Running at the state's biggest stage, the Ellsworth cross country team showed it has what it takes to compete at any level. Both the boys and the girls' teams qualified for the division four state finals at Brooklyn's Michigan International Speedway, where the boys placed 21st overall and the girls came in 19th Saturday.

"It was an absolutely incredible experience to go down there as a whole team and to have to opportu-

nity to show Michigan what our small school has to offer," head coach Ruben Oviedo said. "There was an overwhelming feeling of success and excitement for the program."

The boys ran the first race of the morning and were led by Isaiah Romeyn in a time of 17:37 in a 59th place finish, Lucas Sweet ran an 18:14 and was 108th, Daniel Oviedo was 118th in a time of 18:23, Richard Adams was 152nd at 18:56, running a time of 19:24 was Caleb Goodwin who came in 182nd, Rob Wise was 188th and Cole Essenberg

was 189th with times of 19:28 and 19:30.

"Some highlights were Isaiah running a personal record on a tough course and having all of our guys run under 19:30," Oviedo said.

In the girls race, Christy Figueroa ran a time of 21:09 and placed 54th, Alleah Sundelius was 124th at 22:30, Addie Nagel ran a 22:50 and was 140th, Lani Sundelius was 177th in a time of 23:40, Sarah Sitzema ran a time of 23:54 and placed 180th, in 193rd was Marie Groenik in a time of 24:26 and Sophie Sommer was 213th at 25:37.

"Highlights were our girls really push each other by competing with one another and all placing with in the top percentile," Oviedo said. "Also, having this chance to really race our hardest and say that we made it by working together as a team."

The Lancers, who also swept both sides of the Northern Lakes Conference championships, should be in good shape next season as well, as of their state finals teams all of the boys return and just two girls graduate.

"We're really looking forward to

seeing what we can do in the next few years because of the success we had this year and last year," Oviedo said. "We have no doubt that next season will be great, we will accomplish more by using our hard work and dedication towards our team. Even though we will miss our senior girls we will continue to work towards our goals for them and be able to dedicate our accomplishments to them."
