Rambler repeat! Hills comes up big in title contest

Boyne City 5, Elk Rapids 2

Boyne City 8, Newberry 6

CHARLEVOIX — It's tough to win a championship. It's even tougher to do it again, especially when you're the underdog.

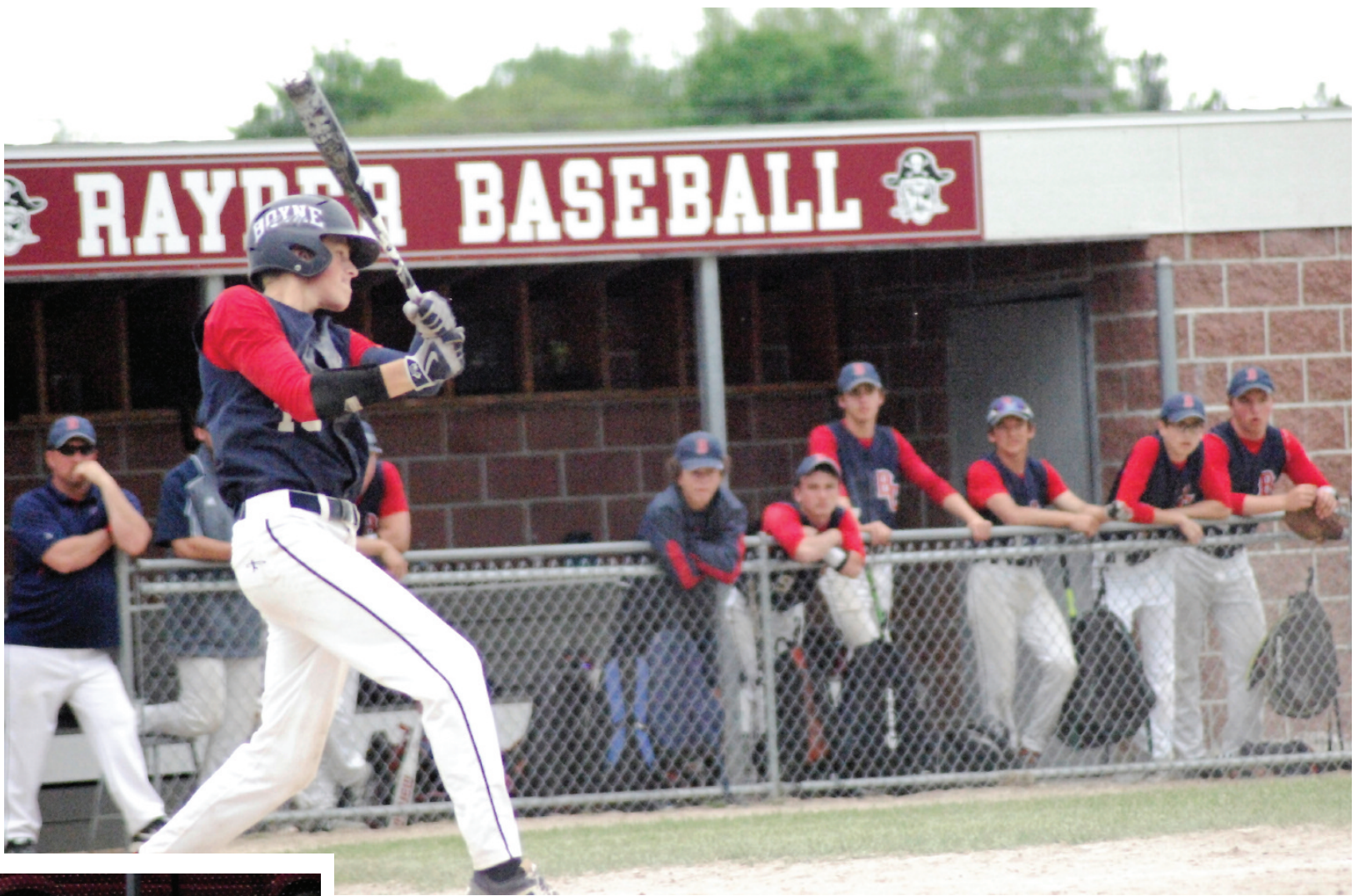
The Boyne City baseball team did just that on June 3, claiming their second straight district crown, defeating a high-powered Elk Rapids team that was favored to win, 5-2 in the title contest.

It was a combination of superb pitching and timely hitting, that helped propel the Ramblers to their repeat.

