



Northern Michigan Outdoors

Matching the Hatch—Beyond the Bugs:

by Patrick W. C. Bevier Fly anglers know that their ability to, "match the hatch" - that is to precisely imitate the insects that the trout are feeding on - will make or break their fishing success. Riverine trout can be extremely picky eaters when it comes to the exact kind, size, color, and life stage of the insect prey that makes up what research tells us is often 80% of their diet. With dozens of different mayfly, caddis fly, and stonefly insect hatches on a given river each year myriad fly patterns have been created to give the angler the best chance of matching the in-

But other food items are very important to Michigan's three, year-round, river-dwelling salmonids-brown trout, brook trout, and rainbow trout. These include various minnows, crayfish, and large insect larvae that dwell in the riffles and runs of many Michigan streams. These prey items provide larger chunks of energy for the fish as opposed to the more numerous but smaller insect larvae and adults. An exception would certainly be when Michigan's largest mayflies-known as Hex or fish fliesemerge by the millions in mid to late June in the Mitten State.



a dobsonfly larvae or hellgrammite, and the adult stage of the dobsonfly.

Knowing the importance of these small fish and macro invertebrates, fly anglers have for eons been crafting creative patterns out of fur, feathers, and other materials. Examples are streamers including traditional patterns like the Mickey Finn, Black Nose Dace, and Woolly Bugger. Many colorful and modern streamers have been created for bigger, deeper waters like the Trophy Water of the Au Sable below Mio. Patterns imitating crayfish and hellgrammites, the huge, black, leggy, and heavy-jawed larvae of the dobsonfly-have also been

tied by anglers hoping to cash in on these popular trout entrees. Having these imitations in your fly box will pay dividends during those times when the fish are not actively rising for bugs or in are holed-up in deeper pools only larger flies can get down to. Whether you choose a streamer made to imitate a minnow, hell-grammite, crayfish, or large stonefly larvae you are likely to catch other fish species-including river dwelling smallmouth bass and walleye-in Michigan's bountiful lakes and streams!


