## Rayders blank Red Devils on Homecoming

Defensive intensity keys victory

**Charlevoix 27, East Jordan 0**

CHARLEVOIX -- It was a long time coming, but the Rayders played their first home game of the season on Friday, September 30, it also happened to be their Homecoming.

For those unable to attend Charlevoix's first four away contests (they also had a home game forfeit victory), the home crowd was treated to a stellar showing by Rayders as they shutout rival East Jordan, 27-0.

While the Rayder offense put up the necessary numbers to win, it was the defense that shined, holding the high-powered Red Devil offense without a score after Charlevoix was unable to slow down Glen Lake a week prior.

The front line of Charlevoix, which features Ray Cunningham, Caleb Hart, Malcom Williams and Joe McCraney kept pressure on East Jordan all night as they combined for 14 tackles, including seven for a loss as they spent a majority of the time in the Red Devils backfield.

"The kids played fired up, I think playing at home for the first time this season and all the excitement surrounding it, had a lot to do with that," Charlevoix coach Ron Bindi said. "Caleb (Hart) and Ray (Cunningham) led the defensive line and an all-around team effort as the defense played well all over."

Defensively, the Rayders forced three turnovers, including interceptions by Colin Smith and Jared McLean. Oliver DeYoung added

four tackles.

Charlevoix was led offensively by Brad Klinger, who finished 11-of-17 for 139 yards and three touchdowns of 35, 22 and 5 yards, while also rushed for 85 yards on 15 attempts.

Smith caught three passes for 46 yards and a pair of scores, while Cam Alden had four receptions for 56 yards, including a 35 yard score. Williams had two catches for 25 yards and McLean one reception.

On the ground, Williams finished with 48 yards on nine carries and a TD, while McLean rushed eight times for 58 yards and Alden 15 yards on three attempts.

"After not playing with very much intensity the last few weeks (ever since the Boyne City game), we got that back. The kids bought in, worked hard in practice and stepped up to the challenge," Bindi noted. "We left a lot of points on the field, we had some good field position, but made some mistakes that took those opportunities away from us."

Despite the inability to get things going offensively against the Rayders, East Jordan looked strong on the defense, forcing four turnovers, including three picks and a fumble recovery.

Keegan McDuffie led EJ with 12 tackles, while Ryan Graham and Trey Peterson each added 11 stops.

Jake Skrocki, Graham and Ryan LaVanway had the interceptions for East Jordan.

With the win, the Rayders improve to 5-1 overall, and are 2-1 NMFL - Legends division; as they close in on returning to postseason play and will play at Onokama on Friday, October 7.

The Red Devils slip to 4-2 overall, and can still make the playoffs with two more victories as they travel to Harbor Springs on Friday, October 7.

### Rayders finish strong to take Ramblers in four sets

BOYNE CITY -- The Charlevoix volleyball team took three of four games against the host Ramblers on September 29, to come away with a road victory. The last time the two teams met, Charlevoix took a 2-0 game lead over the Ramblers, but Boyne came

back with three straight to steal the victory. This night, it was similar through the first three sets, but the Rayders didn't let history repeat, finishing the fourth set in strong fashion. Charlevoix took the matches; 25-16, 25-18, 22-25 and 25-18.

Kenzy O'Leary finished with 12 kills and 21 digs to pace the Rayders; while Becca Moon had 19 assists; Julia Doskoch 13 digs and six aces. Also for Charlevoix, Elise Stuck added 10 kills and 10 digs. Boyne City was led by Abby

Gardner with seven kills, Annabelle Seelye added three assists. Coach Mallory Slate noted that Tyla Cotes had a great performance serving 100 percent, adding two kills and had a great defensive performance. Kelsi Churchill and Emma Von-

dra also served perfect for the Ramblers. Charlevoix improves to 12-13-3 with the win, while Boyne drops to 7-4.

# Boyne bounces Blazers from unbeaten ranks

### Boyne City 21, Kalkaska 14

BOYNE CITY -- Over the past few seasons, the Boyne City football team was known for their ability to strike quick on offense, and hold strong on defense.

