Rayders nearly overcome early deficit before falling to Vikings 48-36

Grayling 48, Charlevoix 36

CHARLEVOIX -- The Charlevoix football team found themselves down early, but were able to put together a comeback that saw them take the lead late in the third quarter, before falling to the visiting Vikings, 48-36 on September 18 at Kipke Field.

"We came out flat and ended up spotting them (Grayling) 12 points, due to bad snaps and penalties," Rayder coach Ron Bindi said. "That makes it very tough to dig your way out of a hole like that, but the kids didn't give up."

After finding themselves down early, Charlevoix finally built some momentum early in the second as the team drove the ball downfield 68, due to the running of Jared McLean and Ben Boss. with Boss punching it in from one yard out on a fourth and goal play. Following a successful twopoint conversion, the Rayders were right back in it, trailing 12-

rayling quarterback. Cam Summer would lead a Viking drive that saw him connect with Koedy Dole from 31-yards out and just 21 seconds remaining in the half for an 18-8 lead.

Charlevoix however, running their hurry up offense, got a 41 vard run from Boss before he was forced out of bounds at the Viking 28 with eight seconds remaining in the half, setting up a Forrest Noirot to Brad Klinger 28-

yard touchdown pass on the very next play, and after a successful

conversion attempt, the Rayders were within two points at 18-16 headed into intermission.

'We had a big bright spot just before the half, and went into the locker room riding that emotional high," Bindi noted. "Then to come out of the half and recover their miscue, kept it going, only to give it right back to them on the next play and they go onto

Following the Viking score, Charlevoix would reel off 14 unanswered points as Boss added his second score of the evening on a 3-yard run and after Klinger picked off a Viking pass on their next drive and returned it to the Grayling 13 yard line, Noirot would eventually find paydirt on a 1-yard keeper to put the Rayders on top for the first time in the contest at 30-26.

But the Charlevoix lead would not last long as the Vikings took their next two ensuing possessions and cashed in as Summer crossed the goalline on both a 26yard and 11-yard run to go back on top 40-30.

"We came out flat and ended up spotting them (Grayling) 12 points, due to bad snaps and penalties," Rayder coach Ron Bindi said. "That makes it very tough to dig your way out of a hole like that, but the kids didn't give up."

"We came back and were able to take the lead," Bindi noted. "But we were not able to hold onto it. We are proud of the kids effort."

Boss would then get his third score of the evening on a 76-yard reception from Noirot to cut the lead to four, 40-36 and give the Rayders hope with the fourth quarter winding down, only to watch the Vikings put the game away on another long run by Summer.

"We feel if we can limit our mistakes, we can play with anyone," Bindi added. "We're our own worst enemy at times, we play solid defense and take care of responsibilities, and then a

few plays later, we don't do that." "In the long run, playing teams like this will help us and prepare us going forward," the coach said. "We've just got to stay focused and keep improving."

Noirot finished the night with 154 yard passing and a pair of touchdowns on 9-of-20 passing.

McLean raced for 124 yards on 16 carries, while Boss picked up 88 yards on 13 attempts and two scores, while also hauling in two passes, including a TD for 78 vards.

Klinger caught five passes for 61 yards and a touchdown, while McLean and Hunter Cox also caught passes.

On the defensive side of the ball, Malcolm Williams finished with 13 tackles; Justin Adkins had 10; while Noirot added six; McLean chipped in with five and an interception; and Klinger also added an interception.

Charlevoix begins a stretch of five conference games in the NMFL II on September 25 when they travel to Suttons Bay for a 7pm contest.

Rambler offense comes to life

Malik Smith explodes with four second half scores in 55-28 victory over Kingsley

Boyne City 55, Kingsley 28

BOYNE CITY -- The Boyne City football team took a few early punches from the Kingsley offense only to respond with their own counter attack as the Ramblers and Stags took turns exchanging blows in what turned out to be a physical, high scoring contest, but in the end, it would be Boyne City coming out on top with their fourth victory of the season and 13th consecutive regular season win, 55-28 at Earl Brotherston Field on September 18.

The Stags wasted little time in challenging the Ramblers as Kingsley quarterback Nathan Schaar found an open Tyler Case streaking down the far sideline for a 70-yard completion, setting up a 5-yard touchdown run by Daniel Gelles for a 7-0 lead just 27 seconds into the game.

Boyne City would respond with a 65 yard, six play, drive of their own capped by a 24-yard touchdown pass from sophomore Mason Gardner to junior Tarin Bell, knotting the game at 7-7 with 7:35 re-

maining in the opening quarter.

On the ensuing kickoff, the Stags would find a crease and return the ball deep into Rambler territory, setting up a touchdown run and giving Kingsley a 14-7 advantage.

After a three and out by the Ramblers, Kingsley looked to widen their lead as they moved the ball to within field goal range, but a bad snap that would eventually end up in an incomplete pass, would turn the ball over on downs and putting the Ramblers at their own 14 yard line.

One play later and Gardner would find Kruzel for an 86-yard score down the near sideline, and the game was once again tied, 14-14 with just under two minutes to go in the first.

The score would remain in a deadlock until 6:40 of the second quarter, when Malik Smith rumbled through the Kingsley defense for a 10-yard touchdown run, giving the Ramblers their first lead of the game at 21-14.

