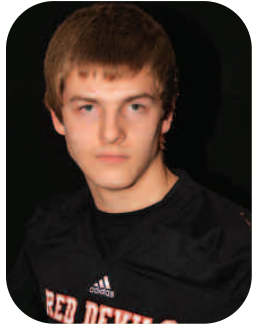

Ramblers take second place at own invitational

Bonus baseball for those in attendance

BOYNE CITY -- The host Ramblers would finish 2-1 on the day during their own Boyne Invitational on April 25, falling in the championship contest to Alpena 2-1, in eight innings of play. Boyne picked up a pair of exciting wins in pool play prior to that as they knocked off Gaylord 6-5 in the opener in nine innings of play before downing Newberry 11-0.

In the title contest, things were pretty quiet until the third inning when Alpena was able to push across the first run of the game for a 1-0 lead. Boyne City was able to get that run back in the fifth on an RBI single from senior Zach Napont.

The Ramblers attempted to take the lead in the top of the 8th, when Napont was cut down at the plate, and in the bottom half of the frame, the Wildcats scored on a double for the 2-1 win.

At the plate for Boyne, Derek Willis and Napont each had two hits.

While on the mound, senior Dalton Gardner took his first loss of the season, slipping to 4-1, against Class A Alpena, as he and Ethan Habasco combined to allow only six hits in the game.

"This was simply a great baseball game. Quality pitching, quality defense, and enough base runners to make every inning drama-filled," Rambler coach Mark Pontoni said. "When they brought in (Chris) Modrzynski (playing Division I baseball next season) to face us in the fifth, I told our guys that that was a measure of respect we had earned from their coach."

Tanner Kruzel, Derek Willis and Dalton Gardner were voted to the all-tournament team

In the opener, Boyne and Gaylord decided that six innings just wasn't going to be enough as the two battled back and forth for nine innings of play, before the Ramblers ended the contest.

Boyne City was down to their last strike in the top of the seventh, down two, with no one on, as Tanner Kruzel punched home a clutch 2-run single, scoring Colton Sieradski and Gardner, as each had singled in their at-bats.

In the eighth, Habasco singled in Napont to take the lead, but Gaylord answered with a run of their own in the bottom half of

the inning.

Kruzel, tossed the eighth and ninth, shutting down Gaylord for the win, improving to 2-0 on the season.

Willis pitched the first seven innings allowing one earned run and striking out nine.

"Two out rallies in the last inning are one of the most satisfying things about coaching baseball," coach Pontoni said. "It should be no surprise that this group of players never feels out of a game, and the guys who we expect to deliver in clutch situations did just that. This will be one of our signature wins this season."

In game two, Boyne took advantage of a tired Newberry team, holding the Indians to one hit and allowing only one runner to get as far as 2nd base.

Seniors, Gardner and Maceo Vroman combined on the shutout, with Gardner earning the win and Vroman getting the save in his first appearance on the mound since his freshman season.

The Ramblers pounded out 12 hits led by Gardner's three singles, while James Roberson and Habasco added two each and Gardner, Max Cuper, and Roberson each had two RBIs.

"The team never lost focus against a team that was struggling. Dalton did a great job dominating their hitters early

and Maceo gave us a much needed couple of innings to close out the game," the coach added.

"This allowed Dalton to come back and start the next game and gave our overworked staff some important rest."

Boyne City is now 11-5 on the year and 4-2 in the LMC.

EAST JORDAN -- On April 23, the Red Devils had to withstand a late rally by Boyne City as the two teams completed their suspended game from April 16 (due to darkness) in securing a 9-6 Lake Michigan Conference victory.

East Jordan was leading 9-3 when the two teams continued where they left off in the top of the fourth, with Boyne pushing across a pair of runs in the inning and another in the fifth, but could get no closer.

Red Devils senior Tucker Alward finished the game he started, allowing eight hits, while walking six and fanning five.

"Tucker's arm was a little sore from throwing a complete game against Charlevoix on Tuesday, but he wanted the ball, and when a kid looks you dead in the eye saying he wants to finish, you kind of got to trust he's ready, and Tucker was," East Jordan coach Tom Reid said. "The kid has true grit."

At the plate, the hot hitting, Herschell Sutton continued his offensive onslaught with a three hits, including an RBI double, while Colin Petrie added three hits with an RBI, and Jordan Peterson also added an RBI single. Wyatt Crick and Noah Raymond each added singles.

Best Time for Birding

“I never for a day gave up listening to the songs of our birds, or watching their fascinating habits...”