After starting the season a little slower than they would have liked, the Ramblers have reeled off four straight victories, making a statement against the previously unbeaten Kalkaska Blazers with a 21-14 win, as the defense held their own for most of the first half and all of the second, including picking off three passes in the final nine minutes of regulation to cap the Ramblers Homecoming celebration.

Boyne City took the opening kickoff and on their first drive, advanced the ball to the one yard line, before junior running back, Joseph Baugh punched it in at the 7:39 mark, a successful extra point by Bence Budi would make it 7-0 Ramblers.

It didn't take the Blazers long to pull even, as quarterback Hunter Suydam found a streaking Tyler Chavalia down the far sideline for a 66-yard touchdown with 6:41 left in the opening quarter.

Following the kickoff, the Ramblers began their next possession at their own 40-yard line and five plays later, senior Tarin Bell would

take a handoff, sprint his way around the end, picking up a few key blocks in the process and it was off to the races, scoring on a 56-yard run and a 14-7 Boyne lead with just over a minute and a half to go in the first quarter.

Both teams then stepped up their defense, until the Ramblers Baugh found a seam along the right side and turned on the afterburners, torching the Blazers for a 50 yard TD with just over five minutes to play in the half and a 21-7 Rambler cushion.

The Blazers took the following kickoff, marched downfield and pulled within a score (21-14) as Suydam found Jake Kies from six yards out with 1:39 remaining in the second quarter.

"I thought our execution in the first half was really very good, defensively they were showing us some things other than what we practiced, they were over playing the run, but we were still able to pop a couple," Rambler coach David Hills said. "The way that their (Kalkaska) offense could score, we really wanted to keep the clock running as much as we could."

Once the second half began, the two teams continued to move the ball, but miscues would stop their drives short as the Kalkaska recovered three Rambler fumbles and

the Ramblers would pick off three Blazer passes, each of them important, but the final one by Mason Gardner with 21 seconds remaining in the fourth.

Gardner would pick off two passes in the final five minutes and 20 seconds, including one that ricocheted about 15 yards off teammate Logan Sulak's helmet and into his arms. Eric Carson also picked off a pass earlier in the quarter.

Also on defense, Jacob Ager recorded 13 tackles, including two for a loss and a pair of fourth down stops. Spencer Joles and Tyler

Himebaugh each added eight tackles apiece and Ryan Hautz added seven.

"Defensively, I thought our kids played really solid, that's a good football team with a lot of speed and multiple kids that can hurt you," Hills added. "We played smart disciplined football, keeping them inside and we knew we had to do that."

Offensively, Baugh rumbled 172 yards on 29 carries and two scores, while Bell added 70 yards and a touchdown on 10 carries, while Gardner, Ethan Hewitt and Logan

Sulak combined for an additional 17 yards on the ground.

Gardner finished with one completion a nine yard toss to Bell on a relatively breezy evening at Earl Brotherston Field.

With the victory, the Ramblers have won four straight and will improve to 5-2 overall (4-2 Northern Michigan Football League - Legends division) after their forfeit win over Benzie Central becomes official. Boyne returns to action on October 14, when they host Elk Rapids.

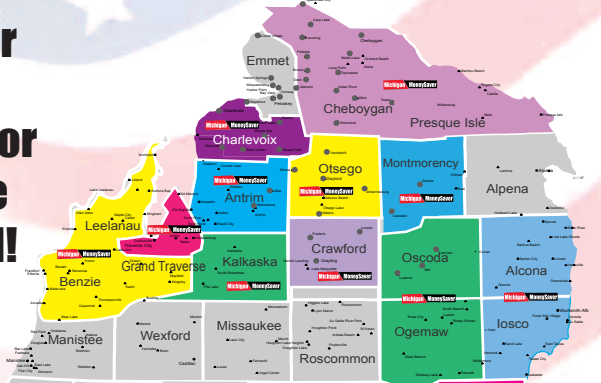


