Ramblers open season with convincing win over Mendon

Ground game, solid defense key victory

Boyne City 38, Mendon 14

BOYNE CITY -- Some had questions coming into the season about how the Boyne City Ramblers football team would respond to reaching a semifinal berth last year.

Question answered.

The 2015 Boyne City Ramblers made a statement against Division 8 powerhouse Mendon, downing the Hornets 38-14 in the season opener for both schools.

"The game played out like we thought," Boyne City coach David Hills said. "They ran their power game, and are very good at executing those plays. As the game progressed, we got better at defending that part of their offense."

The Hornets got things started off on a good note, moving the ball 76 yards on the opening drive, capping it with a 34-yard scoring strike from quarterback Trey Cook to Hunter Lovell for a 7-0 lead, five minutes into the game.

The Ramblers responded with a six minute, fifty three second, 14 play, 63-yard, drive of their own, with senior Malik Smith punching it in from five yards out. A Tanner Kruzel two-point conversion would give Boyne the lead and they wouldn't look back as they would reel off another 22 unanswered points, for a 30-7 lead, before the Hornets would find the endzone at about the six minute mark of the fourth quarter, making it 30-14.

Bovne wouldn't take long to respond as on second and six from the Rambler 24, Smith took a handoff and weaved his way off tackle to some daylight and turned on the jets, shaking off three would be tacklers in the process as he rumbled 82 yards for his second score of the evening and following a successful conversion, a 38-14 lead with just over three minutes to play in the contest.

"Offensively, we wanted to mix it up with some inside-outside running and I thought we did that," Hills added. "I also thought both of our QB's (Mason Gardner and Derek Willis) handled themselves well."

The Ramblers tallied 328 yards on the ground between seven different players, led by Smith's big game of 193 on 21 carries and two

Junior Tarin Bell chipped in

with 71 yards on 10 carries, while James Roberson rushed four times for 31 yards and a seven yard score. Gardner was three of five passing for 49 yards and a pair of touchdowns, connecting with Luke Sage

On the defensive side of the ball, Kruzel and Sage seemed to be everywhere the Hornets turned as they finished with 11 and 10 tackles respectively. Kruzel also had 1.5 sacks and a forced fumble, while Sage recorded three tackles for a

Carter Wilmot added seven stops, half of a sack and a fumble recov-

"Our level of execution was not as sharp as we need it to be," Hills noted. "We did have good pursuit at times, but we need to get faster."

The Ramblers (1-0) now turn their focus to longtime rival Charlevoix (1-0), when the two teams lock up on September 3 at Kipke Field in Charlevoix.

"It's a rivalry game, it doesn't matter what the records are," Hills said. "Charlevoix has good team speed, they have some good backs, if you miss a tackle, they will make you pay for it. We need to maintain leverage and do what we are supposed to do."

INDIAN RIVER -- Sometimes it takes a little bit to get things going. The East Jordan football team

found themselves down 18-0 at the half, before they began to chip away at the Inland Lakes lead, ultimately outplaying the Bulldogs the entire second half, but coming up just short in an 18-14 season opening loss on August 27.

"The kids played hard and never game up," Red Devils coach Allan Peterson said. "We spotted them 18 with a few turnovers, and you just can't turn the ball over playing a good team like Inland Lakes."

The Red Devils were outmatched sizewise, and the team seemed to let that get to them in the early stages of the game.

"They must have had about 60 pounds (estimating) a kid on us, they were huge," coach Peterson noted. "I think we had a little bit of sticker shock at first."

The second half would be a different story for East Jordan as they found the endzone on a Colin Shepard two-yard run. The play was set up by a Donny Cutler 65 yard run to the two yard line.

The Red Devils would draw within four points a few minutes

later as Trey Peterson would score from five yards out. Shepard would connect with Jake Skrocki on the conversion attempt, cutting the Bulldogs lead to 18-14.

The game would remain the same, but EJ would make it interesting on their final drive, as they took the ball from their own 15 yard line and proceeded to move it down the field to the Inland Lakes 35, but ran out of time.

"We bent a bunch, but we didn't break," Peterson noted. "We had a bunch of kids step up on defense. I am super proud of these kids and we will clean up the miscues and be just fine."