~John James Audubon

During this season of awakenings—think delicate, olive

green tree buds, trilliums emerging from crystalline soil, and murmurs of morel mushrooms—there is no better time to go on a

bird watching adventure. The good news is that birding opportunities in our area are as numerous as gulls on the lakeshore. Here are some upcoming ways to fill up your birding checklist and get some healthy aerobic exercise while watching our fine-feathered friends:

Join a gaggle of other wildlife lovers on one of the Straits Area Audubon Society (SAAS) Raptor Watch field trips. I joined a group of researchers and birders on a recent junket and had a blast while learning a great deal about the nocturnal behavior of Saw-whet and Long-eared owls. Professional bird-bander, Ed Pike, and his SAAS colleagues, are cataloging owl migrations and have captured and banded over 120 owls this year. Even greater numbers of these wonderful winged-creatures are being tallied as part of the Mackinac Straits Raptor Watch. The team sets up at two sites in the Mackinaw City area and hope to break their remarkable count of over 43,000 raptors migrating through the straits last year. This year's totals already

eclipse 21,000, including over 300 massive golden eagles on their way to Canada! Contact Pike at (231) 758-3319 or go to mackinacraptorwatch.org for trip information.

The Petoskey Regional Audubon Society (PRAS) will be hosting a FREE Bird Walk at Bay View Association Woods on Saturday, May 2 at 8:30 a.m. The public is invited to join PRAS member, Tracy Datlen, for a two-hour bird hike on mostly flat trails in the area. With migration season at a peak in May the group will be steering their spotting scopes at an unprecedented diversity of song birds, waterfowl, and raptors. Loaner binoculars and bird checklists for Emmet Co. provided. Meet the flock at Water Street tennis courts of the Bay View Association in Petoskey (off of Arlington Avenue).

PRAS members will also lead early morning birding events on all Tuesdays and Thursdays in May. The Tuesday 8 a.m. walks will be at Pond Hill Farm near Harbor Springs. Pond Hill Farm is located about 5 miles northwest of Harbor Springs on M-119. Continue on M-119 for 1/4 mile past the Pond Hill Farm entrance, and park in the berry field. The Thursday 7:30 a.m. walks start at Spring Lake Park located on M-119 near the US 31/M-119 intersection north of Petoskey. Meet at the gazebo, and the group will hike the easy trails along Mud Lake to Round Lake. Plan on a two-hour excursion and bring binoculars, field guides, and sturdy shoes if available. a variety of interests, from discussions about wildlife food plots and hunting and fishing tactics, to a local couple's ambition to catch as many fish species as possible, among many other subjects. Among the seminar presenters will be Big Boys TV hosts Kevin and Jada Johnson, of Gaylord, who will discuss how landowners can use food plots and harvest plots to improve the quality of their deer herd while benefiting other wildlife. Samples will be available for seminar guests to have a better look at different seed

blends. The father/daughter duo tour the country and globe in pursuit of big game for their hit TV series which airs on the Sportsman Channel, Pursuit, Wild TV, ABC and NBC.

The men of Gaylord-based Michigan Gone Wild – Alvin and Arron Sitkiewicz, Joe Sullivan and Jordan Kettlewell – will also be at the expo to talk about the tactics they use hunting and fishing the woods and waters of Northern Michigan for their online video series. Wayne Sitton, aka “Dr.

Deer,” will talk about whitetail necropsy and how the detailed dissections he performs on deer helps determine the overall health of Michigan's herd. Gaylord anglers Joy and

Josh Leisen will share their experience in “lifelike fishing,” where they travel and fish in hopes of catching the most species possible in their lifetime. So far, Josh has caught 256 species

across 10 states and five foreign countries; while his wife, Joy, has reeled in 196 species including several types of shark, stingray, gar and dozens of tropical fish.

On Saturday evening, Michigan's own Gourmet Gone Wild will offer a cooking demonstration and serve up three family-friendly appetizers featuring wild fish and game. Cost for the 6 p.m. demo and tasting is an additional \$10 per person. Register online by visiting www.tinyurl.com/ggw2015.

Expo admission is \$5 for adults, \$3 for kids 4-12, and free for kids 3 and under. The Sportsplex is located at 1250 Gornick Ave., off Wisconsin Avenue. Attendees will also have an opportunity to place an entry for a chance to win a hot tub provided by JP Heating.

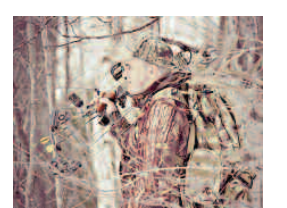
