Strong effort not enough to get past **Glads as Ramblers football run ends**

TRAVERSE CITY -- The Boyne City offense ran into a tough Traverse City defense on November 13, as the two teams played outstanding defense the entire contest, but the Gladiators were able to break through on a couple of big plays and that was the difference as Traverse City downed Boyne, 12-0 in the Division VI regional football final at Thirlby Field.

"I thought we played hard and very well at times," Rambler coach David Hills said. "We were unable to capitalize when we got the ball in TCSF territory, but played solid defense all night and moved the ball well offensively in the second half."

The Gladiators scored on two plays that resulted in touchdowns in the first half, the first, an opening drive 45-vard run by Jacob Klinglesmith at the



9:44 mark of the first quarter.

After trading possessions with the Ramblers over a few possessions, St. Francis running back, Joe Trucco punched it in from four yards out. That play was set up by a 53-yard completion from Joe Coates to Michael Hegewald with just under five minutes remaining in the half.

The Ramblers couldn't quite get anything going on offense over the first 24 minutes of play, as they headed into the break down 12-0.

Boyne City received the ball to start the second half and after taking it at the Rambler 27, Boyne put together a strong drive as they moved the ball downfield with a combination of runs by Malik Smith and another from Luke Sage, bringing them to inside the Gladiator nine yard line.

The Ramblers were unable to get in the end zone on four consecutive plays, as a pass on fourth down could not connect, turning the ball over with 2:39 left in the quarter.

After holding TCSF once again, the Ramblers took possession of the ball midway through the fourth quarter and was moving downfield, playing against both a stacked Gladiator box as they attempted to hold Smith in check and the game clock.

The Ramblers were however able to move the ball on a few occasions when faced with fourth down, eventually getting into Gladiator territory, but were picked off and St. Francis was able to run out the clock.

son, with lots to be proud of and we would all like to express our appreciation for the support we get from the community and our student section is the best," coach Hills added.

The Ramblers were led on offense by Smith, who facing a defense geared to slow him down, was able to manage 118 yards on 25 carries, while Tanner Kruzel added 25 yards on eight attempts and Colton Sieradski picked up 18 yards on his only carry.

Smith finished the season with 1,749 yards on 244 carries (7.17 yards per carry) with 23 tds, breaking the mark of 1713 yards, set by Nick Sulak in 2003.

Mason Gardner and Derek Willis each completed one pass, resulting in 27 total yards. Sieradski and Luke Sage had one

reception apiece.

On defense, Sage finished his high school career with 17 tackles, including a sack and three tackles for a loss, while sophomore Jacob Ager added 12 stops, including a sack.

Sieradski added nine tackles and Carter Wilmot finished with eight.

Boyne City finishes the season 10-2 overall and while this ride comes to an end, look for the Ramblers to put in the work necessary during the offseason to return to this point next year.

The Ramblers graduate a number of seniors and key contributors over the course of the last few seasons, including; Smith, Sage, Kruzel, Wilmot, Sieradski, Willis, James Roberson, Autumn Vousboukis, Zak Bearss and Collin Sudderth.



The Chamber of Commerce from this town, located on US-131 between Boyne Falls and Kalkaska, hosts one of the most ambitious and popular big buck contests anywhere in the Mitten State. Celebrating its 61st straight year it's also the longest running buck pole in Michigan!

This year the contest ran from sunrise on November 15 to sunset on November 16. Prizes included First Deer Hung (\$10), Heaviest Deer (\$150), Most Antler Points (\$100), and Widest Rack

(\$75). The \$5.00 registration fee for each deer entered in the contest goes into a pot and one randomly chosen individual wins the Lucky Hunter Drawing of all registration money. The Chamber guarantees the prize will be \$200.00 or more. So, you didn't need to have the largest deer to win a substantial cash prize!

Despite the warm weather, and the Quality Deer Management antler point regulations, Chamber Executive Director, Joanie Moore, said excitedly, "The numbers were impressive and some really nice deer were registered. We had some returning hunters and quite a few new participants!"

As of Monday evening, 33 sixpoint or larger bucks had been registered. Youth Hunter, C.J.

Camp, of Bellaire downed a massive 180 pound, 8-point buck on day two and was in the lead for the heaviest deer and the \$150 prize.

NR reminds hunter to follow ORV rules

With firearm deer hunting season approaching, conservation officers at the Michigan Department of Natural Resources remind hunters heading afield using an off-road vehicle (ORV) to follow ORV land-use regulations.

