Boyne City's Hoth is repeat Player of the Year, **Coach of the Year is Ellsworth's Montgomery**

CHARLEVOIX COUNTY --With summer now into full swing and the 2016 softball season recently coming to an end, it is time to recognize the area teams and their athletes for all the hard work that they put in and the results they produced.

Boyne City finished their season as regional runnersup after claiming their fourth straight Division 3 district championship. The Ramblers also won the Lake Michigan

record. East Jordan and Charlevoix showed much improvement as the season progressed and look to challenge the Ramblers in both the LMC and district title hunts.

Ellsworth earned the Northern Lakes Conference title and Boyne Falls showed that on any given night, they could hang with any other team in the NLC, both teams will return a solid cast.

With that being said, there was once again a number of area athletes that contributed to the success of their respective team. This year's All-Area Softball "Dream Team" is comprised of both precision and power pitchers, infielders with vacuum like gloves, speedy outfielders and catchers armed with cannons.

Having an abundance of talent in the area to select from, it is often difficult to choose one individual, but after crunching all the numbers and weighing the value to their team, the 2016 Charlevoix County News is proud to announce that the honor of Player of the Year goes to Boyne City senior catcher, Hannah Hoth.

Hannah was also a first

Conference crown with a 13-1 team All-State selection for the second straight season, she was also recognized as a first team Lake Michigan Conference All-Conference selection as well as receiving All-District and All-Region honors and Academic All-State.

When asked to reflect on the season and her career as a Rambler, Hannah had this to say, "As a team, we're most proud of winning districts FOUR years in a row. Also, winning our home tournament (Boyne Invitational) and making it into the record books (MHSAA) for multiple things, including 31 home runs as a team."

"As an individual, I'm proud of my senior year as a whole. I've had my personal best batting average and home runs," Hoth said. "I'm also proud of (teammate) Emma Shumaker and I winning our district four year in a row. We are the only two to have ever done it in Boyne City's history!"

Hoth paced the Ramblers with a .600 batting average, connecting for 60 hits on the season. Of those 60 hits, 14 were doubles, five triples and she blasted 12 home runs and finished the season with a


team-high 66 RBIs while also scoring 51 runs.

She had a contact percentage of .930 and her slugging percentage was off the chart with a 1.170 average, Hannah also worked opposing pitchers for 20 walks, and had two. sacrifice flies.

On the defensive side. much like the last four seasons, opponents were very aware of her quick snap and precision accuracy. She finished the season with a .917 fielding percentage, spending most of her time behind the plate. When not set up as the Rambler backstop, Hannah would control the middle infield from the shortstop position and if it was a playable ball, she would get to it and fire a laser across the diamond to get the runner at first.

When asked what keeps her motivated to play at a high level, she had this to say, "As a team, we got along well and helped each other out when we weren't having our best day and all just had a lot of fun together."

"As an individual, just knowing that there are younger kids watching me makes me want to do better and knowing that I will be

playing at the collegiate level and overseas," she said. "I also had to push myself so that my younger sister (Katie) wouldn't beat me in home runs!"

Next season, Hannah will be playing softball at Lansing Community College, but before that, she will be part of the USA, American **International Sports U19** Team that will play overseas in July.

"I would like to thank everyone who came out to support me along with my family!" Hannah added. Joining Hannah on the 2016 All-Area Softball

BOYNE CITY

Emma Shumaker, senior, #13

The Rambler pitching ace was recently recognized as an Honorable Mention All-State selection as well as first team LMC All-Conference, All-District All-Region and Academic All-State.

Emma tossed a majority of the innings for the Ramblers from inside the circle, finishing with a 20-7 record.

She faced 603 hitters, striking out 160, an average of about six per contest and fielded her position with a .947 average.

At the plate, Shumaker resumed her duties as the leadoff hitter for Boyne, turning in a .393 batting average, pounding out 42 hits on the season.

Of those 42 hits, she had nine doubles, two triples and four home runs. Emma also scored 46 runs and had 21 RBIs from the top of the lineup.

She had a slugging percentage of .626 and her contact percentage was .841, Emma also walked 23 times and had a sacrifice fly.

Emma Vondra, junior #14

Vondra has anchored the right side of the infield at first base since the beginning of her freshman season. With a .985 fielding percentage for her position, she no doubt plays it well defensively and her strong arm keeps baserunners thinking of advancing home on a sacrifice attempt closer to the base in which they came from.

Emma moved up in the lineup this season and it turned out to be a good move for both her and the Ramblers as she finished the season with a batting average of .453, a slugging percentage of .634, while making contact at a .800 clip.

Vondra tallied 43 hits on the season, with 11 doubles, three triples and five round trippers. She also had 48 RBI's and scored 57 times for Boyne. She showed great discipline at the plate by walking 30 times, helping set the table for the rest of the Rambler lineup. Emma earned All-State Honorable Mention, as well as LMC All-Conference, All-District and All-Region.

