Charlevoix stakes claim to District title

Charlevoix 56, Harbor Springs 36

HARBOR SPRINGS -- It's tough to beat a team three times in a season, a feat that stood in the way of the Charlevoix girls basketball team, as they faced the Class C district host, Harbor Springs in the title game on March 3.

Throw in the fact that the last time these two schools meet for the championship in 2015, the Rams went on to defeat the Rayders 53-41 in that contest.

This time it would be different as Charlevoix slowly pulled away from the opening tip, holding an 11-6 lead after the first and leading by 11, 26-15 at halftime and kept right on going after the intermission for a 40-24 advantage headed into the final quarter.

A pair of freshmen would lead the Rayders in scoring, as Elise Stuck finished with 19 points, 16 rebounds, four steals and three blocks and Abby Cunningham chipped in with 10 points and eight boards.

Rachel Nesburg would add nine points, three steals and three blocks for Charlevoix, while Natalie Nesburg added seven points, six steals and five assists and Beth Veenstra contributed five points.

"Good scoring balance with a tenacious defensive effort," Rayder coach Liz Shaw noted. "It was a great feeling of satisfaction Last year we struggled to put points on the board and were constantly out worked by our much older opponents." Charlevoix improves to 17-6 overall on the season. "This year, although not old in age, but older and wiser in game experience, it showed tonight," Shaw added. "We struggled at times in getting flow, but we were able to rebound fast and take care of the ball when we needed to secure the win." Harbor Srings would get 13 points from Libby Garver in the losing effort.

CHARLEVOIX - When Boyne City and Charlevoix get together, fans are always in for a treat.




The Rayders had a chance at pulling even with 7.4 seconds to go in the fourth. Following a timeout, Charlevoix senior Kevin Pearl weaved his way through traffic, coming off a couple of screens and got a clean look at a triple from the right wing, only to have it go just off the mark, but teammate, Luke Buday would gather the rebound and found an open teammate for another look, only to have Boyne City's Mason Gardner block the shot and tip the ball to halfcourt as the horn sounded, sending the Rambler bench and stands into a frenzy.

"That was another hard fought rivalry game," Boyne City coach Nick Redman said. "Typical Boyne-Charlevoix, both teams played incredibly hard! Both teams played great defense tonight."

Leading 31-30 after three quarters of play, Boyne City would go on a 6-0 run to begin fourth on three straight Jacob Ager baskets from inside the paint, as the Ramblers pulled ahead 37-30 with just under five minutes to play.






