Ramblers season ended by Norway in regional semifinal game

ESCANABA -- Fresh off their second straight district title, the Boyne City boys basketball team took on the task of trying to repeat as regional champs.

The Ramblers entered the contest on a roll, having knocked off rival Charlevoix in the district opener, before downing the two district favorites, St. Ignace and East Jordan, in the semi and fi-

That roll however, would come to a sudden stop as the Ramblers could not overcome a poor shooting night from all over the court, and while battling until the final buzzer, Boyne would fall to Norway, 57-47 in the regional semifinal on March 14 at Escanaba High School.

"When we've lost games this vear, it's because we've missed too many free throws and layups, and we struggled to convert those tonight," Boyne coach Nick Redman said. "I thought our effort was great from the start to the very end, but we had too many chances that we just didn't convert

What coach Redman was referring to, was the fact that the Ramblers connected on only 32 percent of their shots from the floor, including only 12 percent from bevond the arch and managed to only convert 54 percent of their free throws.

After Boyne took an early lead, Norway came roaring back with a run of their own and a 10-6 lead. The two teams took turns making shots and with the Knights holding a 15-13 lead, Norway went on a 10-2 run to close out the half.

Norway kept the offensive pressure on following the break and extended their lead to 38-25 headed into the fourth quarter.

The Ramblers would rally however late in the contest, cutting the Norway lead to six, but could not get any closer as the Knights converted at the charity stripe to seal

"It felt like the ball just never bounced our way tonight, and any time we would start to get some momentum, we'd commit a turnover or miss an easy look, coach Redman added. "You have to give credit to Norway, they got the same opportunities we did and they found a way to convert on them better than we did.

"They earned the win tonight." Senior Luke Sage led the Ramblers on the night as he finished with 13 points and six rebounds, while fellow senior Derek Willis added 11 points and three rebounds, and senior Tanner Kruzel chipped in with seven points and 10 boards.

Senior Colton Sieradski had eight points, and sophomore Mason Gardner netted six points and grabbed three rebounds.

"I'm just proud of this team for

"I think this group is defined by what they were able to do this season," Redman said. "After a great run last year, they came back and were able to come together and

win a second straight district title.

"That meant a lot for them and for this program to show that they could stand on their own and continue the success we've had here the last few years. It shows that we've built a culture of success here and we've got players that take pride in being a part of this

team. Coach Redman and the team were also proud to have the sup-

port of the Boyne community. "I thought that was amazing to see tonight, to have this many fans drive four hours to support these kids and watch us play," Redman said. "They've done that all year long, and not just the players and coaches but the school, the community and the fans have a hand in what we've been able to do as