Boyne would then force the Stags to punt on their next possession and on the return, Colton Sieradski would find a seam and take it to the house, extending

the Rambler lead to 28-14 with just under five minutes to play in the half.

Following intermission, the Ramblers would be unable to move the chains and forced to punt, where senior Luke Sage, booted the ball just inside the Kingsley 10 yard line, pinning the Stags deep in their own territory.

Two plays later and Schaar would find Case open behind the Boyne defense and race 81-yards to paydirt at 9:36 of the second half.

The Ramblers would respond like they always seem to do, as they got back to their ground game, mixing it up with the flashy speed of Bell and the physical pounding of Smith and Kruzel, with Smith finally able to punch it in from two yards out, making it 35-21 BC.

The Stags would once again respond quickly with a score of their own, bringing them back within seven at 35-28 with 7:02 to go in the third.

That would be the last

time Kingsley would put the ball in the end zone as the Rambler defense stiffened and the offense continued to roll, with Smith adding three more touchdown runs to close out the game and secure a 55-28

victory.
Offensively for the Ramblers, Smith finished with 21 carries for 184 yards and five scores, while Kruzel added 57 yards on the ground and 103 through the air. Bell also chipped in with 50 yards rushing and 44 receiving.

Gardner would finish

with 159 yards on 5-of-8 passing and two touchdowns, while Derek Willis added a 19 yard completion.

On the defensive side, Kruzel had a team high 11 tackles and Carter Wilmot had 10 stops. Bell and Tyler Himebaugh both had second half interceptions.







"I fish because I love to; Because I love the environs where trout are found which are invariably beautiful."

On one of these chilly and drizzly late summer days some anglers might opt to stretch out in a recliner with a good book. And, if you're a trout aficionado there are four "local" reads I would enthusiastically recommend. They were all penned by northern Michigan men and span the spectrum from "how to" guides to poetic passages with artistic aestheticism. Here's a short review of each:

Michigan: A Fly-Anglers Guide by Bob Linsenman (2001 second edition): The earliest book in the bunch was written by Michigan fishing guru Linsenman and colleague Steve Nevala


Trout Streams of

Voelker's Pond: A Robert Traver Legacy by writer James McCullough and photographer Ed Wargin (2003): McCullough, a literature professor at North Central Michigan College, is the only angler I know who had a relationship with the prolific author and skilled fly fisherman, John Voelker (pen name Robert Traver). James and his father had the rare opportunity to visit Voelker at his extremely secretive and beloved property somewhere within the vast region near Marquette. This gave McCullough the "foot in the door" to travel back to the spot long after Voelker-author of the highly acclaimed book that became an Academy Award nominated movie, "Anatomy of a Murder" -

passed away. Voelker called

his favorite brook trout pond on the acreage Frenchman's Pond. Wargin's vibrant and creative photographs complement McCullough's prose perfectly. It's a must have coffee table book. However, they are somewhat tough to find. Amazon has a handful ranging from \$5.00-\$50.00.

Seasons of the Au Sable by Rusty Gates and Bill Sodeman (2007): I have a cherished memory of spending the better part of a warm summer afternoon, just Rusty and me, drinking ice cold beverages and listening to his take on several fishing techniques and controversial conservation topics. We were at a secluded log cabin he leased on a stretch of the Au Sable he affectionately called, "frog water." It was one of those, "sell your soul to go back to that moment" experiences in my blessed life. There is

time president of the influential Anglers of the Au Sable organization-did more for the preservation of his beloved river in his tooshort life than probably any other person. This collection of his weekly fishing reports was brilliantly compiled with considerable heavy lifting by Sodeman. Much like a 20" brown trout they have become a prized possession. 

Real estate ads are usually full of acronyms and terms that are unfamiliar to first-time buyers. Here's a cheat sheet to let you in on the lingo.

4B/2B -- four bedrooms and two bathrooms. "Bedroom" usually means a sleeping area with a window and a closet, but the definition varies in different places. A "full bathroom' is a room with a toilet, a sink and a bathtub. A

"three-quarter bathroom" has a toilet, a sink and a shower. A "half bathroom" or powder room has only a toilet and a sink.

assum. fin. -- assumable financing

closing costs -- the entire package of miscellaneous expenses paid by the buyer and the seller when the real estate deal closes. These costs include the brokerage commission, mortgage-related fees, escrow or attorney's settlement charges, transfer taxes, recording fees, title insurance and so on. Closing costs are generally paid through escrow.

CMA -- comparative market analysis or competitive market analysis. A CMA is a report that shows prices of homes that are comparable to a subject home and that were recently sold, are currently on the market or were on the market, but not sold within the listing pe-

contingency -- a provision of an agreement that keeps the agreement from being fully legally binding until a certain condition is met. One example is a buyer's contractual right to obtain a professional home inspection before purchasing the home.

dk -- deck

expansion pot'l -- expansion potential mean that there's extra space on the lot or the possibility of adding a room or even an upper level, subject to local zoning restrictions.

fab pentrm -- fabulous pentroom, a room on top (but under the roof) that has great views FDR -- formal dining room

fixture -- anything of value that is permanently attached to or a part of real property. (Real estate is legally called "real property," while movables are called "personal property.") Examples of fixtures include installed wall-to-wall carpeting, light fixtures, window coverings, landscaping and so on. Fixtures are a frequent subject of buyer and seller disputes. When in doubt, get it in writing.
