

Ramblers rally for district title

Strong fourth quarter the difference

Boyne City 48, East Jordan 45

EAST JORDAN -- Coming through in crunch time!

The Boyne City boys basketball team had dig deep during the fourth quarter of the Class C district final in order to accomplish one of their preseason goals and keep their season alive as they rallied late in the contest and had to withstand a strong Red Devil effort as they pulled out a nail biting, edge of your seat, 48-45 victory on March 13.

The Ramblers, trailing by five entering the final eight minutes of regulation, went back to what they know; hard work, defense and team play as Boyne slowly cut into the East Jordan lead over the first two and a half minutes to pull within 41-10 on two Derek Willis free throws at the 5:38 mark.

On East Jordan's next possession, they would be called for a moving screen, giving the ball

back to the Ramblers and Boyne City senior, Cole Butler would put the Ramblers on top, 42-41 on a drive to the middle, the first Boyne lead since 3:49 of the third quarter.

"Very proud of how everyone stepped up tonight! An elated Boyne City coach Nick Redman said. "Great experience to play in an environment like that, doesn't get better than March Madness."

The fourth quarter comeback wasn't an easy task for the Ramblers as the Red Devils refused to bow out, even after junior sharpshooter Jordan Weber fouled out on an offensive foul call with 2:07 to play in the game.

Fellow junior, Colin Petrie would look to take over the offen-

sive reigns, as he attempted to rally the troops from a 47-43 deficit, as he grabbed ahold of a loose ball with just over a minute remaining and tossed in a floater in the paint to pull East Jordan to within a basket, 47-45.

On the other end of the court, Boyne City drew a Red Devil foul and headed to the charity stripe for a pair of free throws. Unfortunately for the Ramblers, both of the shots rimmed off, giving East Jordan a chance to knot the score with plenty of time remaining on the clock.

The next three possessions however, would not go as either team had planned as the Red Devils turned the ball over by stepping out of bounds on their next possession, followed by the Ramblers turning it over via double-dribble, and with 29.1 seconds to go, East Jordan would then be called for another offensive foul on a drive to the lane.

Following a Boyne City timeout, the Ramblers would enter the ball in from underneath the East Jordan basket and work it across the timeline, avoiding any and all Red Devils that were attempting to get a steal, until Gardner drew a foul with 11.2 seconds to go in the contest.

Gardner would connect on the second of two free throws for a 48-45 Boyne lead.

East Jordan would enter the ball and Petrie was fouled in the backcourt, with 7.4 to go. It was the Ramblers fifth team foul, giving the Red Devils the ball out of bounds near the Boyne City bench.

The Red Devils would enter the ball and get off a desperation three that came up short, rebounded by Willis and he would outlet the ball to Napont at the other end of the court and the senior point guard would dribble out the remaining two seconds and the Ramblers would begin their district title celebration.

"Thank you for all the support we had tonight from the students and community it means a lot to these guys," coach Redman said. "Great high school basketball game, both teams gave it everything they had."

Before exiting the contest, Weber had torched the Ramblers for 27 points, even though Boyne had mixed up the defensive looks he would see the entire game.

After a relatively quiet nine points in the first half, Weber would get it rolling in the third quarter as he dropped 14 points, including four three's from well beyond the arc, taking the Red Devils from a 20-17 halftime deficit and pushing them to a 37-32 lead headed into the fourth



quarter. He would add four more points in the fourth before fouling out.

Also for the Red Devils, Petrie added 11 points, while Tucker Alward, Thomas Brandell and Collin Bajko each chipped in with two points apiece.

Boyne City got 14 points from Willis, while Butler and Napont each added nine points each, with Napont hauling in nine rebounds and Butler grabbing four. Gardner also finished with seven points for the Ramblers.

"Dalton (Gardner) and Derek (Willis) really stepped up," coach Redman added. "Also Colton Sieradski, Mike Dohm and Dominic Archey were a big lift off the bench. Everyone on the team did their role to earn the win.'

With the win, the Ramblers, 18-5, earn their first trip to regional play since the 2012 season, where they will travel to Marquette and face Ishpeming (15-7). The last time the two teams met was in the 1990 quarterfinals, where the Hematites pulled out a 84-66 victory at Cheboygan High School and would advance to the state finals where they would fall to Saginaw-Nouvel. (MHSAA record book)

The Red Devils close out another successful campaign at 17-6. EJ started the season 6-0 and earned the Associated Press Class C, No. 1 ranking in the first poll of the year.

Boyne City 59, **Harbor Springs 32**

EAST JORDAN -- It took the Ramblers a little while to get untracked before knocking off the Rams, 59-32 in the Class C semifinal on March 11 at East Jordan High School.

