CHARLEVOIX COUNTY -- What another great year of basketball for the Northern Michigan area. There were great things happening in all corners of our coverage area, from a No. 1 ranking, to repeat conference championships, teams turning their season around, big upsets and tournament runs. And who can forget the student cheering sections, which provided a lot of noise and great support for their respective schools.

All of that doesn't happen unless those teams have the right person leading the charge, and it seems like; Boyne City, Boyne Falls, Charlevoix,

East Jordan and Ellsworth all have the right formula that works for them.

Boyne City finished 15-5 in the regular season, including 12-2 in the Lake Michigan Conference to capture their second consecutive title. But it wasn't until the postseason began that Boyne seemed to hit their stride, winning district and regional titles and advancing to the state semifinals at the Breslin Center on the campus of Michigan State University, only to fall three points short of playing for the Class C title.

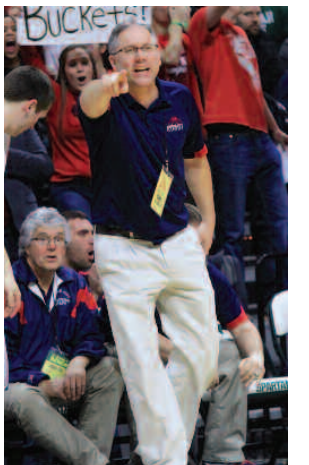
Boyne Falls, reeled off another outstanding regular season, going 18-2, which also included their fourth consecutive Northern Lakes Conference

crown with a 14-0 record. The Loggers also captured their second straight Class D district title and advanced to the regional championship game, where they were ousted in a close contest.

East Jordan was the early favorite in the LMC, starting out the season 5-0, earning the AP Class C No. 1 ranking in the first poll of the season. The Red Devils remained a constant threat for the LMC championship right up until the final week of the regular season.

Charlevoix would begin their season with some stiff competition, but then turned their campaign around by win-

ning 10 of their next 11 games to put themselves back in contention for the LMC title.

Ellsworth had an up and down season, but came on strong as the season wound down, with back to back wins over Central Lake and gave Boyne Falls all they could handle in district play before bowing out.

Along with all of that great team play, their happened to be some outstanding individual play as well. With the respective classes naming their top selections for the 2014-15 season, the Charlevoix County News is proud to announce this years Boys All-Area "Dream Team."

The 2014-15 "Dream Team" once again features talent that can play all five positions, along with key

floor leaders, pure scorers, hard-working rebounders and defensive specialists.

After reviewing all the necessary statistical information and each student-athletes importance to their team and what those individuals faced each and every night on the court on both ends of the court, and sacrifices made for a better team result, it was a very difficult decision between many outstanding athletes, and after narrowing it down to three, the selection of Player of the Year goes to Boyne City senior, Corey Redman.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR

(#2) Corey Redman, Boyne City.

The Rambler senior would help lead the team to the Class C semifinals at the Breslin Center, along with a great supporting cast. As a player that could and did

play all five positions for Boyne, Corey finished the season, averaging 17.8 points per game, 5.9 rebounds and 2.6 assists, while seeing a lot of double-teams in the physical Lake Michigan Conference.

He would also draw the tough task of stopping the opponents biggest offensive threat.

Redman also shot 85 percent from the charity stripe and totaled 1,337 points for his career.

"It's a real honor to be selected, it shows that all the hard work and effort I put in pays off," Corey said.

Redman will take the next step in basketball career next season, and will suit up to play for the Central Michigan University Chippewas.

"My expectations of myself are to work as hard as I can, get under the wings of some of the older players and gain roles," he noted. Redman was asked to reflect on

the season and after some thought he said, "It's the most fun I've had in my high school career. We've always talked about far we wanted to go (in the tournament), but this year, we kept it quiet and didn't want to talk about it (advancing to the Breslin Center)."

"I got to play with my good friends, my best friends. We all work hard and push each other, we're always together doing something and I wouldn't be where I am today without them," he added.

