Ramblers fall in key battle with St. Francis

TCSF 56, Boyne City 46

BOYNE CITY — Putting together a solid 32 minutes is key to any team's ability to compete against top level opponents.

The Boyne City boys basketball team found that out against Lake Michigan Conference rival, Traverse City St. Francis, as the Ramblers had a slight lull in the second quarter that was just long enough to give the visiting Gladiators time to build a lead and the two went on to play evenly the remainder of the night in the St. Francis 56-46 win on February 17.

The two teams left it all on the floor, taking part in a highly physical contest, with neither team backing down, surrounded by fans that had the gymnasium rocking to a college like atmosphere.

Defense took the stage right from the opening tipoff with both teams not allowing any open looks on the perimeter and all drives to the basket were contested with big bodies blocking previously wide open lanes and pull-up jumpers were challenged by outstretched arms as the teams battled to a score of 8-8 following the first quarter.

It was the second quarter that doomed the Ramblers, as the Gladiators were able to continue their first quarter defense, while they were able to get a few easy looks at the hoop to create a lead that they would not relinquish, outscoring Boyne 18-10 during that span for a 26-18 TC lead at intermission.

"We got off to good start," Rambler coach Nick Redman said. "We had some mental breakdowns defensively to end first half that was

the difference in game. We just didn't finish at rim or rebound well enough to get over the hump the rest of game it was even."

Once the second half began, it was obvious that the both teams would not be outdone by their opponent, getting stop after stop on defense, blocking close range shots or trading baskets. Boyne was able to cut into the Gladiator lead, pulling within 10 points, outscoring TCSF by a bucket during the third quarter.

The fourth quarter featured more of an offensive display by both squads, but Boyne City could not get over the hump and St. Francis was able to hold off the Ramblers efforts down the stretch.

"Proud of our effort," coach Redman added. (The) guys battled, they were little better than us tonight."

Redman also noted the team got solid play from Dillon Sulak, Dylon Williams, Ethan Hewitt and Max Vondra off the bench.

The Ramblers 10-6 overall, 8-4 LMC slip to two games off the conference lead with the loss.

had plenty to cheer about during the final eight minutes of regulation as Charlevoix clamped down on defense and battled back offensively to pull within one point with 13 seconds remaining in the game.

The Rayders had multiple opportunities to pull even with the Ramblers over the final seconds, missing a free throw while trailing by one and were unable to connect on a triple try.

The rivalry game was close throughout the evening, knotted at 10-all after one quarter of play and BC went up 18-16 at halftime.

Rayders give top contender tough battle

Kalkaska 60, Charlevoix 48

CHARLEVOIX — Don't look now, but the Rayder girls basketball team is getting closer to taking a top spot among the league leaders in the Lake Michigan Conference.

Charlevoix played pretty even with the co-LMC leaders for most of the night, trailing 20-15 after one quarter of play and were still down five at the half, 34-29.

A strong start to the third quarter had the young Rayders all tied up with the veteran Blazers, but a fast finish by Kalkaska put them back in front 48-39 entering the fourth quarter.

Freshman Elise Stuck added another double-double to her season totals, scoring 19 points and hauling in 12 boards, while also dishing out three assists.

Olivia Jeakle chipped in with 14 points and five rebounds and Abby Cunningham netted 12 points and grabbed eight rebounds.

The Rayders slip to 12-6 overall, 8-4 LMC with the hard-fought loss.

Big night by Stuck leads Rayders over Boyne

Charlevoix 47, Boyne City 32

BOYNE CITY — As the season moves towards tournament time, the Charlevoix girls basketball team continues to improve. A big part of that is the play of freshman Elise Stuck.

Stuck continued her outstanding play on February 14, notching another double-double, finishing with 17 points, 17 rebounds, five assists and three steals in the Rayders 47-32 victory over Boyne City.

In a contest that the Rayders took control of from the get-go (14-6 after the first quarter), Stuck ran the Rayder offense from the point position and seemed to sky above everyone to grab every rebound.

Charlevoix continued to pour it on during the second quarter, extending their lead to a 30-10 advantage at the break, the Rayder lead would reach 23 with just under two minutes to play in the third quarter, 40-17 on a Rachel Nesburg basket.