Clinging to a 19-15 halftime lead, the Boyne City basketball team made the necessary adjustments and exploded out of the gates in the third quarter for 20 points to give themselves a 39-25 cushion heading into the final eight minutes of regulation.

"Our effort was good we just need to play more disciplined on defense and take care of the ball better," Boyne City coach Nick Redman said.

During that third quarter burst, Boyne rallied around the combination of Cole Butler (seven points); Zach Napont (six points); and Tanner Kruzel (five points) as they scored 18 of the teams 20 points during the Rambler run.

The Ramblers were playing without senior floor leader Corey Redman, who is out with a foot injury, continued to spread the ball around like they have all season.

East Jordan 50, **Inland Lakes 42**

EAST JORDAN -- The East Jordan Red Devils continued their quest for another district title with a 50-42 victory over Inland Lakes on March 11.

The win, however, would not come easy.

East Jordan found themselves down 12-11 after one quarter of play, and trailing 17-14 during the second quarter before they switched up their defensive scheme and applied some pressure by employing a halfcourt trap.

That defensive switch, allowed the Red Devils to go from three points down to a six point lead, 24-18 at the half.

A 17-14 advantage in the third quarter allowed East Jordan to extend their lead to 41-32, highlighted by 10 points from junior sharpshooter, Jordan Weber.

Weber would finish with a game-high 25 points to lead the Red Devils, while Colin Petrie chipped in with an all around strong game, netting 11 points, grabbing eight rebounds and making four steals.

Matelski dominates in Boyne Falls victory over Eagles

Boyne Falls 48, Bellaire 41

GAYLORD -- Back to back champions!

That has a pretty good ring to it, and if you ask anyone from Boyne Falls, you'd be pretty hard pressed to find anyone that disagree with that.

The Loggers earned their second consecutive Class D district title with a huge win over rival Bellaire, 48-41 on March 13.

The win, the 21st of the season for Boyne Falls, didn't come easy. The Loggers jumped out to an early 10-2 lead and before the Eagles knew what hit them, the Loggers were us 17-7 after one quarter of play.

"The game was a complete opposite of the game a few weeks ago (a 56-47 loss to Bellaire on February 23)," Boyne Falls coach Tim Smith said. "We got off to a much better start and played with the lead entire night. We played this time with much more energy defensively and we were outstanding on the offensive boards."

The second quarter would see the Eagle try to close the gap a bit, but a nine point effort by Marcus Matelski would keep the Loggers in front 29-17 at the half.

Bellaire would make a run at the Loggers in the third quarter, outscoring BF by an 11-6 margin, getting as close as five points, but Boyne Falls would build their lead back up behind the play of Matelski.

"We controlled tempo of game once we built a nice lead and we kept Bellaire uncomfortable all game with our pressure," coach Smith added. "I was proud of our toughness, we won the loose balls and made championship plays on defensive end all night."

Once the fourth quarter play began, Bellaire attempted to make another run at the Loggers, cutting their lead to five and then four before senior Andrew

Stevens knocked down a pair of free throws at the 2:11 mark, pushing the Boyne Falls lead back to six points and the Loggers would close out the game at the free throw line.

"Marcus (Matelski) was outstanding containing their scorers and he was a man on the glass," Smith added. "At times he put us on his back and carried us, the entire team was engaged we had great energy on floor and on bench. When you win 20 games your league and a district you have had a good year. But we are going to get greedy now and go to TC with a lot of confidence."

Matelski finished with 30 points, 20 rebounds and four steals to lead the Loggers, while Stevens added 10 points and six rebounds and Andrew Campbell chipped in with six points for the 21-2 Boyne Falls.

Bellaire got 18 points from Gabe Meriwether and 14 from Jamal Lockhart.

The Loggers advance to the TC West regional where they face Fairview (13-9) on Monday, March 16.

Boyne Falls 42, Ellsworth 27

GAYLORD -- Meeting for the third time this season, the Loggers and Lancers are somewhat familiar with each other and for three quarters of play, it was anyones ball game.

But it was an 18-5 run over the final eight minutes of play that pushed Boyne Falls from a two point advantage to a 15 point victory, 42-27 over their conference rival at Gaylord St. Mary High School on March 11.

"We really struggled most of the night," Boyne Falls coach Tim Smith said. "We never got into a flow on offense and didn't shoot the ball well all night only 24 percent from floor."

"Ellsworth always junks us (defense) and they have great size at the rim with their two big guys and when you don't make open shots you struggle," Smith added.

Their ability to mix up the defense and control the tempo was exactly what the Lancers were looking for.

"It really came down to free throws at the end of the game," Ellsworth coach Kirk Ikens said. "The game, the style of play was what we wanted, we slowed it down and kept us in range."

