Both teams put forth strong defensive effort

Boyne City 13, Charlevoix 0

CHARLEVOIX -- They always say, when rivals meet, throw out the record book.

In this case, both teams came in with 1-0 records for this early season meeting, with both coming in convincing fashion, with offensive outbursts.

This contest however, would be all defense, as neither team could muster a lot of offense against their opponents.

Boyne City would get on the scoreboard with 4:34 remaining in the opening quarter as Tarin Bell scooted his way around the right side and into the endzone for six points. A successful Tanner Kruzel would make it 7-0 Ramblers.

The score would remain that until just before halftime, when the Boyne caught everyone off guard with a trick, halfback option play from Kruzel as he swept left and then when the Rayder defense began to pursuit him, he pulled up and floated a pass over the Charlevoix defensive backs and into the arms of a wide open Luke Sage, and the senior would outrun, would be chasers to the

endzone for a 61-yard score and a 13-0 lead as the extra point attempts was not good.

Both teams made their counterparts work for everything they got as both were even more dominant in the second half, where both offenses were unable to get the ball over the goalline.

Charlevoix would have some success moving the ball through the air in the second half, twice moving to within the 10-yard line in the final 12 minutes of the contest, but unable to punch it in against a strong willed Rambler defense.

'We had no answer for their de-

fensive speed against our young offensive line," Bindi added. I thought we made a few nice plays and had some good blocks, but against great teams like Boyne who play at a different level of speed, we just weren't able to contain all of them on enough plays to sustain a drive and get it in the end zone."

Boyne was able to apply pressure all night on the Rayder quarterbacks and backs, as Kruzel and fellow lineman Carter Wilmot, along with linebackers Sage and Malik Smith spent plenty of time in the Charlevoix backfield. The Ramblers totaled 11 tackles for a loss as a team, with those four racking up 10 of them

Sage finished with a team high 13 stops (four for a loss); while Kruzel recorded nine tackles (one for a loss); Wilmot added six stops (one for a loss); Jacob Ager had six tackles; and Smith chipped in with four tackles for a loss.

Not to be outdone, the Rayder defense which spent a lot of the second half in the Ramblers backfield, hurring plays and putting big hits on the quarterback, as Austin Putman had two sacks and a forced fumble and Brad Klinger and Jared McLean each finished with six tackles.


Offensively for Charlevoix, McLean carried the ball 14 times for 61 yards to lead the rushing game, while Klinger, filling in for injured quarterback Forrest Noirot, had four completions for 70 yards, with Putman and Erik Oshaben the recipients of those throws.

"Our game plan was to not allow them (Boyne) beat us up the middle," Charlevoix coach Ron Bindi said. "On their first score, we had good coverage, just didn't take the right angle.'

"Brad (Klinger) came in and played well, filling in for Forrest (Noirot)," coach Bindi said. "We're comfortable with both guys leading the team, and they both get plenty of reps and know the offense.'

The Ramblers got 79 yards on the ground from Smith on 19 carries, while Bell added 69 yards on 10 attempts.

Boyne City (2-0) travels to Mancelona on September 11, to take on the Ironmen at 7pm, and the Rayders (1-1) visit Coleman on September 12 for a 3:30pm contest.



ORDINANCE #234 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 44 ARTICLE III STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING SECTION 44-47 PARKING LIMITATIONS

THE CITY OF EAST JORDAN ORDAINS:

Section 1: Amendment of Section 44-47 Parking Limitations

- (a) No parking is allowed on any street in the city between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. between the dates of December 1 and April 1.
- (b) No parking is allowed in the city between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. at any time on the following streets:
 - Esterly Street-From Second to Spring (1)
 - Main Street-From Mill to Garfield (2)
 - Mill Street-From Spring to Third (3)
 - Second Street-From Mill to Esterly (4)
 - (5) Spring Street-From Mill to Esterly
- (C) No parking is allowed on any street in the city posted by city commission resolution.
- (d) Limited parking is allowed on any street in the city posted by city commission resolution.
- Any vehicle parking in a parking lot or park-(e) ing space must move their vehicle at least every 48 hours for cleaning and snow removal or a citation will be issued.

Section 2: This amendment will take effect seven (7) days after publication per City Charter.