Corey also mentioned that he wouldn't be where he is without his parents, Nick and Julie Redman. "My dad has done so much for me in life and in basketball, a lot of what I do comes from him and I'm honored to be where I am right now." "My mom has done a lot for me as well, whenever I needed to travel, she was there. She also helped out my dad and the team too, from filming,

doing book, entering stats, pretty much anything to help out."

Corey was recently named first team All-State in Class C by the Associated Press, Detroit Free Press, BCAM, Bank Hoops and Prep Hoops.

BOYNE CITY

(#10) Zach Napont, senior.

Zach would also help lead the Ramblers to the Class C semifinals.

The senior point guard would direct traffic on the floor for Boyne, dishing to open teammates, or creating his own shot when needed. He was also a big asset on the defensive end of the court, making timely steals or surprising opponents with his leaping ability and blocking shots

at key moments in a contest.

Zach finished the year averaging 10.7 points per game, grabbing 3.4 boards and dishing out 2.5 assists each night.

(#3) Cole Butler, senior.

The smooth shooting Butler was a key component in the Boyne City attack, leading the team in tournament play with big games against Iron Mountain (20 points) in the regional final and netting a huge double-double (16 points, 10 rebounds) in the state semifinal against Grand Rapids North-Pointe Christian.

Cole averaged 10 points per game, just under seven boards and one assist per contest and would mix up his smooth finesse play on offense, with some hard working physical play on defense.

BOYNE FALLS

(#32) Marcus Matelski, junior.

The all-around leader of the Loggers was a tough matchup for any team, let alone individuals as the junior would draw double-teams on a nightly basis or face defenses geared up in hopes of containing him.

Marcus would dominate the competition that tried slowing him down, while playing within the Logger system. He averaged 29 points per game, 11.2 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 3.4 steals, while shooting an incredible 60 percent from the floor, 42 percent from beyond the three point arch and 80 percent from the free throw line.

Matelski would be selected first team Class D all-state by the Associated Press and BCAM, and second team all-state by the Detroit Free Press, while playing all positions for BF and often times drawing the opponents best player on defense.

(#3) Andrew Stevens, senior.

The sharp-shooting senior was another key piece in the puzzle for Boyne Falls, keeping defenses honest by not allowing them to double team Matelski, and if they did, he would make them pay by converting a three pointer from well beyond the arch. Many times they would come in groups, from two or three in a row, to possibly six.

Stevens would share ball handling duties to get the Logger offense in gear, or if it was needed, he could put the ball on the floor and get to the glass for an easy look or pull up for a jumper.

Andrew finished the season with a per game average of; 13 points, 5.5 rebounds, 5.6 assists, 1.8 steals, while shooting 41 percent from both the floor and three point range and 71 percent from the charity stripe.

(#5) Andrew Campbell, junior.

Campbell was often times overlooked by opponents, but they would soon find out that Boyne Falls could rely on the junior to pick up scoring when it was needed.

Andrew would have one of his better games this season against East Jordan when he would go off for 17 points in a contest that the Loggers had a hard time finding offense during the first three quarters of play.

Campbell finished the season averaging 9.3 points per game, 4.6 rebounds, 3.4 assists, 1.3 steals, while shooting 42 percent from the floor and 36 percent from beyond the arch and 61 percent from the free throw line.

CHARLEVOIX

(#40) Austin Putman, junior.

Austin would help the Rayders withstand a tough early season schedule where they stood at 0-5, Austing and company would rejuvenate the Charlevoix team by leading them to a 12-3 record over the season's final two months.

One of the hardest working players in Northern Michigan, Putman would average 17 points and 10 rebounds per game for the season, but topped the 20 point mark on several occasions during the Rayders resurgence back to the top of the Lake Michigan Conference where the team finished 10-4, tied for third place with East Jordan.

SHEPARD -- The Charlevoix varsity baseball team got their season kicked off on April 11, falling 8-0 in the opener, before rebounding for an 11-7 victory in the nightcap.