The whoops, hollers, screeches, cheers, and yelps I was hearing were actually over a mile away and were created by almost 300 tubers as they were launching en masse from the boat ramp below the Mio Dam. The event, appropriately dubbed Uber Tuber, was created in an attempt to set a new Guinness Book of World

I had not heard about Uber Tuber but was fortunate to be in the right place at the right time as the second annual Oscoda County

OCRiverfest was featuring this phenomenal initiative at the end of its three day festival. The mission of the OCRiverfest was to, "celebrate our most prized natural asset, the Au Sable River!"

I waded in a little further and waited for the flotilla to come around the bend near Loud's Rest landing. When the massive chain of rubber-carrying all shapes, sizes and races of humans aged 5 to 75-first came into sight I almost dropped my fly rod in the river. The conglomeration of tubes featuring every color of the rainbow was quite a spectacle. I cursed myself for not having a camera but knew that

such an event must have been captured on film by many.

Knowing that every
self respecting trout was
probably cowering under a
log in 10 feet of water I
reeled in and headed for
humanity. Steve Priestap,
owner of Gott's Landing
(989-826-3411) excitedly
shared, "It was a perfect

day for the Riverfest and for the Uber Tuber event. Everyone had a great time!"

The OCRiverfest was sponsored by Oscoda County officials and the two canoe liveries in the area-Gott's and Hinchman Acres-pitched in with reduced tube rentals. Blue Flame Propane, Woodhaven Log and Lumber, Q100.3 Radio, and Northern Power Sports were also major sponsors.

The OCRiverfest website captured it well when it described the motivation for Uber Tuber:

"People in Oscoda
County have known for a
long time that the Au Sable
River is the best tubing
river in all the land and we
thought it was about time
we took our form of water
recreation global. What better way to put us on a world
stage than with a Guinness
Book of World Records!"

On the lovely, partly sunny 75 degree day the participants embarked on the 4-hour float trip that ended at Comins Flats nearly 10 miles downstream. Some fascinating aerial photos of the string of tubes can be viewed at oscodaherald.com.

When I asked Uber Tuber mastermind and Mio Economic Development Commission member, Pat Kelly, about the record he responded,

"The old record was 251 tubers, we unofficially beat that with 291 but are waiting to hear from Guinness if it's official. The official word from Guinness may take a long time but we are confident that we beat the record!" When asked "what's next?" Kelly responded, "We are already planning another similar event for next year!"

So if you are a lover of the northern Michigan outdoors, stay tuned for how you can get involved in next year's challenge!

Rayders put on offensive show in opener

McLean leads Charlevoix to victory

Charlevoix 53, Elk Rapids 30

CHARLEVOIX -- If it seemed like Charlevoix junior running back Jared McLean scored just about everytime he touched the ball, it's because he pretty much did.

McLean would hit paydirt on five of his first six carries, including a 68-yard run on the Rayders first play from scrimmage, en route to 298 yards rushing on only 10 carries. He would also add an 85-yard kickoff return on the Rayders second possession, giving Charlevoix a 13-3 lead just over eight minutes into the game.

"He's a special kid, at anytime, he can take it to the house," Rayder coach Ron Bindi said. "With a couple of guys out, he really stepped up. Our other backs also came in and did a good job and took advantage of what Elk Rapids gave us."

The Charlevoix offensive line created hole after hole for the Rayder running backs to run through, as the team totaled 340 yards on the night. They also did their job of protecting the quarterback as Forrest Noirot completed five of nine passes for 80 yards.

Charlevoix took their biggest lead of the night early in the third quarter, following a McLean 43 yard run, but then had to weather a Elks attempt at a comeback.

"We started strong

and were able to hang on," coach Bindi noted. "We started to lose it after our score in the third quarter, some lack of focus coming out of the locker room, and before we knew it they were closer than we would have liked."

In addition to McLean's big night, Brad Klinger added a 33-yard touchdown run. Austin Putman hauled in two passes for 53 yards and Klinger had three receptions for 27 yards.

Hunter Cox was successful on two extra point attempts.

On the defensive side of the ball, the Rayders forced four turnovers, including three interceptions by Klinger and a fumble recovery by Erik Oshaben that he returned 16-yards for a score.

McLean also recorded five tackles and five assists, while Cam Alden added five stops and three assists, while Justin Adkins had three tackles and nine assists.

The Rayders host Boyne City on September 3 in front of the home crowd. Both teams enter the contest with 1-0 records.