Katie Hoth, sophomore, **#9**

Katie made the transition to centerfield this season and the move paid off well for the Ramblers. She could cover the ground from left center to right center better than anyone in the area with her blazing speed and ability to judge a fly ball. There were not many balls hit that she was unable to get a glove on, as she finished the season with a .962 fielding average.

She was recently recognized as an All-Lake Michigan Conference selection, as well as All-District and All-Region.

Her speed transferred over to the offensive side as she hit for a .458 average from the five spot, had a slugging percentage of .875 and made contact .760 percent of the time and was second on the team with 65 RBI's

She led the Ramblers with 26 stolen bases, but her all-around game didn't just rely on speed as she finished with 44 hits, including five doubles, four triples and nine home runs, while also scoring 37 runs.

There was not a hitter in Northern Michigan hotter in the month of May than Katie. She also hit home runs against all but one Lake Michigan Conference team, including three Grand Slams!

Kelsey Hubbard, sophomore, #2

Kelsey filled in at shortstop for a majority of the season, when not manning the middle infield, she would take a turn behind the plate, finishing the season with a fielding percentage of .893.

Offensively, Hubbard's total hits were 47, with 12 doubles,



one triple and one home run. She led the Ramblers with 61 runs scored and was a magnet for the ball, netting a team-high 15 hit-bypitch.

Her average was .465, with a slugging percentage of .634 and contact percentage of .851. She also knocked in 22 runs.

Kelsey was recently named Honorable Mention in the LMC, as well as All-District and All-Region.

BOYNE FALLS

Kurstin Wilson, senior, #3

Wilson has been the Loggers backstop ever since her freshman season, keeping Northern Lakes Conference runners in check when they attempted to try and take a free base.

Kurstin finished the season with a .509 batting average and a slugging percentage of .587. She had 27 hits on the season, including eight doubles and four triples.

She scored 35 runs, walked 10 times and had 20 RBI's.

Kurstin was a first team All-Conference selection and will be trying out for the Grand Valley State softball team in college.

"Kurstin will be missed next season," Logger coach Rick Matelski said. "Her leadership and what she brought to the ballpark

every night will be hard to replace."

Alicia Gasco, senior, #9

Alicia also helped lead the young Loggers. Playing both a field position as well as spending time in the circle.

While pitching, she earned a 4-5 record, tossing $48 \square$ innings of ball, striking out 35 and walking 72.

At the plate, Gasco hit .367, with a slugging percentage of .530. She finished the season with 18 hits, including four doubles, two triples and a home run.

She also scored 27 runs, while walking 17 times and added 15 RBI's.

Alicia was selected second team All-NLC and will tryout for the Central Michigan University softball team in college.

"Alicia did a fine job this season for us both offensively, defensively and in the circle," coach Matelski noted. "She upped her game this season and it showed on the field."

CHARLEVOIX

Skylar Herriman, senior, #16 Herriman once again took to the circle for the Rayders this season, and it was very noticeable that she put in a lot of time and hard work over the winter and early spring.

Skylar worked 154 innings during 32 games, 27 of which she started.

Abby Nachazel

She allowed 221 hits against the 943 batters she faced, giving up 295 runs (159 earned) while striking out 140 and walking 108, finishing with an ERA of 6.19.

She also fielded her position well, with a .983 average, only making one error, while collecting 14 putouts and 44 assists.

At the dish, Herriman carried a big stick, hitting .547 on the season, 31 hits in 86 at-bats, including 10 doubles, one triple, five home runs and 45 RBI's. Her slugging percentage was .824.

Skylar will play softball for Delta Community College next season and was a first team All-LMC selection and All-District.

"Skylar is the glue that held the team together for the last three years," coach Tom Mielke said. "She has sacrificed personal achievement and recognition to fill a needed role on the team."

Hannah Solomon, freshman, #33

Solomon stepped into the leadoff role for the Rayders before the first practice ended, utilizing her ability to connect with the ball and her "Flash" like speed.

Hannah would record 66 hits in 101 trips to the plate, including four doubles, one triple and a home run, for an average of .653 and slugging

percentage of .743.

Ellsworth

She stole 47 bases and walked 16 times, finished with 20 RBI's and scored 55 runs.

Defensively, Solomon played a majority of her games at shortstop, where she had a fielding percentage of .789, with 29 putouts and 31 assists.

Hannah was a Lake Michigan Conference Honorable Mention and All-District selection.

"She's one of the toughest outs in the league," coach Tom Mielke said. "And may be the best leadoff hitter in Northern Michigan."

McKenna Ebert, junior, #15

McKenna played left field for the Rayders and played the position nearly flawlessly, finishing the season with a fielding percentage of .938.

Ebert recorded 39 hits in 84 atbats, including four doubles and a triple. She also knocked in 19 runs.

She walked 11 times and scored 28 times.

"McKenna had a 22 game hitting streak for us, hitting from our number three spot in the order," coach Mielke said.

Ebert was an All-District selection.



For the second straight season, Ellsworth coach Andy Montgomery has been selected as the Charlevoix County News Coach of the Year.

After enjoying a 19-15 season last year for the Lancers, Montgomery helped lead Ellsworth to a 21-12 record this season and capturing the Northern Lakes Conference title in the process, going 10-0.

