With that being said, it is time to recognize the top players for their efforts in leading their respective teams as the Charlevoix County News announces the 2017 All-Area Softball "Dream Team".

The Ramblers of Boyne City once again advanced to regional play after their talented pool of softball players captured their fifth consecutive district crown. Boyne also finished in the top half of the Lake Michigan Conference this season.

Charlevoix and East Jordan both improved this season, taking on tough opponents and pushing them to their limits.

Ellsworth and Boyne Falls put together strong seasons in the Northern Lakes Conference, and will look to challenge for the title next spring.

individuals that stood out amongst their peers, there were a few that were just a little bit better and were vital pieces to each of their teams success. Once again, this years All-Area Softball "Dream Team" boasts strong pitching, sure-handed infielders, fleet-footed outfielders and rocket-armed catchers.

## Player of the Year

### Katie Hoth

junior, #9

Hoth proved to be of great value to the Ramblers once again this season, leading the team in triples, home runs, stolen bases, RBIs and also picked up 10 pitching victories, en route to earning Division 3 All-State honors as an outfielder. She is a two-time All-Area selection.

When asked about being selected the 2017 Player of the Year, Katie had this to say, "Awesome! I work hard outside of day to day practice and it's nice to know people notice the time I put into becoming a better athlete. Being selected Player of the Year is an honor, however, I will be pushing harder next year, as my goal this year was to make it out of regionals. My hope is that next year through hard work and determination, we can make it even further."

Hoth's ability to chase down any fly ball on defense was not only matched on offense, but her power hitting and baserunning put her in a class of her own. She was also recently named All-Lake

Michigan Conference, All-District and All-Region.

"My first thank you goes out to my parents. My dad (Robert) is very encouraging, always pushing me to be the absolute best I can be. Whether in the weightroom, or pitching me soft toss. My mom (Michele) never misses a game, and goes out of her way to make sure I have everything I need in order to be successful."

"With that being said, she take me to a hitting coach that deserves a ton of credit for my bat. Coach Greg Jones has been working with me for just over four years. Not only transforming my swing, but also my mindset. I also want to thank all the fans that the team has. We're fortunate to have so many loyal fans that come time and time again no matter the place or weather. It's so much more exciting to play in front of a fanbase. They make you want to go above and beyond on the field."

Katie finished this season with a batting average of .496, pounding out 59 hits in 119 at-bats, including nine doubles, 13 triples, seven home runs and knocked in 53 RBIs, while

also drawing 20 walks. She had a .966 slugging percentage.

She was a nightmare on the basepaths for opponents, swiping 33 bags, including stealing home nine times and scored 58 runs for the Ramblers.

Defensively, she committed only one error all season to finish with a .992 fielding percentage.

In the circle, she finished the season with a 10-8-1 record and a 2.19 ERA. Hoth tossed 106 1/3 innings of ball, allowing 88 hits and only 39 earned runs. She also struck out 89, while walking 95.

This summer, Katie will be playing for the Traverse City Cherry Bombs, looking to increase her softball skills.

"I'm hoping to spend a lot of time in the outfield, simply for the experience. That's my favorite position to play, but I've only spent about a season and a half out there. As for the offensive side of the game, working on my mental strength is something I'm really focusing on. Being able to see every pitch and becoming a "choosy" batter is going to help me come next spring. Seeing a higher level of pitch-

ing will definitely be beneficial for not only that metal side, but also my actual skills."

Joining Hoth on the 2017 All-Area "Dream Team" are Rambler teammates, Kelsey Hubbard and Emma Vondra; Charlevoix's Hannah Solomon, Nichole Hart and McKenna Ebert; East Jordan's Chelsea Gibson, Marissa Kolp and Abby Peterson; Katelynn Wilson and Sydney Bess of Boyne Falls; and Samantha Miller, Abby Nachazel and Olivia Spence of Ellsworth.

first to lead the Rambler infield. She finished the season with a .941 fielding percentage.

At the plate, you could always count on Kelsey making contact and putting the ball in play, most of the time finding a gap that would lead to extra bases.

Hubbard finished the season with a .548 batting average, which included 68 hits in 124 trips to the plate. 23 of those hits were doubles, while adding eight triples and one home run.

She walked 21 times from her leadoff position and added 22 RBIs. Her slugging percentage was an astounding .887 percent.

Once on base, she too was a threat to steal every pitch, recording 17 steals. Kelsey also scored a team-high 63 runs.

Hubbard was selected as a Division 3 All-State Honorable Mention, while earning first-team honors in the LMC, and All-District and All-Region. Kelsey is a two-time All-Area selection.

## Emma Vondra

senior, #14

The lone senior on the Ramblers this past season, Vondra put up another year of great numbers on both sides of the ball.

Emma once again took her place at first base, a position that she has played since her freshman season, scooping up throws from her fielders and applying tags when her catchers decided that runners were just a little too far off the bag.

She finished with a fielding percentage of .965.

At the dish, Emma hit .430 from the four spot this season, recording 49 hits in 114 at-bats. She had 10 doubles and six home runs, while knocking in 45 runs and scoring 45.

Vondra walked 20 times, reached safely by error 11 times, made three sacrifices and had a slugging percentage of .675. Emma is a repeat All-Area selection and was selected as a first team Division 3 All-State.

## CHARLEVOIX

## Hannah Solomon

sophomore, #33

There is no doubt that Solomon is one of the fastest softball players in the area. She may be also be near the top in the state of Michigan.