In game one, senior Nate Moon took the loss while KeNen Borths pitched 3 2/3 innings of relief, allowing two hits, one walk and two strikeouts.

"Shepherd is one of the best baseball programs in the state in Division 3, it's a little intimidating to see their state championship banners, but if you want to be one of the best, you have to play the best," Rayder coach

Allen Telgenhof said. "I thought for the most part we played well. They scored all of their runs in game one in a huge second inning and in game two, we led 11-2 headed into the last inning."

In the opener, Moon took the loss while KeNen Borths pitched 3 2/3 innings of relief, allowing two hits, one walk and two strikeouts.

While in the nightcap, Hunter Cox picked up the pitching win, with relief help from Austin Putman and Moon, who earned the save. Cox gave up only one hit and struck out three in 4 1/3 innings of work.

(#20) Nate Moon, senior.

Moon could take opponents to the rack or shoot the long ball and do whatever was needed for the team to succeed.

Moon would finish second on the Rayders in scoring, netting 10.5 points per game, while also grabbing seven boards per outing.

(#22) Walker Drost, junior.

Walker would use his lightning quick speed to harass ball handlers all over the court, many times causing a turnover or making a steal on his own.

Drost would put the ball in the hoop when his number was called, dropping just over eight points per game, but did a majority of his damage to opponents by setting up teammates for easy scores, averaging five assists per game for Charlevoix.

EAST JORDAN

(#32) Jordan Weber, junior.

One of the few players that opponents need to guard once they cross the half-court line. Weber was not only a threat from close range, he could and would knock down shots from 30-40 feet away from the basket, making him a tough person to defend and opening up the middle of the Red Devils offense for fellow teammates to flourish.

Jordan would finish the season with a 28 points per game average, while hauling in nearly seven rebounds per contest as well.

Weber started the season with a bang, dropping 45 points in the

Weber was selected first team Class C all-state by the Associated Press and BCAM and fifth team all-state by the Detroit Free Press.

(#24) Colin Petrie, junior.

Petrie, moved to the point guard position part way during the season for the Red Devils, something new for him and he seemed to flourish in his new role, coming close to numerous triple-doubles during the year.

Colin finished the year with averages of 12 points per game, five assists and was second on the team in rebounding with 91 total boards.

"Great all around team player who has an outstanding work ethic and one of the most coachable players I've ever coached," coach Darrin Weber said. "One of the best young men I've ever been around, I've enjoyed watching him grow over the years and look forward to seeing him grow some more."

(#33) Collin Bajko, junior.

A key component in the East Jordan game plan, Bajko stepped further from the basket this year and became more of a perimeter threat than in the past, many nights, opening things up for the Red Devils other scoring threats.

Bajko would average over eight points per outing and haul in six

rebounds.

"Very blue collar worker, who does a little of everything," coach Weber said. "Hustles on everything he does, great student and young man, and defines hard work. Great role model for younger players."

ELLSWORTH

(#22) Winter Romeyn, senior.

The Lancer leader would pace the team in scoring in nearly every contest this season.

Romeyn would use his athleticism to matchup with quick guards to high scoring forwards. He averaged 11.4 points per game this season for Ellsworth and hauled in seven rebounds per game as well.

(#12) Luke Seaney, senior.

Luke was a defensive force for Ellsworth, harassing the opponents ball handlers and creating havoc with his pressure defense.

Seaney averaged six points and three assists per game for the Lancers this season, while running the point guard position and getting the team into their offensive flow.

just recently finished one heck of a ride the Ramblers put on this past March. Boyne then traveled to Marquette, capturing their first regional title in 25 years and finally

CLOSING CHECKLIST TIP #1: RETAIN EXECUTED SELLER DISCLOSURES, PURCHASE CONTRACT AND ADDENDUMS

Ideally, you will receive a complete closing package by your escrow officer or closing agent. But you could also find some of these documents scattered about in your car or at your office. Keep all of these documents in a safe place. It's conceivable you could need them again, especially if a bill was unpaid or the buyer challenges something and hires an attorney.