"Each year, some hunters use ORVs where it is illegal to operate them," said Cpl. John Morey, DNR ORV and snowmobile coordinator. "We remind hunters that ORV restrictions are in place to protect natural resources and minimize user conflict with other hunters and outdoor recreation enthusiasts To ensure everyone's safety and to help everyone have an enjoyable hunt, we ask riders to know the rules.'

Hunters should be aware of the following ORV land-use regulations:

It is illegal to operate an ORV on public lands in the lower peninsula unless they are operating on the DNR designated ORV trail system. Michigan's ORV trail system has three basic types of trails, including: Motorcycle-only trails main-

tained at a 28-inch width 50-inch-wide trails open to

ORVs that are 50-inches wide or less

ORV routes maintained at a width of 72 inches

ORV use on designated trails is limited depending on the type of designated ORV trail and the ORV width. Off-trail or off-route ORV operation outside of a designated trail is prohibited, except for licensed hunters removing deer, bear or elk and operating an ORV at speeds of 5 miles per hour or less and traveling to the harvested game using the shortest possible route. Big game ORV retrieval provisions do not apply to the Pigeon River Country State Forest or to state game areas and national forests.

ORVs are generally prohibited on state game areas or state parks and recreation areas.

In all national forests, motor vehicles can be used only on roads, trails or areas that are designated as open on motor vehicle use maps. For more information, contact the local national forest headquarters.

It is illegal to operate an ORV from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. on any area open to public hunting during the Nov.

15-30 firearm deer season. For exceptions to these time restrictions, see the 2015 Hunting and Trapping Digest, which is also available at mi.gov/dnrdigests, or the Handbook of Michigan Off-Road Vehicle Laws. Images of the ORV confidence markers are found on page 51 of the handbook.

Roads, streets and highways maintained for year-round automobile travel (including the shoulder and the right-of-way) are closed to ORV operation unless designated open to ORV use by local ordinance. ORV operators should check with that county's sheriff, road commission or clerk for local ordinances.

Private land is closed to ORV operation except by the landowner and the landowner's invited guests.

An ORV may not be operated in a manner that creates an erosive condition. Michigan's soils and shorelines are fragile, and ORV operation in these areas and along stream banks and other waterways is prohibited.

It is unlawful to operate any ORV in or on the waters of any stream, river, marsh, bog, wetland or quagmire.

Medicare recently announced the details for the Part D prescription drug plans available for 2016.

Beneficiaries can switch their plans during the Annual Enrollment Period that runs from October 15th through De reach this amount dur-ing the year, Medicare beneficiaries will enter the donut hole which results in a higher cost for their drugs. Those who enter the donut hole in 2016 will pay 45% of the total cost of brand name drugs and 58% of the cost for the generic equivalent.

There will be several changes in plan offerings, premium costs, and benefit details for Medicare Part D drug plans next year. Following are some of the significant highlights of these changes:

There will be a total of 28 drug plans approved by Medicare for Michigan beneficiaries, three less than what is available in 2015.

Three Part D plans are currently under sanction by Medicare. All are offered by United America and include their Enhanced, Essential and Select Part D plans. Current members are permitted to remain in these plans for 2016 if they want, however, the plans are not available for new enrollments until the sanc-tion is lifted.

Several Part D plans have an annual deductible. Medicare has authorized an increase of \$40 to the de-ductible for a new maximum of \$360.

The donut hole will go up by \$350 to \$3,310. When the full cost of medications

One plan available in 2015 will not be offered in 2016. It is the Alliance Medicare Rx Part D Plan.

Also, four drug insurance companies are re-assigning their members from one of their current plan offer-ings to another plan within the same company for 2016. These companies are Cigna, Smart D. Aetna, and Transamerica.

Part D companies are required to notify their subscribers of all of these details in their Annual Notice of Change mailing. Beneficiaries should already have received this information.

While the list of plan offerings is quite extensive, there is a very helpful tool available that can be used to compare an existing drug plan with other plans available for 2016. The tool is called the Medicare Plan Finder. To do your own comparisons, or get help in finding the best plan simply select one of the following options:

If you are comfortable doing your

lowest cost. Enrollment in a new plan can also be done at the same website.

You can call 800-Medicare (800-633-4227) and a trained customer service representative can help by furnishing you with plan options. Have your current medication list available when you make the call.

Also, you can call the Medicare/Medicaid Assistance Program (MMAP) at 800-803-7174, and ask to have a prescription drug worksheet mailed to vou. Once vou complete the form and return it to the MMAP office, a certified Counselor will review drug plan options and furnish you with recommenda-tions for 2016. Counselors can also help you enroll in a new Part D plan if needed.