"I am truly honored to be all area coach of the year for two consecutive years. Thank you!" he said. "Fact is, it could not be possible without the support I receive from the assistant coaches. They work so hard and volunteer their time to a great cause, softball."

Coach Montgomery noted that the Lancer staff works very hard to teach the girls the game, stressing that good things happen.

"We do have a very young team with only one graduating senior, and we only have one senior next year as well," he added.

"The girls just turned the light switch on and ran with it," he said. "We won our conference this year (10-0) and we also took second place in a tournament at Traverse City Christian.'

Karlee Dunson, junior, #12 Karlee returned to her shortstop position for the Red Devils this season, playing 143 innings there. She recorded 27 putouts and had 49 assists and had a fielding percentage of .738.

Dunson had 27 hits in 71 at-bats for an average of .380. She seven doubles and two triples and finished with 22 RBI's.

Her slugging percentage was .535, with an on-base percentage of .519 and contact percentage of .915. She recorded eight stolen bases and scored 27 runs for EJ.

"Karlee is a team leader who always tries her best and leads by example," coach Meg Kitson said.

Marissa Kolp, junior, #4 Kolp set the table for the Red Devils as the leadoff hitter,

Marissa finished the season with a .346 batting average, collecting 27 hits in 78 plate appearances, including six doubles and five triples. She also added eight RBI's and scored 28 runs.

Her slugging percentage was .551 and her OBP was .500, she also walked seven times.

Defensively, she played 141 innings in centerfield, recording 29 putouts and adding four assists for a fielding percentage of .786.

Chelsea Gibson, sophomore, #3 Gibson was a solid backstop for the Red Devils behind the plate, she let other teams know early and often

that it was not a good idea to run on her, as she threw out 18 runners attempting to take another base.

Charlevoix

Chelsea finished the season with a .944 fielding percentage, recording 31 putouts and 20 assists.

She was the number two hitter for EJ this season, advancing runners when her number was called, including two sacrifice bunts and a sac fly. She hit .190 on the season, including one triple and tallying five RBI's. Gibson also scored 23 runs for the Red Devils.

"Defensively, she (Chelsea) has mad skills as a catcher," coach Kitson noted. "She has a rocket for an arm."

The foot contains 26 bones, 33 joints, 107 ligaments and 19 muscles, which is 1/4 of all bones in the human body. Your feet mirror your general health. Conditions such as arthritis, diabetes, nerve and circulatory disorders can show up initially in the feet. Good foot care should be a priority for everyone.

Years of neglecting the feet and wearing poor footwear, can put you at risk for falls. As part of your overall fall prevention plan, take a good look at your shoes. High heels, floppy slippers, worn out shoes or shoes with

When purchasing new shoes have your feet measured each time, your size will change many times over a lifetime. Buy the very best shoe you can afford. You truly get what you pay for when it comes to footwear. Avoid footwear with extra thick soles and soft structure. Choose lace up or shoes that have fasteners and keep them tied. The best time to buy footwear is in the afternoon as feet and legs tend to swell. If you have one foot that is a different size, always fit to the larger one.

More Medicare Counselors Available

The Region 10 Office of the Medicare/Medicaid Assistance Program, MMAP, has recently added another 12 counselors in their 10 county service area.

Jim Verville, MMAP Regional Coordinator, announced that his Traverse City office recently provided a three day intensive training for new team members. "We continue to add more counselors to the program each year", said Verville. "We now have 52 individuals who are available to provide consultation to residents in Antrim, Benzie, Charlevoix, Emmet, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, Leelanau, Manistee, Missaukee and Wexford counties."

MMAP is part of the national State Health Insurance Program sponsored by Medicare. Free services are provided to folks in all areas of Medicare health insurance including help in se-lecting drug and health plans and supplemental policies. MMAP counselors can also

screen Medicare beneficiaries for eligibility in Medicaid, Extra Help, and other low income assistance programs and even assist with the application for these benefits. Another service involves help with the identification of possible Medicare and Medicaid fraud and abuse.

"We are very excited about the new members of our team," said Verville. "There are over 170,000 Medicare beneficiaries located throughout our 10 county region, and we are only able to reach about 4% of them". "We need to conduct more outreach to create a better awareness of our services and also ensure that we have additional counselors available to help more people".

During the 53 day Medicare Annual Enrollment Period last year, MMAP counselors in Region 10 saved their clients \$1.4 million by helping them find a better Part D prescription drug plan. Verville

said, "The cost-benefit of the program is absolutely fantastic".

About half of the MMAP counselors are volunteers and the remaining half are individuals who are currently working for an organization that permits them to provide these services as a part of their duties. Many of these individuals work for the County Commissions and Coun-cils on Aging, home health care organizations, tribal governments, medical facilities, and even managers of senior apartments. "Our team is growing, but our challenge is to help even more beneficiaries", said Verville.

Assistance is available by calling the toll free MMAP phone number at 800-803-7174, and leaving a message. A local counselor will return the call.


