Rayders spoil Red Devils Homecoming

Charlevoix ground game picking up steam

EAST JORDAN -- The Charlevoix Rayders rolled into town, looking to stay unbeaten in conference play and inch closer to a possible playoff berth. On October 9, they accomplished both in defeating the host Red Devils, 31-0 in front of a standing room only homecoming crowd at East Jordans Boswell Stadium.

With the win, the Rayders third straight, Charlevoix improves to 3-0 in the Northern Michigan Football League II, and 5-2 overall on the season.

Things looked promising in the early going for the Red Devils, as they held the ball on an eight play drive to begin the game, taking more than five minutes off the clock, only to turn the ball over on downs at the Charlevoix

The Rayders wasted little time in putting a drive of their own together as they marched 64 yards in five plays, capped by a Ben Boss touchdown run from five vards out and following an unsuccessful conversion attempt, Charlevoix took a 6-0 lead.

With both teams stepping up on the defensive side, neither offense could get anything going until 1:41 remained in the first half, when Charlevoix struck again, this time through the air,

as Rayder quarterback, Forrest Noirot connected with Austin Putman on a 50-yard pass, and after a successful Hunter Cox extra point, the Rayders were up

The Red Devils took over and looked to put some points on the

board before the half, driving down the field in five plays to the Charlevoix 12 before the Rayders picked off a pass intended for Ryan Graham. Charlevoix would run out the clock and head into

the half, leading 13-0. "They (East Jordan) moved the ball on us early in the first quarter and again before the half, but our defense stepped up and kept them out of the end zone,"

Charlevoix coach Ron Bindi said. "I'm liking the way were playing defense right now, we're playing a lot more physical."

Coming out of the break, the Red Devils recovered an onside kick, but were unable to move the chains as Shepard fumbled the ball on the drive and the Rayders recovered at their own 35 yard

Charlevoix would then string together a five play, three minute, ten second drive that covered 65 yard, highlighted by a 32-yard touchdown run by Noirot, making it 19-0 Rayders with 6:41 to go in the third.

Charlevoix would score again with one second left in the quarter as the Noirot to Putman connection would find paydirt on a 16-yard touchdown and a 25-0 Rayder lead.

Malcolm Williams would cap the Charlevoix scoring at the 7:41 mark of the fourth quarter, when he broke free for a 46-yard run.

"The kids played hard," East Jordan coach Allan Peterson said. "Charlevoix is a good football team and very physical, we don't hold up to the pounding very well."

Offensively for the Rayders, Noirot finished 5-of-13 passing for 104 yards and two touchdowns, while also rushing for 47 yards

On the ground, Williams picked up 132 yards on seven carries and a score, while Boss added 97 yards on 14 attempts and a touchdown.

Putman hauled in four passes for 99 yards and a pair of TD's, while Brad Klinger also had a re-

On defense for Charlevoix, Jordan Adkins and Williams both recorded 10 tackles, with Williams adding a fumble recovery. Cam Alden had nine stops, while Justin Adkins added seven

Also for the Rayders, Boss had four tackles and an interception, while Josh Hinkley had a fumble recovery.

For the Red Devils, Shepard was 5-of-8 passing for 57 yards, while Donny Cutler gained 36 yards on 11 carries and also caught four passes for 61 yards; Ryan Graham added 22 yards on 13 attempts. Riley Kibler also rushed for 15 yards.

Cutler led the EJ defense with nine stops, Kibler added eight, and Graham and Jordan Cartwright each finished with six tackles

"We had to play some guys out of position and they responded pretty well," coach Peterson added. "I continue to be very proud of this bunch, because they fight to the end."

The Red Devils (0-3, 2-4) travel to Harbor Springs on October 16 to face the Rams; while the Rayders play host to Frankfort at Kipke Field, both games begin at 7 p.m.

Trent Graham also rushed seven times for 79 yards, while Keegan Mcduffie had 51-yards on 10 carries and a touchdown


Jared Piechann completed three passes for 69 yards including a touchdown to Nick Norton.

Successful early elk hunt season in books

Michigan's early elk season is now over, leaving many happy hunters with full freezers and memories for a lifetime.

"It was perfect! The hunt was above and beyond my expectations, very thorough and very professional," said Dale Grelewicz of Twin Lakes. Grelewicz harvested his once-ina-lifetime bull elk, with his wife Jeanne at his side, on Aug. 26.