"I think we can become a very good football team, but we can't have that letdown against good quality opponents," Bindi added. "We have a lot of improving to do, our biggest thing is to stay focused and play all four quarters."



As we are coming out of the dog days of summer many remember the excitement and anticipation of finding the famous Morel Mushroom last spring. As spring gives way to summer the excitement turns to disappointment as the Morels go back to their elusive hid-a-way. But this doesn't have to be the end of your love for mushrooms. There are so many wonderful mushrooms that are if not as good but in my opinion better than Morels. This article does come with a warning, Remember that there are a number of elements that go into properly identifying a mushroom. If the mushroom you have does not satisfy ALL of these elements, do not pick it, and definitely do not eat it. Use this content at your own risk.

So let's talk about a small sample of the delightful mushrooms that are available for your enjoyment. One that blooms in the spring is Pheasant's back or Dryad's Saddle Polyporus squamosus, these make some fantastic mushroom soups, then summer gives us the magnificently firm Chanterelle mushrooms, Cantharellus cibarius, this one pairs deliciously with steaks and or chicken, and at the same time you will also find the silky, light Oyster mushrooms, Pleurotus ostreatus, that actually smells like an Oyster and is a great side dish to any meal. The next two are my personal top two favorite mushrooms; first is Chicken of the Woods, Laetiporus sulphureus, this mushroom grows on dead logs and it is great fried and yes it does have the same taste and texture of chicken, one of the last ones to bloom before the cold hand of winter grabs them all is Hen of the Woods, Grifola frondosa, this elusive top choice edible mushroom is a favorite

to many top chefs.

While there are so many more to mention the ones listed are good ones to get your love for mushrooms flowing again during the summer and fall months. Here is just a small sample of resources to reference for you to begin to expand your mushroom knowledge. First is this website also is a great place for you

The edibility of wild mushrooms should be approached with respect and with the same caution you would show whenever you try a new food source. Edible wild mushrooms are truly a culinary treasure; however, they need to be approached carefully. Some species are deadly poisonous. It is very important that you accurately identify a wild mushroom before consuming it by cross-referencing several field guides, or more preferably, working with someone with experience.

Everybody is different, and everybody's response to different foods is diverse. It is the same for eating edible wild mushrooms. Try each new species cautiously at first. Also, even if you are experience with certain species and wish to consume a vast quantity, it may not be a good idea. Some people have experienced uncomfortable symptoms from over-indulging when eating certain mushrooms in larger quantities.

This is in no way meant to discourage your enjoy and exploration of edible wild mushrooms. There are many wonderful colors, flavors and textures to be experienced among the mushrooms. Not to mention, the process of finding them in the outdoors can be very exciting and rewarding in and of itself.

DNR's Hunt Access Program gets funding

The Michigan Department of Natural Resources will receive \$951,400 to expand its **Hunting Access Program** into the northern Lower Peninsula to increase private-land hunting opportunities. This grant, awarded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Voluntary Public Access and Habitat Incentive Program, also will improve wildlife habitats by enhancing grassland, forest and food plots.

The Voluntary Public Access and Habitat Incentive Program encourages landowners to allow outdoor enthusiasts greater access to their privately owned land for hunting, bird watching, fishing and hiking. According to a 2013 study by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, outdoor recreation supports 6.1 million direct jobs across the country and \$646 billion in spending each year. Deer hunting alone attracts more than 700,000 hunters to Michigan each year and contributes billions of dollars to the state's economy.

Michigan's Hunting Access Program was created in 1977 to increase public hunting opportunities in southern Michigan, where 97 percent of the land base is privately owned. Through HAP, private landowners receive financial incentives for allowing hunters access to their lands. One of the oldest dedicated private-lands, public-access programs in the nation, HAP provides access to quality hunting lands near urban areas.

According to DNR wildlife biologist Mike Parker, "HAP enrollment will be targeted primarily in the agricultural areas in the northeast and western northern Lower Peninsula, where public land is a bit scarce. Grant funds will also be used to restore wildlife habitat on willing HAP properties, to improve opportunities for deer hunters, turkey hunters and small game hunters alike."

Using funds from Michigan's recent license restructuring, this new federal grant and an existing USDA grant, the DNR plans to continue expanding the program in the southern Lower Peninsula, the northern Lower Peninsula and the eastern Upper Peninsula over the next three years.
