The Ramblers finished their downstate trip 2-2 for the second consecutive weekend, but this time they brought home the first place trophy at East Jackson.

On Friday, Boyne City dropped two tough games to Class B power Tecumseh.

In the first game on April 23, Rambler senior Derek Willis tossed a no-hitter in Boyne's 2-1 victory over Bath. Willis finished with eight strikeouts, four walks and hit one batter in seven innings of work.

The Ramblers got on the scoreboard early, taking a 1-0 lead in the first inning as Willis singled and scored on a Tanner Kruzel triple to left center.

In the fourth, Willis lost a bit of his control, walking three and hitting a batter to allow Bath to tie the game at 1-1. Following his rough inning, Derek retired the last thirteen in a row to send the Ramblers to the finals.

The score remained the same until the sixth inning, when with two outs, Kruzel singled, stole second, and flew home on a Dom Archey RBI single up the middle.

In the championship game against Whitmore Lake (a repeat match-up from last season), Boyne City jumped all over the Trojans pitching and built a comfortable 8-0 lead after five and a half innings of play.

After Kruzel had reached his pitch count limit, a very tired Rambler bullpen gave up seven runs aided by a couple of costly errors, to pull the Trojans to within one run after five complete

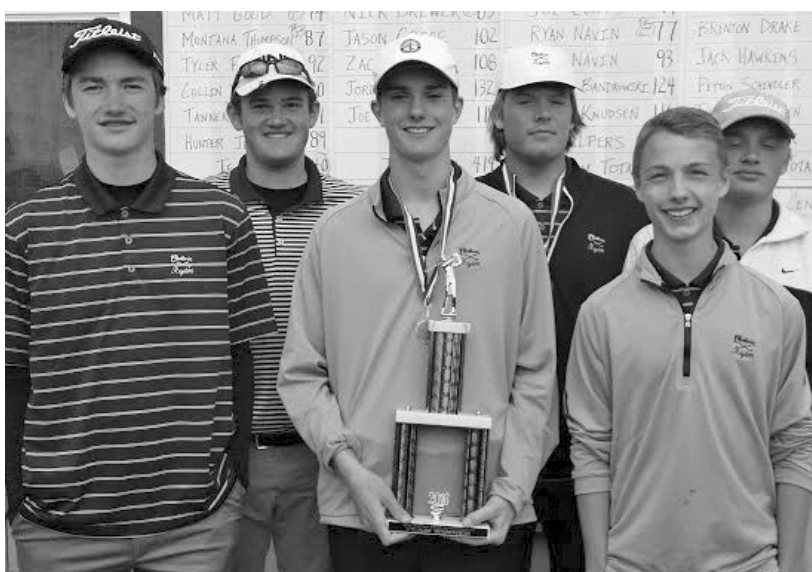

Fishing

Fishing seasons kick off this Saturday, April 30



Many anglers are anxious to head out this weekend for several Michigan fishing seasons that open Saturday, April 30. (COURTESY OF DNR)

The Michigan Department of Natural Resources would like to remind anglers to dust off their fishing gear and get ready for the opening of two fishing seasons Saturday, April 30. The statewide trout season and the Lower Peninsula inland walleye, northern pike and muskellunge seasons all open that day.

In Upper Peninsula waters, the walleye, northern pike and muskellunge seasons open Sunday, May 15.

Don't forget the catch-and-immediate-release season for largemouth and smallmouth bass is open all year on nearly all waters (unless otherwise closed to fishing - check the Michigan Fishing Guide for specifics). The possession season for bass opens statewide Saturday, May 28, except for Lake St. Clair, the St. Clair River and the Detroit River, which open Saturday, June 18.

Fishing is a major economic driver in many parts of the state.

In Michigan, anglers typically spend 28 million days on the water and generate \$4.4 billion in economic activity, which produces \$623 million in local, state and federal tax revenue. On top of that, sportfishing in Michigan is estimated to support nearly 38,000 jobs.

The new license season began April 1, so anglers need to be sure they have purchased a new fishing license for this fishing season. The 2016 fishing licenses are valid through March 31, 2017.

The 2016-2017 Michigan Fishing Guide and Inland Trout & Salmon Maps are available online; visit the DNR website at michigan.gov/fishingguide for the most up-to-date information. Don't forget this year's guide covers two years of regulations (this season plus next season) so anglers should be sure to keep their printed copies through March 31, 2018.

Matelski to play basketball at NMU

BOYNE FALLS -- It was a long time coming, but as in most cases, it was definitely worth the wait as Boyne Falls All-Stater, Marcus Matelski found his new home beginning in the fall at Northern Michigan University in Marquette.

When it came to talks with Northern, Matelski noted that "Coming from a small school and going to a Division II like Northern, a lot of kids don't get that opportunity."

"It came up a little later in the recruiting process, and we both were on board."

While he will move to a location a little larger than his hometown, Matelski will be sure to remember the tight knit area in which he comes from and what he will

most remember.

"The family-like atmosphere, the (Boyne Falls) community is always behind you in everything we do," he said.

Matelski finished his Logger career with 2421 points, ranking ninth all-time in the State of Michigan. His grand total which includes his 8th grade year on the varsity is 2626.

He also had 340 career steals, placing him fifth all-time, and his 146 steals this season is a state record. Twice he had 13 steals in a game, (12-17-15 against Mackinaw City and on 1-7-16 against Alba), a total that is the second highest in state history.

Other records at the state level: 830 career rebounds (24th all-time); 425 made free throws (14th

all-time); and an 80.6 career free throw percentage (12th all-time).

Some of his additional school records: High school team record of 97-12; scored 50 points in a game on February, 1, 2016 against TC Christian; 260 career assists.