The early elk season was made up of three, four-day hunts starting Aug. 25. Fifty state hunters had 12 days to harvest their elk, and 43 of them were successful in doing so. The early elk season is unique because it takes place during the rut, when calling can be effective, increasing the potential for some exciting interactions.

"Throughout the season we have had excellent weather," said DNR wildlife biologist Jennifer Kleitch. "Weather is always a big factor in hunting, and a hunt in late August, for large animals like elk, can sometimes be difficult if the weather is too warm and animals don't move much."

For the early elk season, 35 licenses were issued for antlerless elk and 15 for bulls. Of the 43 elk that were harvested, 28 were antlerless and 15 were bulls.

Over 36,000 Michigan residents applied to hunt elk this year, and 100 were selected via a random, weighted lottery, which began in 2003. This system provides some advantage to hunters who apply consistently year after year, while still offering an opportu-

nity to all applicants.

"I had been applying for over 20 years," said Grelewicz.

Elk hunting in Michigan, which has occurred annually for state residents since 1984, is an effective management tool biologists have used to maintain elk herd numbers, composition and even distribution. The early elk hunt is designed to address crop damage or other private-land concerns by managing elk primarily in agricultural areas.

The December, or late, elk hunt will begin Dec. 5, and 50 more state hunters will have nine days to pursue elk in northern Michigan.

"We are all looking forward to the late elk hunt," said Kleitch. "With the chance of snow on the ground, it's a whole different hunt and experience."

Pheasant hunting growing in Michigan

With pheasant hunting just under way, the Department of Natural Resources reminds hunters that there are a growing number of opportunities to take part in this treasured Michigan tradition.

Pheasant hunting season runs Oct. 10-31 in the Upper Peninsula in Menominee County and portions of Iron, Marquette, Dickinson and Delta counties; Oct. 20-Nov. 14 in the Lower Peninsula; and Dec. 1-Jan. 1 in selected areas of Zone 3 in the southern Lower Peninsula. The bag limit is two male pheasants daily, with four in possession. A base license is required to hunt pheasants.

"A few years ago Outdoor Life magazine rated Michigan's Thumb among the top 10 places in the country to go pheasant hunting, which points to the fact that pheasant hunting is still alive and well in our state," said Al Stewart, DNR upland game bird specialist. "The DNR and our partners are making progress toward creating more quality pheasant hunting opportunities with the Michigan Pheasant Restoration Initiative, a collaborative effort to revitalize Michigan pheasants."

The Michigan Pheasant
Restoration Initiative aims to
create small-game hunting opportunities, increase wildlife
populations, improve hunter satisfaction and help Michigan's
economy. Landowners can get involved – and can get technical
and financial assistance – by
forming cooperatives to create
and enhance pheasant habitat.

"It has been exciting to see what the MPRI coalition of partners has been doing over the last few years to improve pheasant habitat, pheasant numbers and pheasant hunting in southern Michigan," said Bill Vander Zouwen, Pheasants Forever representative and Michigan Pheasant Restoration Initiative Coalition co-chair. "For example, the DNR bought 917 acres and improved thousands of acres on

state game areas, Pheasants Forever provided 75,000 acres of habitat, the U.S. Department of Agriculture farm programs provided nearly 100,000 acres of habitat, and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service helped landowners improve close to 3,000 acres. I am really looking forward to seeing what the next five years will bring."

The best counties for pheasant hunting are in south-central Michigan to mid-Michigan and into the Thumb. There are some localized concentrations of birds elsewhere, based on habitat availability. Stewart advises hunters to look for warm-season grasses, especially idled farm fields. Late-season hunters can have success in cattails and shrub lands adjoining picked agricultural fields.

Hunters may be interested in the recently published 2015 Michigan Ring-Necked Pheasant Status Report. The report, along with more information on pheasant hunting and the Michigan Pheasant Restoration Initiative, can be found at mi.gov/pheasant.

The DNR asks hunters to help monitor pheasants and quail in Michigan by becoming a "hunter cooperator" and filling out a survey form, which provides important information about the status of these game birds. The form should be returned by Oct. 28 for the early season, and by Jan. 5 for the regular season.
