## Ramblers win battle of defense versus offense

### Boyne City 21, Grayling 6

BOYNE CITY — It was your typical offense versus defense battle and in this case, an explosive offense against a very stingy defense.

It would be the ball-hawking, hard-hitting Boyne City defense that prevailed in a battle of early season unbeatens, as the Ramblers held Grayling to only one score in their 21-6 victory on September 22 at Earl Brotherston Field in Boyne City.

The match-up featured the pass happy spread offense of the Vikings, that came into the contest averaging an astronomical 47 points per contest, while the Ramblers were only allowing just over eight points per game.

With the victory, Boyne moved to 5-0 overall and 3-0 in the Northern Michigan Football League - Leg-

ends Division, while the Vikings dropped to 4-1, 2-1.

“We’ve been playing very good defensively all year,” Rambler coach Dave Hills said. “Our defense is our strength. That was the matchup I thought was going to be interesting to see, and fortunately, our defense rose to the occasion and played really well. To hold them to one score is really a testa-

ment to our defensive staff and the kids,”

Entering the contest, the Vikings knew that they weren’t going to run on the Boyne defense, so they stuck with their typical aerial attack, and found out right away that the Ramblers could defend that as well, as BC senior defensive back, Eric Carson picked off Grayling’s first offensive play of the night and returned it 14 yards to the Viking 25, setting up Boyne’s first scoring opportunity.

Eight plays later, quarterback, Ethan Hills handed it off to Tyler Price and the senior pounded the ball in from the 2-yard line for a touchdown. A successful extra point by Jacob Dean would put the Ramblers up 7-0 with 7:31 to play in the opening quarter.

Following that opening drive, both teams looked to be playing a chess match on the field, with neither squad able to get the upper hand and find a dent in the others armour, until the Vikings took advantage of a Boyne turnover with time ticking down in the second quarter.

Grayling would then use a mixture of quarterback Justin Nicholas, either passing or running the ball, getting the Vikings to the nine yard line with just over 30 seconds remaining in the half. On the next play, Nicholas started to rush up the middle after receiving the snap in the shotgun position and tossed a jump pass just before the line of scrimmage to Nick Hunter and he scooted into the end zone, making it 7-6 as the Viking conversion was unsuccessful.

After the halftime intermission, the two teams once again engaged in taking turns moving the ball down the field, but neither were able to do much more than that until the 10:52 mark of the fourth quarter when Rambler Dillon Sulak weaved his way through traffic and into the endzone for a 14-6 advantage after Dean’s point after was good.

After forcing a quick exit by the Viking offense on the next series,

Boyne looked to by driving in for another score, but turned the ball over at the Viking 10.

That’s when the Rambler defense stepped it up even another notch, forcing Grayling into a quick three-and-out and a short punt that went out of bounds at the Viking 40.

Three handoffs later and senior Joseph Baugh, in his first action since week one, tore through the line for a 10-yard touchdown, another Dean extra point would make it 21-6 with 4:33 remaining in the contest.

With one last chance to pull closer, the Viking were able to drive the ball down the field, only to fumble the ball inside the Rambler 1-yard line and have it recovered by BC linebacker, Jacob Ager and on the ensuing offensive play, the Ramblers would run out the clock for the win.

Leading the Boyne offensive attack was Baugh, as he gained 135 yards rushing on 18 carries and a score. Ethan Hewitt added 52 yards on five attempts, Trevor King, Tyler Price and Sulak combined for another 107 yards on the ground.

When coach Hills was asked about what it meant to have Baugh back in the fold, he replied. “He’s a dynamic back, and when you put him in the mix with our other backs, all of a sudden our offense is a little more effective.”

Hills finished 5-of-13 passing for 46 yards, completing two passes to each Mason Gardner and Hewitt, while King hauled in another.

While on the defensive side of the ball, Jacob Ager recorded 12 tackles, including one for a loss, while Neal Hautz added eight stops and a sack, Gardner and Ryan Hautz had seven tackles each and Frank Minier added a sack.

“This is a great win for us, we’ve beaten some teams, and we’ve kind of won them ugly. This is a very good team and we performed well. I’m super proud of the kids,” the coach added.

The Ramblers get back at it in conference play, when they travel down US 131 to play Kalkaska on Friday, September 29, gametime is 7pm.

Boyne earned the win to stay unbeaten in the LMC, winning 25-14, 16-25, 25-23 and 25-12.

“This was 100 percent a team effort tonight, boyne City coach Malory Slate said. “We knew going into the night that no matter what, the games were going to be intense and we were going to have to play our best and that’s exactly what happened.”

