Rayders/Red Devils split in non-conference meeting

EJ falls one run shy in doubleheader losses to Elks

EAST JORDAN -- Familiar setting, familiar Lake Michigan Conference opponent.

But with their LMC schedule wrapped up and an open date available, the Red Devils and Rayders decided to take on each other in non-conference action on May 21, as each team was looking for a quality opponent in preparation for district play.

The result, a mirror image from their Lake Michigan Conference meeting earlier in the season, with the two teams splitting the doubleheader, the Rayders earning a 4-0 win in the opener, and the Red Devils bouncing back for a 7-6 win in game two.


Noah has been named second-team all-state each of the last two seasons.

Proper Catch-and-Immediate Release Techniques

New Michigan fishing regulations permit anglers to do battle with stout smallmouth and lunker largemouth bass yearround. All northern lakes,

therefore, are now open to Catch-and Immediate Release (CIR) bass angling. Therefore, a refresher of safe and proper catch and release techniques is in order. Here are a few:

Crimp down the barb on the hook with a pair of needle-nose pliers so it's easily removed. There is no evidence that fish hooked on a barbless hook are less likely to be landed.

Use circle hooks when bait fishing. Studies have shown that the use of circle hooks can reduce overall hooking mortalities by 50%.


Leave the fish in the water whenever possible. A study of rainbow trout in Canada found that fish taken out the water for as little as 30 seconds had twice the mortality as fish kept in the water. Trout tend to be more fragile, but even brawny bass have a lower survival rate the longer they are kept out of the water.

Have the camera ready for a CPR (Catch Photo Release) and save the shots for only the trophy worthy fish.

Wet your hands thoroughly before handling fish. Dry hands can scrape the fish's natural protective slime coating and leave the fish prone to fatal bacterial and fungal infection. For similar reasons, the use of a landing net made of soft knotless fabric is critical.

Fish hooked deeply in the gills or gullet have a relatively high mortality rate. Up to 35% are lost when accompanied by bleeding, while fish hooked in the lips or jaw survive at least 95% of the time.

If a fish is gut hooked or hooked in the gills consider keeping it if it is legal size. Even if you cut the line, deeply hooked fish rarely survive. Get out the cornmeal and a sizzling skillet and enjoy wonderfully healthy meal!

For bass, lip landing is a viable alternative to grabbing them by hand or using a landing net.

Never handle a fish using the gill plate because the gills are a very delicate, vital tissue.

When releasing all fish, cradle them under water while gently moving them back and forth until they take off under their own power. Bring the fish to the boat as

quickly as possible and never use ultra-light gear if you plan to release a fish. Many fish die from exhaustion if played for a long period of time on light tackle.

Using these responsible practices with fidelity will insure greater success and enjoyment of your fellow anglers in the future!


