KALKASKA — After a steal at half-court by Boyne City's Max Vondra with just over three seconds to play, the Ramblers were able to move the ball

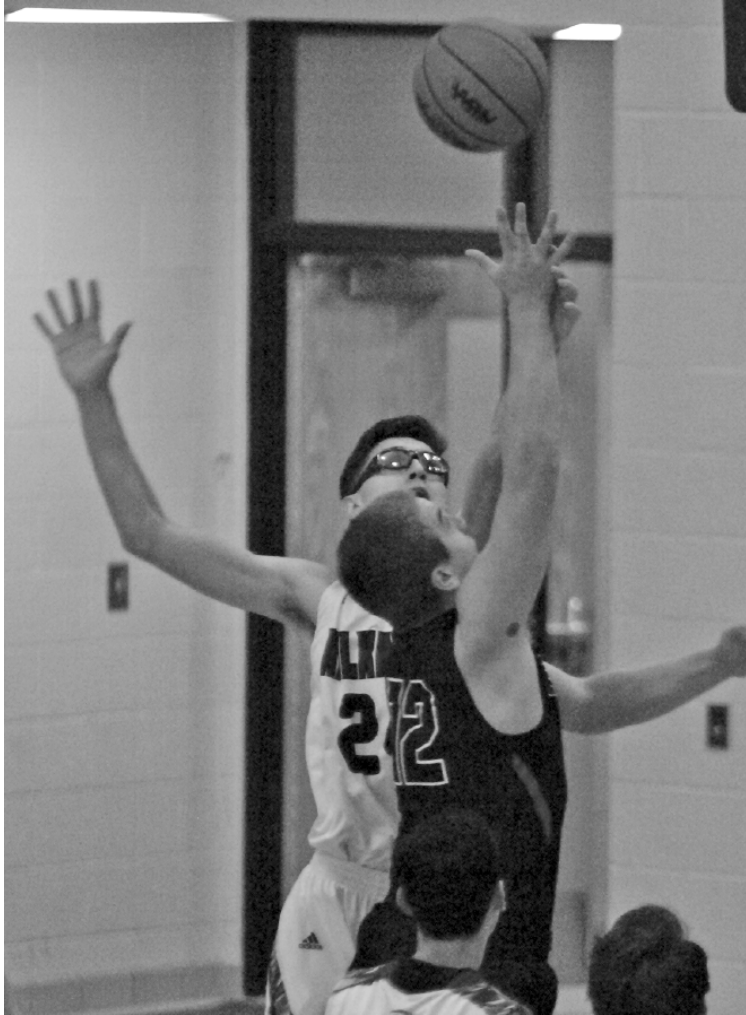
quickly for a 15 foot shot attempt by junior Trevor King as time expired, but the shot rimmed off, and the host Blazers earned a 54-52 Lake Michigan Conference win on January 5. Kalkaska led at the quar-

ter breaks, 15-13, 31-23 and 42-37 headed into the final eight minutes of regulation. "We can't give a good team like Kalkaska that many extra possessions off rebounds and turnovers,"

Boyne coach Nick Redman said. "On a positive note, we still had a chance to win on the road against a good team, we will learn a lot from games like that." The Ramblers slipped to 4-2 overall, 1-1 in the LMC.

Junior Dillion Sulak and sophomore Max Vondra finished with 11 points apiece, while seniors Eric Carson added 10 and Mason Gardner chipped in with nine. Vondra also had seven re-

bounds and Carson dished out two assists. Boyne returns to action on January 12 when they host neighboring Charlevoix.

Red Devils closing in on consistency

Grayling 65, East Jordan 42

EAST JORDAN — The East Jordan boys basketball team continues to progress, showing more signs of consistency, each time they take the floor and gain more experience. On January 5, the Red Devils welcomed the Vikings from Grayling and through the first four minutes of the opening quarter, the contest was a stalemate, with the score knotted at 9-9, but a change in pace from the visitors would put Grayling up 21-9 at the end of the quarter. "Their tempo and pressure got to us a little bit," Red Devils coach Nate Dzwik noted about the end of the first quarter. "Forced us into a couple of turnovers and a couple of quick shots which lead to transition points for them." The two teams battled to a 9-9 second quarter, ending the first half with the Vikings ahead 30-18. Grayling would outscore East Jordan 35-24 in the second half to come away with the Lake Michigan Conference victory. Although EJ would not unseat the Viking for the league win, they came out strong in the second half, and handled pretty much anything that Grayling

threw at them, except for a 10-0 Viking run late in the third. "I was pleased with how the kids responded to that run and fought back and competed to keep it a manageable game through the fourth quarter," Dzwik added. "The kids scraped and fought all game and played through the final buzzer and that is a credit to how hard these guys are working to get better each day and how competitive they are. Again though this game and really all the games on Friday, really shows the depth and strength of this league and how good every team is in it, I know these guys see that and are working hard to be up in the conversation and play a role in who wins the league title." Keegan McDuffie and AJ Bartlett led the way with 10 points each, while Cooper Stevenson added eight points despite big foul trouble limiting him to 10-12 minutes on the night. Stevenson also chipped in with 11 rebounds, with Ethan Zeeryp and Keegan McDuffie each adding six boards. East Jordan slips to 0-6 overall, 0-2 LMC, and will hit the hardwood on January 12, when they travel to Elk Rapids.

EAST JORDAN — What a difference a couple of days makes.

That would be the case for the EJ girls basketball team, as the Red Devils bounced back from a disappointing loss two days earlier, by blowing past Lake Michigan Conference opponent Grayling on January 5.

