Ramblers battle back, but come up short in regional semifinal

Manistee 6, Boyne City 56

BOYNE CITY — The Boyne City softball team battled back all afternoon, and had the game winning run at the plate when a deep fly ball to right-center got held up in the wind, allowing Manistee to record the final out of a 6-5 Chippewas regional semifinal victory on Saturday, June 10.

Manistee had the Ramblers playing catch-up all day, taking a 2-0 lead early on and extending that to

a 3-1 advantage after three innings of play, going up 5-2 in the sixth and then 6-4 headed into the bottom of the seventh.

The Chippewas pushed a pair of runs across in the first as the top of their line up got on with two singles and moves around the basepaths and eventually scored both runs with the aid of a pair of passed balls.

Boyne would cut that margin in half in the bottom of the second, 2-1, as freshman Katelyn Gabos

blasted a homerun run 20 plus feet over the left-center field wall for a solo shot.

Manistee would answer right back in the third, as their leadoff hitter, Erin Dorn reached again on one of her three singles in the game, moving up on passed balls and coming home when the Ramblers fielded an infield ground ball and went to first for the out, giving them a 3-1 lead.

The score would remain that way until the bottom of the fourth when BC junior, Katie Hoth hit a stand-up triple and used a delayed steal on the very next pitch, sliding home well ahead of the throw to bring the Ramblers within one run once again.


In the top of the sixth, Manistee used the aid of two walks a single and an error to tack on two more runs for a 5-2 lead, but Boyne responded in their half of the frame, when, with two outs, the Ramblers strung together four straight singles off the bats of Hoth, Emma Vondra, Sophia Morias and Gabos, scoring two runs, cutting the Chippewas lead to 5-4 headed into the final inning.

Manistee added another run in the top of the seventh as Nicole Zimmerman doubled over the drawn in outfield and would score on a triple by Emma Witkowski for a 6-4 lead.

In the Ramblers final at-bat, the Chippewas would record the first

two outs before Boyne made it interesting, as junior Kelsey Hubbard tripled and scored to make it 6-5, on freshman Brooklyn Fitzpatrick's single up the middle, setting the stage for the heart of the lineup.

After falling behind 0-2 in the count, Hoth took ball one and on the next pitch, sent a high, towering fly ball to right-center with a chance to go out, but had it knocked down by the wind just in front of the warning track and into the glove of the Chippewas outfielder to end the game.

At the plate for the Ramblers,

Gabos homered among two hits, while Hubbard tripled and doubled, Hoth tripled and singled, while Vondra, Fitzpatrick and Morias all added one hit.

Hoth took the loss in the circle, despite only allowing two earned runs on nine hits, striking out five and walking six in seven innings of work.

Boyne City will say goodbye to Vondra, their lone senior first baseman, who was part of four of the Ramblers five straight district titles.

That task included taking on No. 1 ranked Traverse City St. Francis in the semifinal contest. Boyne City kept it close early on as the pitching and defense held their own, but the Ramblers could not come up with the big hit when they needed

it, falling to the Gladiators 8-0 on Saturday, June 10.

On the other side of the diamond, St. Francis got the pitching performance they expected out of starter Casey Peterson and also from relief pitcher Connor Sweet, as the pair combined to limit Boyne to four hits over seven innings of play.

After a scoreless first inning, the Ramblers threatened in the top of the second, putting runners on second and third, but could not get the hit they needed to score either runner.

In the bottom portion of the frame, with runners on the corners, a pickoff attempt to first base caught the runner off too far, and when he took off towards second and Boyne pursued, the runner at third broke for home and scored before the runner at second was tagged out, giving the Glads a 1-0 advantage and what would turn out to be all that the St. Francis pitching staff would need as they scattered a few more runs over the next three innings.

Sophomore Ethan Hills took the pitching loss, working 5 1/3 innings,

before giving way senior, Tristan Stackus who finished up.

At the plate, Hills finished with two hits, while Connor Gabos doubled and Dylan Hutterer chipped in with a single.

Boyne City closes out the season with a record of 17-16 and graduate a trio of seniors in Hutterer, Dominik Archey and Stackus, each helping contribute to the Ramblers back-to-back district championships.

foreseeable future.



EAST JORDAN—East Jordan is heading in the right direction and its future is bright was the message members of the community walked away with after hearing four keynote speakers discuss the status of the city, schools, and DDA at East Jordan's State of the Community Luncheon Tuesday, November 11.

An air of optimism filled the Harvest Barn hall as 26 East Jordan High School seniors and other members of the community listened intently to Mayor Russell Peck whose speech focused on the challenges and infrastructure im-

provements that still lie ahead for the city. "All in all things are looking up, we're heading in the right direction. Together we will position our community for a resilient and sustainable future. Indeed, East Jordan's future is bright," he concluded.

Peck not only talked about all that the city has accomplished but emphasized the infrastructure improvements needed to accommodate new growth. "We are very optimistic about the future of our community and that optimism comes from the exciting new direction we have been heading," he said. He cited the city's sewer system that is already operating at 98%

capacity, sidewalks, and sea-pilings to be installed at the southwest side of the harbor next to the bridge intended to stop silt from filling the harbor (construction to begin in December) as projects that will further enable the city to grow. He mentioned the new well house (al- open 24/7 recycling center and the \$12,000 kayak facility in the park which he stated presently "looks like an art project." "We are developing the kind of community we have envisioned for future generations. There is a positive up beat energy," he said.