Boyne advanced to the title contest after defeating Newberry 8-6 in the district semifinal earlier in the day, while Elk Rapids beat Charlevoix 7-0 on the other side of the bracket.

In the championship contest, Boyne battled back from a two run deficit. The Ramblers were able to get the big hit when it was needed as senior Tristan Stackus delivered a seeing-eye single up the middle, plating Dylan Hutterer and on the same series pinch-runner Max Koch would hustle home on a throwing error by Elk Rapids.

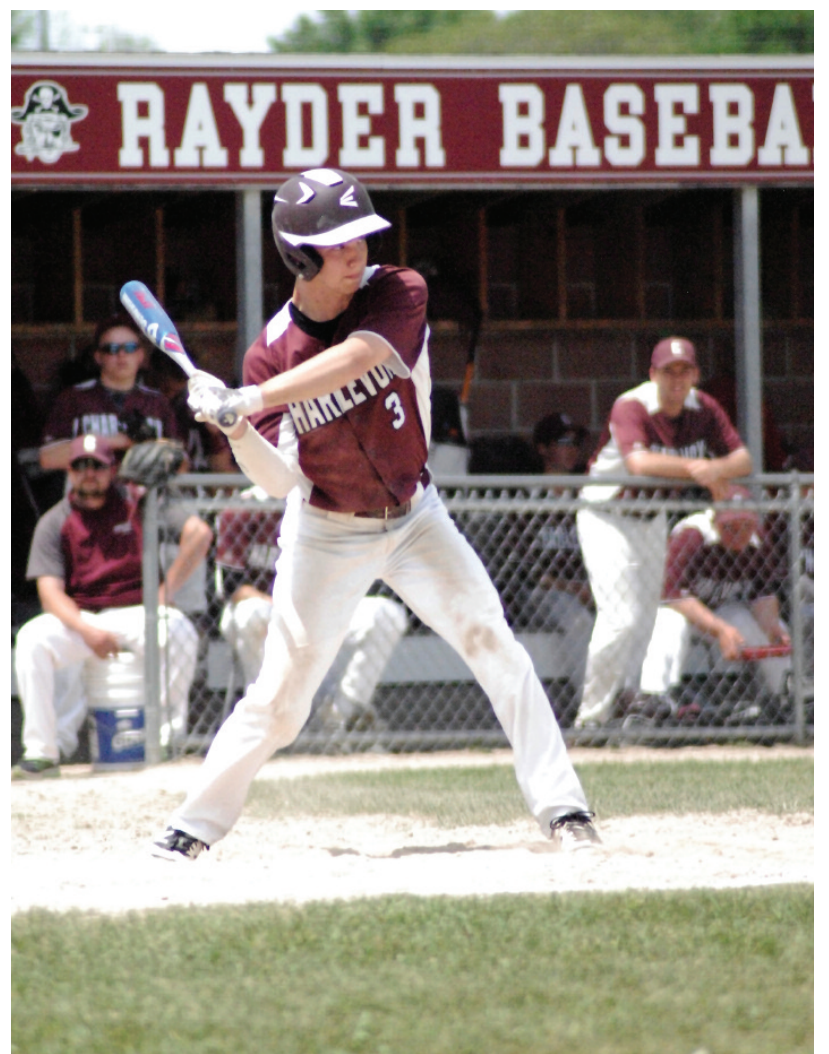
Now with the momentum, BC got a double by Ethan Hewitt, driving in Stackus for a 3-2 advantage. The

Ramblers would maintain that margin until the bottom half of the 6th, when Ethan Hills decided to add to the lead, sending a rocket single to the grass, scoring Stackus and Hutterer on the play and a 5-2 lead.

"The pitcher was working pretty quick, so I called time to get myself set-up, and hit a line drive," Hills noted.

In addition to his timely hitting at the plate, Hills (a sophomore) was just as impressive on the mound, keeping the Elks off balance all day, working 5 and 6 innings, before reaching his pitch limit and earning the eventual victory. Freshman Nick Aown would come in and despite allowing the Elks to earn a couple of walks, he would shut them down over the final 1 and 2 innings to pick up the save and give Boyne the victory.

"I think once they (Elk Rapids) got the lead, the fire got lit under us and the bats got going, the pitching got going and the defense was all good and for those next four innings it showed," Hills said following the championship contest. "Nick did great, I told him right before he came in (after Hills reached his pitching limit) to finish what I started, we need this victory and he did."