Boyne City would not go quietly, as Molly Burch would connect on a triple attempt early in the fourth quarter, part of her nine points on the night, igniting a 15-7 Rambler run over the final eight minutes of play.

Rachel Nesburg would finish with 13 points, six boards and three assists, while Abby Cunningham added five rebounds and Natalie Nesburg scored three and made three steals.

HARBOR SPRINGS — What a way to finish a big week of basketball.

The East Jordan girls team edged Harbor Springs, 51-47 in a Lake Michigan Conference contest on February 17 to complete a 3-0 sweep of opponents over the week.

"Long week and we competed every game, very proud of the effort from the Lady Red Devils!" East Jordan coach Steve Hines said. "Another game with some players missing and everyone stepped up did what we needed to do to pick up a road win against a good team."

The two teams kept the game close throughout the night, with Elk Rapids leading 10-8 at the end of the first and 19-16 at halftime and 28-25 by the end of the third quarter.

A 18-8 offensive explosion in the fourth quarter by the Lady Red Devils would turn that three point deficit into a seven point road victory.

East Jordan 51, Ellsworth 50

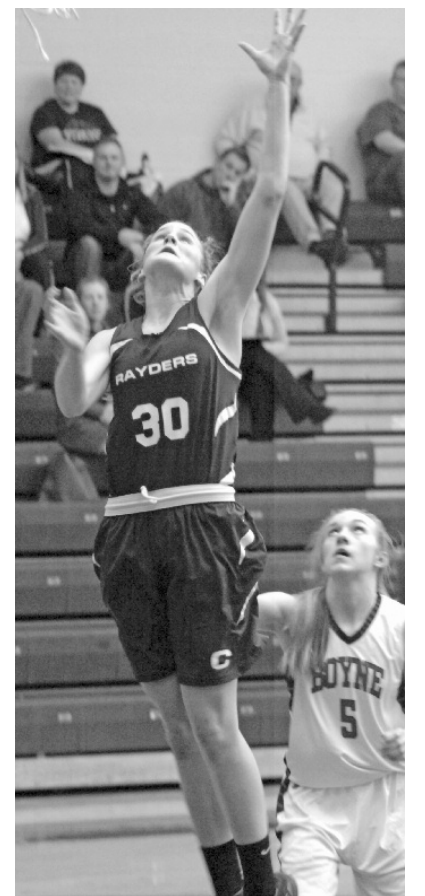

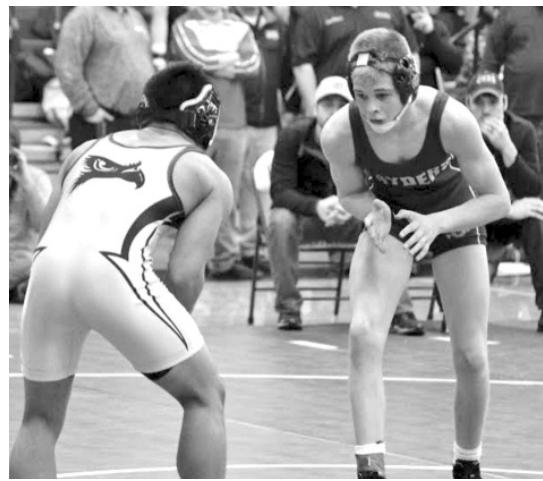
In the finals, Chernauckas fell to No.2 ranked, Trevor Robinson of Shepherd 1-17 to finish in second place.

