

SUTTONS BAY — Boyne City got 23 points from Corey Redman, including nailing 6-of-8 free throws in the fourth quarter, as the Ramblers held off a late surge by the Norsemen to earn a non-conference win on December 18.

Boyne lead 15-12 after one quarter of play and extended their lead to 30-19 headed into halftime and looked to be in control 51-33 after three quarters of play.

Cole Butler added 16 points and six boards for the Ramblers, including nine points in the third quarter, while Zach Napont finished with 10 points and five rebounds and Dalton Gardner added eight points. Redman added six boards as well.

East Jordan stays unbeaten with win

BELLAIRE — The East Jordan Red Devils put three players in double figures in downing the Bellaire Eagles on December 19 in a non-conference game as they improved to 4-0 overall, 2-0 Lake Michigan Conference headed into the holiday break.

Jordan Weber finished with 26 points, while Donny Cutler added 24 and Colin Petrie finished with 15 for EJ as the Red Devils were able to stuff every run the Eagles made at them throughout the contest.

East Jordan jumped out to an 18-9 first quarter lead as Weber poured in 10 points while the Eagles attempted to blanket him with some tight man-to-man defense, to no avail.

The Eagles however did find some success in slowing Weber down in the second quarter, as they edged their way back into the contest, pulling within 22-19 on a Jamal Lockhart putback with about four minutes remaining only to see Cutler take off as the junior point guard weaved his way into the lane for seven of his nine points in the stanza.

The Red Devils would take a 36-21 lead into the break.

Following intermission, East Jordan would come out of the gates with a quick run, opening up a 43-23 cushion, just under two minutes into the third quarter.

Bellaire however would not go away as the Eagles clawed their way back into game, cutting the Red Devil lead to 10 twice in the quarter, the last coming on a triple at the horn to make the score 53-43 headed into the final

eight minutes of regulation.

"It was a game of runs, we knew they would try and take Jordan out of the game and they did a pretty decent job, but we were able to run some sets for him and Cutler got to the basket really well. It was also nice to see Colin Petrie step up and make some shots for

us the second half."

Weber would open the fourth with a three pointer, followed by back to back Cutler steals and layup conversions, pushing the Red Devil lead back to 17 points, 62-45 with 4:12 left in the game.

"We're in a pretty good spot, being 4-0 at the break, we've got a pretty good group of kids and they work hard," coach Weber added.

East Jordan would then go on a 8-4 run over the final four minutes to close out the contest.

The Red Devils return to action on January 16 when they visit Traverse City St. Francis.

BOYNE FALLS — Andrew Stevens had the hot hand early and Marcus Matelski stayed steady throughout the contest as the host Loggers disposed of the visiting Comets 80-39 on Decem-

Stevens and the Loggers jumped out to an early 25-6 first quarter lead. The Boyne Falls senior guard blitzed Mackinaw for 17 points in the stanza, including nailing all five of his three-point attempts.

"When you shoot the ball as well as we did in the first quarter, we put them behind the eight ball early, if we don't make some of those shots and they do, it's a totally different ballgame, fortunately for us we made the shots," Boyne Falls coach Tim Smith said. "Andrew Stevens was just unconscious, but we've seen him do that before in the last couple of years."

The Logger defense shut down the Comets ability to get good looks at the basket, forcing Mackinaw into taking shots they weren't comfortable with or forcing a turnover, while controlling the paint in the process, as Logger big men, Shae Ross and Truman Crego were mon-

sters on the boards, giving up very few second shots.

"Both Shae and Truman played outstanding, they kept their big man off the boards," Smith added. "Both executed well, we were getting a lot of good shots as they are both great screeners and created a lot of open looks for our three good scorers."

In addition to the defensive lockdown, the Logger offense executed with precision and patience, setting screens to free up teammates and moving the ball to the open man for a good look at the rim, each individual understanding and flourishing in their role.

Boyne Falls would lead 45-21 at the half and took a 58-30 lead into the final eight minutes of play.

Matelski would be his usual steady self throughout the game, netting a game-high 35 points, including 12 in final quarter, while also grabbing nine rebounds and dishing out seven assists.

Also for BF, Stevens added 22 points, including six triples, to go with eight rebounds and six assists and Andrew Campbell chipped in with 12 points.

The Loggers, 3-0 overall, 1-0 NLC, hit 10 three-pointers in the contest and were 8-of-9 from the charity stripe.

"We have a couple of weeks now to put in some new stuff and look to get better," coach Smith added. "We don't have a lot of depth, so we've gotta find ways to take care of ourselves and stay healthy."

Mackinaw City (2-1, 0-1) got 11 points from Matt Rivera and 10 from Zach Smith.