Despite having a lot of youth on the roster, Rambler coach Todd

Ramblers take control late to win district

Boyne City 10, Mancelona 2

Boyne City 11, Elk Rapids 1

CHARLEVOIX — Hitting is contagious, and while Boyne City is well aware of this due to their recent string of success, it never gets old to watch it in action.

Clinging to a 2-1 lead headed into the bottom of the third, the Boyne City softball team flexed their muscles, scoring five times on six hits, highlighted by a triple and a pair of two-run home runs, one each by Katie Hoth and Sophia Morias, as the Ramblers went on to win their fifth straight district championship 10-2 over Mancelona on June 3.

Once the Rambler bats got going in the third, it was lights out from there as they tacked on two more in the fourth and another solo run in the sixth.

Boyne would finish with 14 hits in the game, including six that went for extra bases, led by a 4-for-4 afternoon by Kelsey Hubbard, including a pair of triples. Hoth added three hits, including her home run and a triple, with 3 RBIs; Morias added her homer among two hits and 3 RBIs; Brooklyn Fitzpatrick and Emma Vondra both singled twice with RBIs; Katelyn Gabos added a double and Grace Wells singled.

In the circle, Hoth went the first 4 \square innings against Mancelona, allowing zero earned runs, one hit, striking out six and walking four. Madi Rosenow tossed the final 1 \square inning, allowing one hit and walking two.

Vondra, the lone Rambler senior was overcome with emotion after the victory, one that allows her to play at home once again, as Boyne City hosts the regional tournament on Saturday, June 10.

“Capturing the program’s fifth straight district title means the world to me,” Vondra said. “All of the girls on the team stepped up and played solid defense and got it done at the plate. It’s pretty cool to see everything click this time of year.”

“Our goal from day one has been to keep the streak; however, we want more. That regional trophy is now our main goal and the fact that we get to work towards that goal on our home field means the absolute world to myself and the whole team.”

The Ramblers advanced to the final with an 11-1, five inning mercy win over Elk Rapids in the second semifinal of the day.

Hoth picked up the victory in the circle, recording eight strikeouts, while allowing four hits and walking two.

BC scored twice in the first due to aggressive base running by Hoth and Hubbard, Boyne then added four runs in the third and five more in the fourth inning to complete their scoring.

At the plate, Hubbard finished

Rayders win in shootout..claim district title

Charlevoix 2, Kingsley 1

TRAVERSE CITY — The Charlevoix girls soccer team has made a habit of adjusting. That would be the case once again for the battle tested Lady Rayders, as some of the starters were unavailable due to conflicting schedules with the state track meet, but nonetheless, the team was up for the challenge and ended up pulling out a 2-1 victory, thanks to outscoring the Stags 4-3 on penalty kicks on June 3.

The Rayders got on the board first as Payton Novotny took a pass from Abbey Scholeten and used a quick shot to boot the ball past the Kingsley keeper for a 1-0 lead with 39:18 to play in the first half.

Charlevoix would hold the lead until 21:06 in the second half when Kingsley's Hannah Dutton broke free and found a hole in the Rayder defense to score the equalizer.

The game remained knotted at 1-1 through an additional 20 minutes of overtime. Faced with penalty kicks to decide the outcome, the Rayders went a perfect 4-for-4, as Megan Scholten, Payton Novotny, Jane Kelly and Raigan Novotny were successful.

Beth Veenstra recorded two stops in the shootout and had 12 saves in the game to earn the win in goal.

Charlevoix improves to 14-7-1 on the season. Results from their June 6 contest at Clare High School against Big Rapids in regional play were not available at press time.

"I was so proud that our girls were able to grind this one out. It was difficult playing in the heat," Charlevoix coach Pete Scholten said. "Due to the state track meet we were without some of our starters. This was a great opportunity for our bench to step up and contribute to the win. We have put a lot of time in on pk shots at practice this season so we were very confident going into the shootout. Practice paid off as our girls went a perfect four for four."