CLOSING CHECKLIST TIP #2: CLEAN THE HOUSE

If you don't have time to clean, hire a professional cleaning service. How clean to leave a house is often personal preference. It's not always necessary to shampoo the carpets, but that's a nice touch. This also means wipe down cabinets, inside and out. It doesn't hurt to make your last impression

on the buyer a good one by polishing sink fixtures. Leave your home the way you, as a buyer, would like to find it.

CLOSING CHECKLIST TIP #3: TURN OFF SHUT-OFF VALVES

If you have disconnected a washer, for example, make sure the shut-off valve is completely turned off because a small drip, drip, can eventually flood a home. Some sellers shut off the valves to all water sources such as sinks, toilets and dishwashers, too. Leave a note for the buyers so they won't call a plumber when the water won't turn on.

CLOSING CHECKLIST TIP #4: ATTEND THE FINAL WALK-THROUGH

There are so many

quirks that only a home seller knows, and you could pass on these tips to a new home buyer during the final walk-through. Things like which light switch operates the lights, whether a door sticks, or how to clean a swimming pool. I like to ask sellers what they always wanted to do for a home improvement project but never got around to doing.

CLOSING CHECKLIST TIP #5: CANCEL YOUR INSURANCE POLICIES

Wait until you know the deed has recorded or title transfer has formally occurred before you call your insurance agent. You should receive a refund from a prepaid premium for your homeowner's insurance.

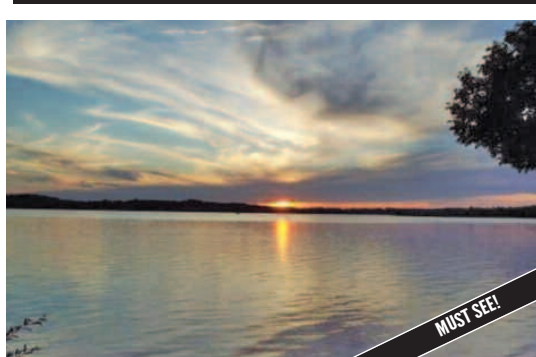

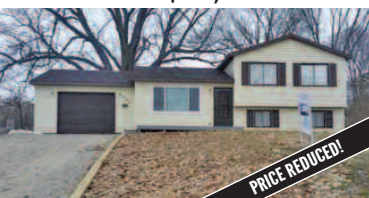

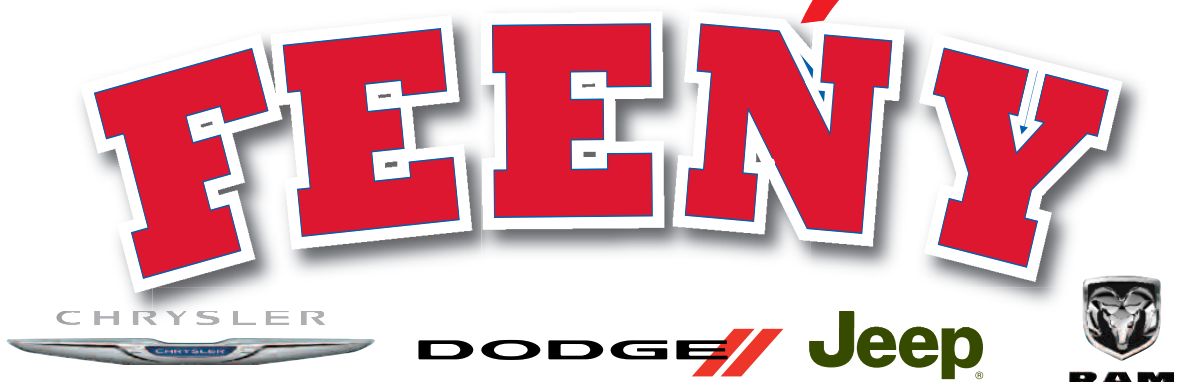