Her ability to get out of the box quick allowed her to record 63 singles, four doubles, two triples and one home run. Hitting for a .660 batting average in 106 at-bats. She also walked nine times and had a slugging percentage of .764.

Hannah's on-base percentage was .682, she stole 43 bases, many times without a throw and scored 57 runs for the Rayders.

Solomon made the position change from shortstop to center field and both changes seemed to help the Charlevoix defense as it allowed her to utilize her quickness to chase down fly balls in the gap and minimize opponent's abilities to want to take an extra base.

She was a LMC first team selection and All-District.

## Nichole Hart

senior, #12

Hart was a good defender, solid offensive force in the middle of the lineup and leader for the young Rayder team.

Nichole moved from the outfield to first base this season and quickly turned into a very good corner defender for Charlevoix.

At the plate, she was a tough out, hitting most of the season from the four or five spot, pounding out 37 hits in 89 at-bats for a .416 average, that included seven doubles and two triples, while knocking in a team-high 29 RBIs.

She scored 26 runs, walked eight times, had an on-base percentage of .485 and a slugging percentage of .539.

## McKenna Ebert

senior, #15

The number three hitter for the Rayder offense, the two-time All-Area selection was a constant threat to connect every time she dug in at the plate.

Ebert finished the season with a .421 batting average, connecting for 40 hits in 90 at-bats, including a team-high 17 doubles and one triple, while knocking in 26 RBIs and scored 18 runs.

Defensively, McKenna was switched to the catcher position for Charlevoix and did an outstanding job behind the plate.

"McKenna stepped into the catcher position and after a few games, you would never know that it was her first year back there. She is a quick learner and did an outstanding job for us," coach Tom Mielke said.

She finished with a .621 slugging percentage and a .467 OBP. McKenna is a two-time All-Area selection and a first team LMC and All-District selection.

## EAST JORDAN

## Chelsea Gibson

junior, #3

One of the top catchers in Northern Michigan. Gibson was a solid wall behind the plate for the Red Devils and with a strong and accurate throwing arm, Chelsea kept runners close to their occupied base.

Gibson would throw out 17 runners this season, while making another 24 assists and recording seven putouts, with a .838 fielding percentage.

Her offensive numbers improved from a season ago, finishing the year with a .333 batting average, recording 24 hits in 72 at-bats, which included a double, two triples and three home runs. She also scored 24 runs for East Jordan.

She added seven stolen bases, had a slugging percentage of .551 and an OBP of .556

Chelsea was a first team LMC and All-District and a repeat All-Area selection.

## Marissa Kolp

senior, #4

A two-time All-Area selection and All-LMC first team and All-District player.

Kolp was a constant contributor for the Red Devils again this year, hitting .346 on the season, recording 28 hits in 81 at-bats, including four doubles and a triple with 12 RBIs, scoring 18 runs.

Marissa also had a slugging percentage of .431 and an OBP of .400.

Defensively, she finished with a team-high .958 fielding percentage, making only one error all season.

## Abby Peterson

junior, #14

A solid pitcher for East Jordan for the third straight season, Abby put together another strong year in the circle, working 95  $\square$  innings, facing over 550 batters and allowing 163 hits, recording 89 strikeouts, and finishing the season with a 4.00 ERA.

At the plate, Peterson hit .323, including five doubles, one triple and one home run to go with 17 RBIs and scored 15 runs for E.J.

Her slugging percentage

was .512 and her on-base percentage was .560.

Abby was a first team Lake Michigan Conference and All-District selection as well as a three-time All-Area selection.

## BOYNE FALLS

## Katelynn Wilson

senior, #1

Wilson was once again a key pitcher for the Loggers in her final season, tossing 41 innings of ball, allowing 58 earned runs and walking 42.

At the plate, Katelynn hit .418, with one double, two home runs and knocking in 31 RBIs.

She also stole five bases and scored 30 runs for BF.

## Sydney Bess

sophomore, #14

The Logger sophomore put the bat on the ball at a high rate this season for Boyne Falls.

At the plate, Bess hit a very respectable .365, pounding out 14 hits, including a triple and had 27 RBIs.

She also walked 16 times,

stole eight bases and scored 21 runs.

## Olivia Spence

sophomore, #17

The leading hitter for the Lancers this season, Spence finished the year with a .588 batting average, while knocking in 24 runs. Her slugging percentage was .853 and Olivia hit one home run.

"She's has had a great year, and has shown great discipline at the plate this year," coach Andy Montgomery said. "She is a great one to have batting if you need runners moved. Great hand to eye coordination."

## Abby Nachazel

junior, #8

One of the leaders for Ellsworth both in the circle and at the plate. A team captain, Nachazel was a force when she was hurling the ball, finishing 18-11 on the year, recording 222 strikeouts and an ERA just over 2.00.

Abby tossed a no-hitter against Mason County Cen-

tral, while also throwing a one-hitter and a couple of two-hitters.

At the plate, Nachazel hit .553, with nine home runs and 54 RBIs. She had a slugging percentage of 1.132 and hit .714 with runners in coring position.

## Samantha Miller

sophomore, #23

Miller was another key contributor for the young Ellsworth team, playing pretty much every position on defense for the Lancers this year.

Samantha hit .443 at the plate with 27 RBIs, while slugging at a .714 percentage rate.

"She is a great asset to the team offensively and defensively, as we can put her anywhere with confidence," coach Montgomery said.