Gaylord St. Mary 10, East Jordan 3

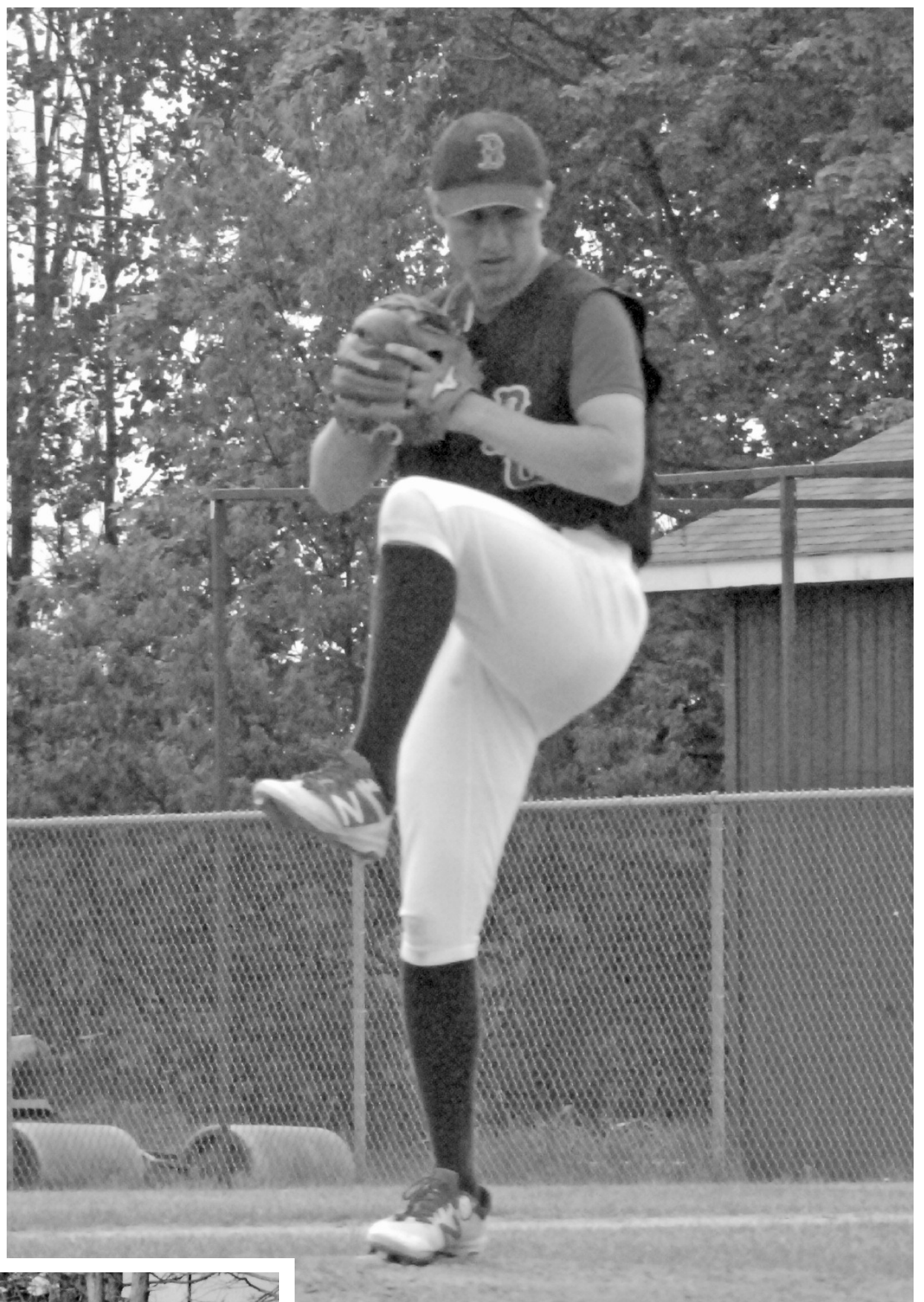

On the mound, Kaleb Raymond started and took the pitching loss with Barnett coming on to toss the final 5 2/3 innings of strong relief,



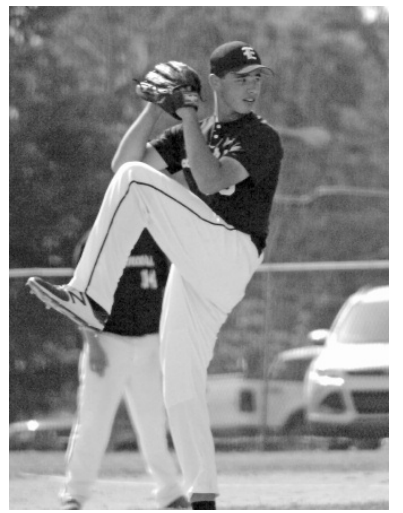

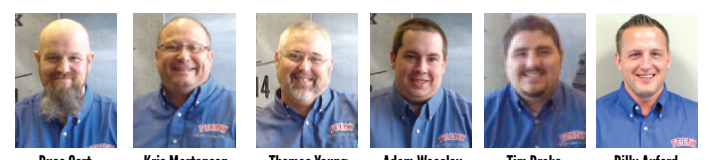