"Big difference for us to come from a running clock the first time we played to giving ourselves a chance tonight, as the game was much closer than what the final score indicated," coach Ikens said. "The kids really worked hard and I'm proud of them."

Boyne Falls would finish the game 18-for-20 from the free throw line as Marcus Matelski led the way with 16 points, hitting 10-of-13 free throws and grabbing 10 rebounds. Andrew Stevens added 15 points, including three triples, and shot 6-of-6 from the charity stripe in the fourth quarter.

Also for the Loggers, 20-2, Andrew Campbell added

seven points.

"We did play well defensively only giving up 27 points and that and our rebounding was good enough for us to advance," coach Smith noted. "We also didn't play in eight days and I think we were rusty."

The Lancers were led by Winter Romeyn with 11 points, and Tyler Drenth grabbed nine rebounds.



Defensive adjustments key to victory as the Ramblers advance with win over Ishpeming

MARQUETTE — Leading 13-4 with about three minutes left in the first quarter, the Ishpeming High School boys basketball team appeared to have its Class C regional game against Boyne City well in hand Monday night.

The Ramblers had other ideas, however.

Boyne City went on a 12-3 run to tie the score, then used a 15-10 third quarter advantage to beat the Hematites, 50-43.

BC (19-5) will now meet Iron Mountain (21-2) for the regional title at 7 p.m. Wednesday at Marquette Senior High School. The Mountaineers beat Ironwood 72-52 in Monday night;s opener in Marquette.

"We just got tired and panicked a little," IHS head coach Jeff Olson said of the early advantage that disappeared. "We had some turnovers and threw up some quick shots when we had the lead

"We haven't played a team with that much quickness this season."

Ozzy Corp scored four of his 12 game points in the first quarter surge and Luke Kuliu — back from an ankle sprain — added a 3-point shot among his team-leading 13 points.

"Ishpeming came out and stuck it to us early," BC head coach Nick Redman said. "We came out slow and missed a few easy shots.

"But the guys did a good job staying focused and executing." The Ramblers — with injured star and Central Michigan University recruit Corey Redman not playing due to a foot sprain — got four points apiece from Derek Willis and Zach Napont in their rally. Napont finished with 16 points and nine rebounds.

BC also went to a 3-2 zone defense that caused IHS (15-8) some trouble.

"I like to use a man defense, but I felt we had to go to the zone. We had some foul trouble," coach Redman said. "It was a good adjustment for us."

BC eventually took a 24-22 half-time lead.

"You have to create some things defensively when the ball isn't going in. We weren't able to do that because (BC) was taking us off the dribble.


"We beat the No. 1 team twice this season in Negaunee and Iron Mountain, though. It was a very good season."

Six tips that tell you it's time

Figuring out whether you're ready to buy a house -- whether you're a renter or are aiming to move up or size down -can be a daunting task. But there are signs that will indicate whether you're ready to take the buying plunge.

If you are thinking about buying, you're not alone. So are you ready to make the move? You might be if you:

1. Are familiar with the market. If you've been paying attention to how much houses are listed for in the neighborhoods you're eyeing and have a realistic view of how much a house will cost you, you're in good shape. But if you're dreaming

about that big corner house with no clue about it's asking price, you may want to spend some more time becoming familiar with the market and how much houses are going for.

2. Have the money for a down payment and closing costs. The down payment is a percentage of the value of the property. Freddie Mac says the percentage will be determined by the type of mortgage you select. Down payments usually range from 3 to 20 percent of the property value. Also, you may be required to have Private Mortgage Insurance (PMI or MI) if your down payment is less than 20 percent. Closing costs include points, taxes, title insurance, financing costs and items that must be prepaid or escrowed and other settlement costs. You can expect to pay be-

tween from 2 to 7 percent of the property value. Generally, buyers will receive an estimate of these costs from your lender after you apply for a mort-

3. Know how much you can afford. Freddie Mac says that as a general guide, your monthly mortgage payment should be less than or equal to a percentage of your income, usually about a quarter of your gross monthly income. Also, your income, debt and credit history go into determining how much you can borrow. As a general rule, your debt credit card bills, car loans, housing expenses, alimony and child support -should not be more than about 30 to 40 percent of your gross income.

4. Know what additional expenses will come with owning a home. This includes homeowners insurance, utility bills, maintenance costs -- roofing, plumbing, heating and cooling.

5. Have your credit in good shape and make sure your credit report is accurate. Potential lenders will view your credit history -how much debt you've accrued, how many accounts you have open, whether your payments are made on time, etc. -- to determine whether they'll give you a loan. You should get a report from each of the credit reporting compa-

6. You haven't made any recent major purchases, particularly a vehicle. If you do, you may have a harder time getting a loan -- or it could potentially lower the amount you'll be approved for.