“Our senior leadership tonight from, (Kelsey) Hubbard, (Katie) McHugh, (Tyla) Coates and (Kendra) Kruzel was exactly what the team needed to get through the four games. Harbor Light won, 25-20, 25-10 and 25-13.

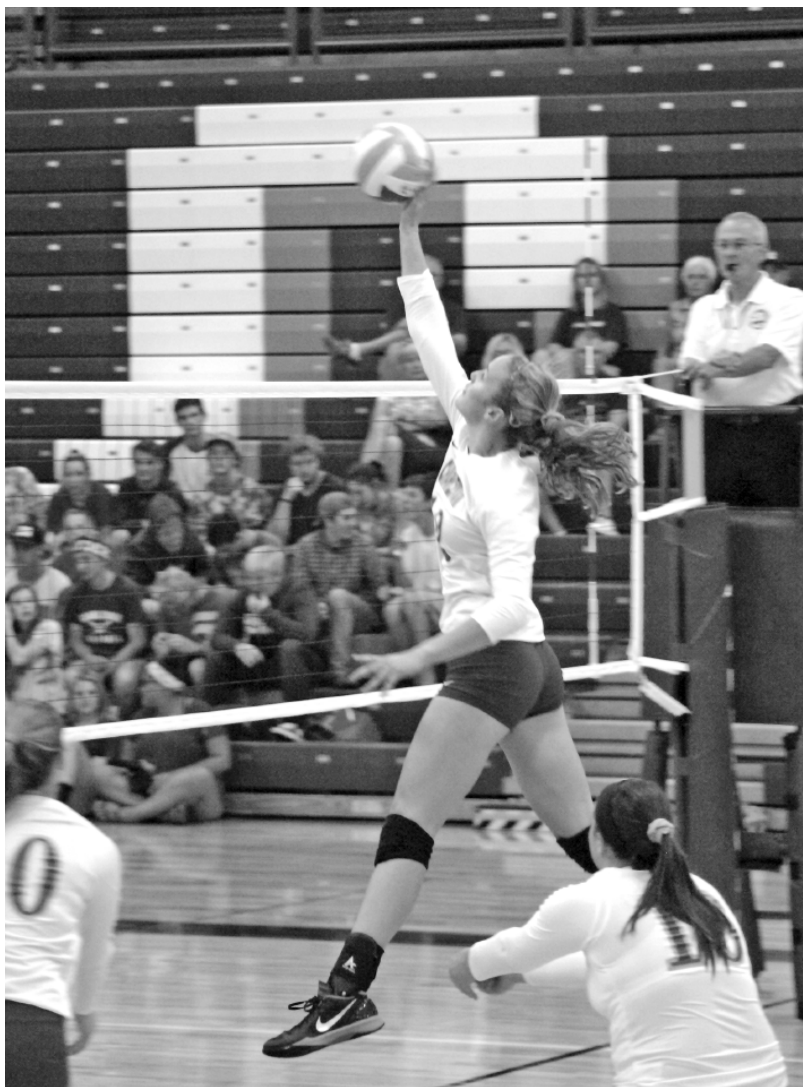
For Ellsworth, Abby Nachazel had four kills, one block and served at 100 percent with two aces.

## Red Devils run out of time in loss

### Inland Lakes 16, East Jordan 12

EAST JORDAN — In a tight, evenly matched contest, the game came right down to the end, before the Red Devils just ran out of time on the game clock in falling to visiting Inland Lakes, 16-12 on September 22 in a Northern Michigan Football League - Legacy Division contest.

With the loss, East Jordan dropped to 1-4 overall, 0-2 league on the season.

Both teams were able to get on the scoreboard in the opening quarter for a 6-6 tie, as Jack Cross bulled his way into the endzone for the Red Devils.

East Jordan took a 12-6 lead in the second quarter, as Keegan McDuffie found paydirt on a 9-yard scoring run. That lead however would be erased as the Bulldogs managed to push their way down the field, capitalizing on an 80 yard pass play to score with about 18 seconds to play in the quarter.

A field goal in the third quarter would give Inland Lakes their margin of victory, holding off a late charge by EJ, as the Red Devils moved the ball effectively, getting to the Bulldog 23 before they were stopped and then ran out of time.

Red Devil senior, Spencer Reid had an outstanding ground game, racking up 84 yards while quarterback Keegan McDuffie, in addition to his rushing touchdown, went to the airways and tossed for nearly 200 yards, finishing with 179 passing.

Nick Norton was the main recipient of these passes, hauling in 93 yards.

Defensively, Reid made 12 stops and had an interception, while Trent Graham added nine tackles and Hayden Ferguson had seven.

East Jordan host rival Charlevoix in a non-conference matchup on September 29, game time is 7pm.
