Ramblers rally past Red Devils

Boyne City 13, East Jordan 5

MANCELONA – Make that three in a row for the Boyne City Rambler softball team.

Three straight district titles that is, following a 13-5, late inning, come from behind win on June 1 over Lake Michigan Conference rival, East Jordan.

The Red Devils would not make this an easy task for the Ramblers though as EJ was in control for a majority of the contest and leading 5-4 heading into the bottom of the sixth inning.

With one out in the bottom of the sixth, sophomore Emma Vondra reached on an error; freshman Katie Hoth was substituted to run for her and then senior Lauren Richards tripled to begin what would turn out to be a Boyne City hit parade, as the Ramblers would score eight more times, giving BC a 13-5 lead, before the Red Devils were able to record out number two.

That would be all the scoring for the remainder of the game.

The Red Devils got on the board first, scoring twice in the opening inning and holding the Ramblers to a single run in their half of the frame.

East Jordan would then add three more runs in the third, on key singles from Sydney Drew and Kaitlin Loviska.

Boyne would match the Red Devils with a three spot of their own in the bottom half of the inning as Hannah Hoth hit an RBI single to plate Brooke Fouchia, and Jordan Weiss added a sacrifice fly that would score the others, pulling the Ramblers back within one, 5-4, setting the stage for the monster half of the BC sixth inning.

Emma Shumaker picked up the win for the Ramblers in the circle, going the distance, allowing five runs on nine hits, no walks and struck out 10.

At the plate for Boyne, Hannah Hoth finished with three hits and two RBIs, while Fouchia and Paige Hornbeck added two hits each, with Hornbeck picking up two RBIs.

Also for the Ramblers, Richards tripled, Shumaker added a two RBI double and Vondra singled.

For the Red Devils, Lindsay Schroeder took the pitching loss, going the distance, allowing 13 runs on 12 hits, while fanning eight and walking three.

Karah Dunson paced the East Jordan offense with three hits, including two doubles and two

Boyne City improves to 19-12-1 on the season and advances to regional play at Traverse City St. Francis and will face LMC rival St. Francis at noon on Saturday, June 6.

The Rayders reached the championship game after a big win over Boyne City in the semifinal and took an early lead in the title game.

Charlevoix senior, Noah Certa blasted a two RBI single that plated Alex Kleiber and KeNen Borths and it looked as if the Rayders were about to get things going when the Ironmen closed the door, preventing more damage.

Certa would finish with two hits in his final game for Charlevoix.



Mancelona 10, East Jordan 0



DNR gives tips for safely operating ATVs

As summer kicks off in Michigan, national ATV Safety Week (June 6-14) is a good opportunity for the Department of Natural Resources to remind riders of important safety tips that can help ensure a more enjoyable off-road experience.

Here are the DNR's top 10 safety tips for ATV riding:

Always wear a U.S. Department of Transportation-approved helmet, goggles, long sleeves, long pants, over-theankle boots and gloves.

Never ride under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.

Never carry a passenger on a single-rider ATV, and no more than one passenger on an ATV specifically designed for two people.

Supervise riders younger than 16; ATVs are not toys. Ride only on designated

trails and at a safe speed. Take an off-road vehicle safety course or an online course. Visit the DNR website at michigan.gov/dnr and check for a course near you

under the Education & Out-

reach menu. Do a pre-ride check of your vehicle to make sure it is in proper working order. Pay close attention to the tires, making sure they aren't low and don't have leaks. Low

tire pressure can cause han-

dling issues for your ORV. Know your trail – study the map for where you are riding before you head out and become familiar with where

the sharp curves are located. Know where you're riding – before heading out, make sure you know whether or not the county you're riding in allows ORV use on county roads. Do not mistake state

forest roads for county roads. Contact the county sheriff's department, road commission or county clerk's office for information about each county's ORV ordinances. The DNR also keeps updated ORV maps on its website.

ORVs primarily are designed for off-road use. Driving on paved surfaces is hazardous because of handling issues. Riding on paved roads is a common cause of ORV-related fatalities.

Beaver Pond Brookies

Much like finding a cluster of delectable morel mushrooms in an expansive ash forest, stumbling across a beaver pond

on a remote northern stream is a lucky encounter indeed. This is especially true if the damn is large and old enough to have created a substantial pool of deep water. Anglers who discover such "diamonds in the rough" just might be in for a brook trout ballyhoo!

