It's an honor being selected as the defensive player of the year." Sage said. "It's nice to be recognized for putting in all the hard work in the weight room and from a team standpoint, I don't think I'd get this recognition without them. They help push me

Carter was the center for the Ramblers and responsible for getting the ball to the quarterback and blocking to free up lanes for his teammates to run.

Wilmot also made 21 stops on defense for Bovne.

Lee Rainey, senior (#66) **Boyne City**.

Lee, a guard for the Ramblers, was another needed blocker for the running and passing game.

Rainey recorded 52 tackles for Boyne, including three sacks and two fumble recoveries.

Austin Putman, junior (#6) Charlevoix.

The Rayder tight end was the leading receiver for Charlevoix this season, with 18 receptions for 331 yards (18.39 average) and three touchdowns.

Austin also showed defenses that a big man could move fast as well, as he rushed for 52 yards on eight attempts and a touchdown.

Putman was also the leading tackler for the Rayders with 62 this year, including three sacks and six tackles for a loss, a fumble recovery and an interception.

Sam Hovie, senior (#20) Charlevoix.

Sam was the motor that moved the Rayder offense throughout much of the year, until a late injury forced the running back to the sideline.

Hovie still managed to lead the team in rushing yards with 736 on 84 carries, an 8.76 yard per carry average and seven scores in seven games.

through things that have helped me get to this point."

When asked what drives him, Sage responded, "As, I've gotten older, I find I've paid more attention to the coaches and my dad (a former MSU football player) and I want to get to that next level. In addition to that, my team drives me and I always want to try and be better than everyone else out there."

Luke was was a Detroit Free Press All-State Division 6 first team selection and an AP Division 5-6 All-State special mention selection.

In addition to forcing teams to try and run their offense away from him, Sage was also a big contributor on the offensive side of the ball.

Luke gained 261 yards on the ground on 37 carries and scored six touchdowns and caught two passes for 22 yards and a score, while also adding a two-point conversion.

"We're happy with the season, but not satisfied." Sage added. "All



Mac Alexander, senior (#5) **Boyne City**.

Another hard hitting Rambler defensemen, Mac would make offenses pay if they somehow were able to get to an opening from his strong safety position.

Alexander finished second on the team with 103 tackles, including three fumble recoveries and two picks. Mac also blocked an extra point attempt.

He was also another fleet footed running back in the Rambler offense, carrying the ball 35 times for 343 yards and two scores, while also catching six passes for 61 yards and a touchdown, and adding two conversion attempts.









Tanner Kruzel, junior (#43) Boyne City.

An outside linebacker for the Ramblers, Tanner recorded 89 stops on the year, including eight sacks and a fumble recovery.

Kruzel was also a tight end for Boyne and their leading receiver with 13 receptions for 223 yards and four touchdowns and a pair of two-point conversions.

Tanner was also the kicker for the Ramblers. netting 3,423 yards on 72 kickoff attempts for an average of 47.54 per kick. Many times the junior would boot the ball into the endzone or pin opponents deep in their own territory.

Max Cuper, senior (#12) Boyne City.

Another part of the Rambler inside linebacker core, Max was responsible for 85 tackles. six fumble recoveries, four sacks and two interceptions resulting in one touchdown.

Cuper also piloted the Boyne offense as the team's quarterback. Max finished the season 33-for-78 for 541 yards and 11 touchdowns, while also rushing 36 times for 299 vards and six scores.

Dalton Gardner, senior (#44) Boyne City.

Dalton was a key piece to the Rambler secondary from his defensive back position, locking down on the opponents top receiver.

Gardner finished the season with 45 tackles, one fumble recovery and three interceptions.

Dalton was also the Boyne place kicker and punter. He finished 44-of-60 in extra point attempts and added a two-point conversion and punted 16 times for 493 yards, a 30.81 average.

Gardner chipped in with a 31 yard touchdown pass, added 96 yards rushing on eight attempts with a score and hauled in a 15yard pass for a score as well.

In addition to those numbers, Dalton returned 13 punts for 163 yards (12.54 avg) and a touchdown and added 10 kickoff returns for 259 yards (25.9 avg) and another score.



The mortgage underwriter (the person who actually approves your loan) will probably require a complete paper trail of all the withdrawals and deposits. You may be required to produce cancelled checks, deposit receipts, and other seemingly inconsequential data, which could get quite tedious.

Perhaps you become exasperated at your lender, but they are only doing their job correctly. To ensure quality control and eliminate potential fraud, it is a requirement on most loans to completely document the source of all funds. Moving your money around, even if you are consolidating your funds to make it easier, could make it more difficult for the lender to properly document.

So leave your money where it is until you talk to a loan officer. In addition, this would be a bad time to change banks.


