HARBOR SPRINGS -- Marcus Matelski recorded another double-double, his second of the week, as Boyne Falls knocked off Harbor Light Christian, 73-33 in Northern Lakes Conference action on February 13.

With the victory the Loggers, 14-0 overall, 11-0 conference, clinched a share of the NLC title, which is their fourth straight. Boyne Falls has also won 53 consecutive games in the league.

BF jumped out to an early 21-7 first quarter lead and extended that to a 42-14 advantage at halftime. Following a 19 point third quarter, the Loggers had a sizeable cushion headed into the final eight minutes of regulation.

"They (Harbor Light) played the same junk defense as Alanson and we were more prepared for it," Logger coach Tim Smith said. "Plus its the best we shot in five games as we are beginning to get healthy. Marcus (Matelski) really shot the ball well early on some tough contested shots and Shea (Ross) scored six early points to get us going."

Matelski finished with 36 points on 17-of-21 shooting, and added 11 rebounds and six assists to his stat line.

Also for BF, Andrew Stevens tallied 14 points and seven assists, while Shea Ross chipped in with 10 points.

Caleb Wendt had 14 points for Harbor Light.

# Should I Buy or Sell First?

### Part 2 of 2

Brisk selling conditions in some parts of the country require more aggressive tactics.

Brett Furman, a broker in suburban Philadelphia, says the strong market dictates that homebuyers focus on buying first, and selling later.

"The housing market in the suburban Philadelphia market is moving very quickly," said Furman. "Normally we advise our buyers to sell their home first and buy second ... However with the faster moving market, we are advising many of our buyer clients to obtain a mortgage commitment that is not contingent upon selling their existing house."

In their book, House Selling for Dummies (Hungry Minds Inc., 1999), Eric Tyson and Ray Brown "strongly recom-

mend" that you sell first. "Even in good real estate markets, sales frequently drag on much longer than you expect," the authors say. "Selling in a weak market usually compounds the problem. Homeowners tend to overestimate their house's resale value and

underestimate the length of the selling process -- a fiscally deadly one-two punch."

**Featured Property** 

The Dummies book says selling first eliminates financial risk -- no double mortgages and double payments for property taxes and insurance payments. And no worrying about how you'll come up with a down payment.

But selling first isn't the perfect solution. Some of the issues that may come up include:

Being forced out of your house before you have a new place available. Where will you live? Where will your kids go to school?

Having to move twice. Do you want to go through the hassle? Where will you store your extra furniture while you live with family and friends or rent an apartment?

Not being able to find a house you like. How long are you willing to live in temporary quarters until you find a suitable house?

Whichever way you go, it always seems to work out in the end, at least in Gregor's experience.

"I've been in the business for 30 years," he said. "We've never had anyone out on the street and the vast majority of our clients that make double moves are those building new homes that had to have their property sold first."