When deep water environments are created by beaver damns they can furnish prime fish habitat where it didn't previously exist. That's because the trout are looking for the security this deeper water affords and the

substantial food it attracts, especially baitfish and aquatic insects. Of particular interest are the large, burrowing may fly larvae of the genus Hexagania that dwell in the silt bottom that results from the damning up process. The "Hex" hatch of these mammoth "fish flies" is the most famous bug phenomena in all of Michigan. When this is occurring trout are more active than any other time of year as they commence a feeding frenzy for the plump insect nuggets.

The age of the beaver lodge is also a key component as to whether or not a beaver pond will hold fish. Unfortunately, beavers can be here one day and gone the next. Consequently, the damns can deteriorate without the animal's constant attention. An excellent fishing area may become dead water if abandoned by the beavers.

Brook trout are the most popular beaver pond fish. They won't tip the scale to the same

extent as rainbow and brown trout, but what they lack in size they more than make up for with spunk and display the most stunningly beautiful colors in the freshwater fish world.

Baits for successful beaver pond angling range from wet and dry flies, number 0 or 1 Mepps or Panther Martin spinners, and good ole, "garden hackle" aka as worms. Speaking of bait, make sure you pinch down your hook barbs, handle the fish as little as possible, release him gently while facing him upstream, and try to bring the fish in as quickly as possible to prevent possible deadly exhaustion. It's not unusual for a beaver pond brookie population to stunt. Therefore, if you catch a few that are legal sized, they are a delicious deli-

Therefore, a beaver pond are pleasant surprises when you happen across one. I've stumbled on a few while walking deep in the woods small game hunting.

They exist on many northern streams including the Jordan and Maple Rivers and Hemingway's beloved Horton Creek. If you find one, scout out nearby tributaries in hopes of finding

more ponds.

No matter where you go, or what you use, beaver pond fish are often very willing to bite. Toward that end, tight lines anglers, tight lines!

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT AMENDING JORDAN VALLEY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AUTHORITY'S ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT to amend the Articles of Incorporation of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority is entered into between the City of East Jordan, a Michigan home rule city, whose address is P.O.Box499EastJordan, Michigan 49727 (the City); Jordan Township, whose address is 574 S. M-66 Hwy., Mancelona, Michigan 49659; Echo Township, whose address is 2021 Finkton Rd, East Jordan, Michigan 49727; South Arm Township, whose address is P.O. Box 304, East Jordan, Michigan 49727; and Banks Township, whose address is P.O. Box 68, Ellsworth, Michigan 49729; all of which are Michigan general law townships located in Charlevoix County and Antrim County, Michigan (the Townships). Collectively these parties shall be referred to as the "Incorporating Municipalities."

RECITALS

- The Incorporating Municipalities created the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority by the adoption of its Articles of Incorporation, which were filed with the Michigan Department of State, Office of the Great Seal State on February 19, 2014.
- B. The Incorporating Municipalities now desire to amend Article II of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority's Article of Incorporation to remove Eveline Township as an Approved Contracting Municipality, since Eveline Township does not desire to be an Approved Contracting Municipality under the Articles of Incorporation.
- C. The Incorporating Municipalities therefore enter into this Agreement for the purpose of amending Article II of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority's Article of Incorporation, as provided herein.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the Incorporating

That Article II of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority's Article of 1. Incorporation shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

II. APPROVED CONTRACTING MUNICIPALITIES

The Incorporating Municipalities hereby agree to recognize a class of municipalities that will contract with the Authority to provide ambulance services within a portion of those municipalities, as specified in the contract. This class of municipalities shall be known as "Approved Contracting Municipalities." All Approved Contracting Municipalities shall possess the rights and obligations as specified in these Articles of Incorporation. The Incorporating Municipalities hereby agree and approve the following municipality as an Approved Contracting Municipality:

Wilson Township, a Michigan general law township, whose address is P.O. Box 447, Boyne City, Michigan 49712; and

Additional municipalities may become Approved Contracting Municipalities by an amendment to these Articles of Incorporation that is approved by all of the Incorporating Municipalities and the previously recognized Approved Contracting Municipalities. Nothing in this Article, however, shall be construed to limit the power of the Authority Board to contract with other municipalities to provide ambulance services under the terms and conditions of agreements approved by the Authority Board. Any such contract will not confer upon the contracting municipality recognition as an Approved Contracting Municipality, unless these Articles of Incorporation are amended as provided in this Article.

- 2. That the Secretary of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority shall be responsible for publishing this amendment to the Articles of Incorporation in the Antrim County Review and in the Charlevoix County News and for filing a certified copy of these articles with the Secretary of State as required by the Emergency Services to Municipalities Act.
- 3. That this amendment shall become effective upon being filed with the Secretary of State as required by the Emergency Services to Municipalities Act.