“Hard to believe this is the same team I saw two nights ago,” EJ coach Steve Hines said. “Much better night on the court for the Lady Red Devils. We shot better, we rebounded better and we took care of the basketball.”

East Jordan led at the quarter breaks 14-9, 30-14 and 43-25.

Abby Peterson and Lily Black finished with 10 points each to lead the Red Devils, while Jayden Weber and Madeline Malpass chipped in with seven each and Kendall McNitt added six, on a pair of triples that have her tied with the most three-pointers in EJ girls history with 85.

Rebecca Drenth grabbed nine boards, Gabby Snyder hauled in eight and Weber added seven, while Peterson made four steals and McNitt had three and three assists.

“Good balanced scoring in all four quarter and individually,” Hines noted. “Lily (Black) came off the bench and played well, very active on both ends of the floor and Rebecca (Drenth) had her best game of the season so far, controlling the boards. Looking for consistency as we move into the heart of the season.”

EJ is 3-4 overall, 1-1 in the Lake Michigan Conference and will travel to Elk Rapids on January 12.

Bellaire 36, East Jordan 33

BELLAIRE — The Red Devils girls basketball team were unable to get things going for most of the night, falling to Bellaire 36-33 in a non-league contest on January 3.

“Close game the entire night, East Jordan coach Steve Hines said. “We didn’t play very well and we seemed to be flat and just couldn’t get into any flow during the game. Our defense kept us in the game but, our rebounding was not very good and our ball handling was not as strong as it should have been.”

Despite struggling in their first contest following the holiday break, the Red Devils still had opportunities to pull even or win the game but were unable to get the shots to fall when needed.

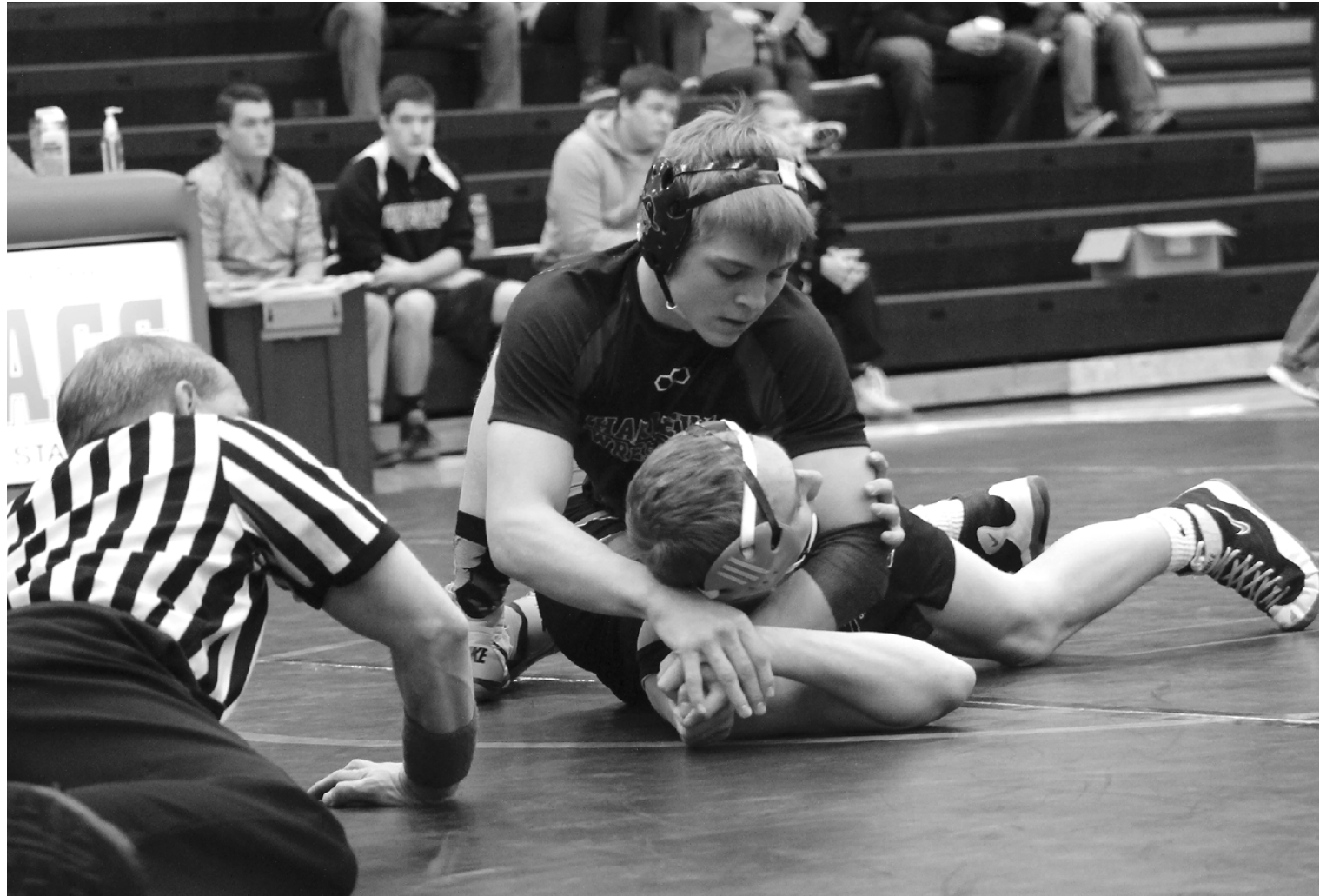
Jayden Weber finished with 17 points and 10 rebounds and Kendall McNitt added nine points to pace EJ.