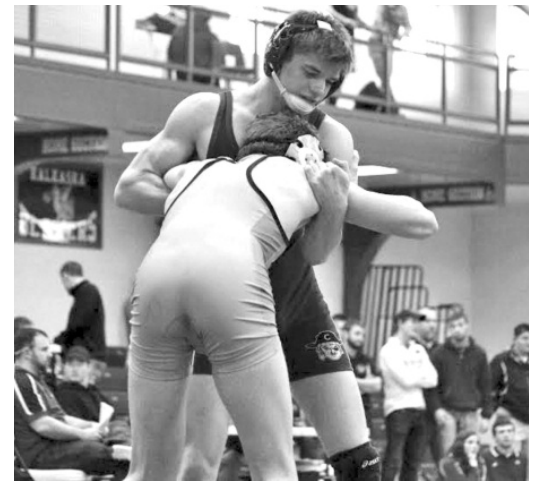

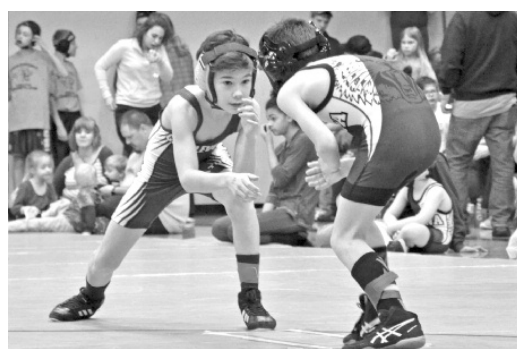

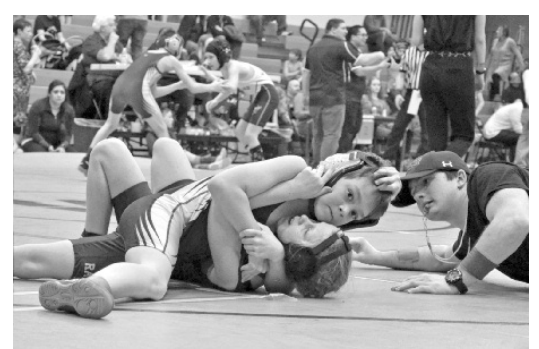

Rams use long range shots to down Red Devils

Harbor Springs 75, East Jordan 55

HARBOR SPRINGS — The East Jordan and Harbor Springs boys teams have each had their share of bright spots and tough moments during this season, but on February 17, it was the Rams that got an offensive lift that propelled them to a 75-55 Lake Michigan Conference victory over the Red Devils.

The Rams connected on 12 long-range triples during the contest, despite some tough, in-your-face defense by the ever resilient Red Devils.

With Harbor Springs hot shooting, East Jordan found themselves down 13 after one quarter and 20 at the half.

“Harbor made 12 three-point shots despite some decent defense which put us in a hole we couldn't get out of,” East Jordan coach Nate Dzwik said. “We handled their pressure better than we have most of the season and limited our turnovers which gave us a chance to stay in the game but we couldn't get past 12 down and really put pressure on them.”

Over the final two quarters of play, the teams played evenly with the Rams holding an 18-15 advantage in the third and the Red Devils responding with a 16-13 point differential in the fourth quarter.

Colin Shepard finished with a game-high 22 points to lead East Jordan, while Jackson Robbins and Jackson Raymond both added eight points, with Raymond also grabbing seven rebounds.

Harbor Springs got 21 points from Joe Claramunt and Nick Bonter chipped in with 15.

The Red Devils slip to 3-12 overall, 0-10 LMC with the loss.

Short handed EJ no match for Elks

Elk Rapids 72, East Jordan 38

ELK RAPIDS — The East Jordan boys basketball team were dealt a blow on February 14, taking on a tough Elk Rapids team despite missing three key players out to injury or illness, ultimately falling to the Elks 72-38 in a Lake Michigan Conference contest.

Elk Rapids took advantage of the short-handed Red Devils early on, jumping out to a 26-6 first quarter

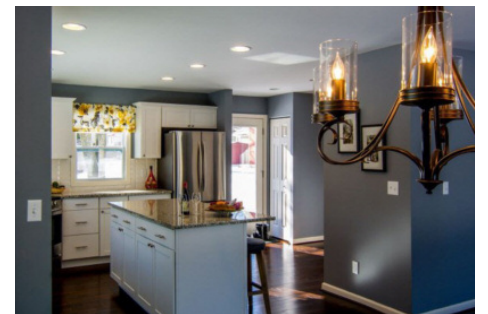

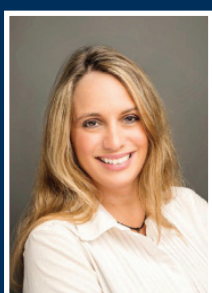
