Skinny Ski for Free

Now that Father
Winter has deposited a foot or
more of that wonderful white stuff
it's time to wax up
those skinny skis.

Many places in northern Michigan provide either oftused or groomed cross country trails open to the public free of charge. Stride on over

Aspen Park: Featuring over 100 acres of natural splendor this Gaylord location is a terrific place to skinny ski. Two miles of groomed trails are also lighted for night skiing. You'll also have the opportunity to view elk, turkey, and other wildlife in the park. Access is from Commerce Blvd.

Wildwood Hills Pathway: East of Petoskey this area boasts 9.3 miles of groomed classic skiing trails for beginners to intermediates. You can choose loops ranging from 4.5 to 9 miles. Take C-58 (Mitchell Road) east for 9 1/2 miles then 3 miles on Wildwood Rd.

Hartwick Pines State Park (Grayling): Rare old-growth forests make this place a favorite. The Weary Legs trail provides 7.5 miles of groomed cross country ski trails from easy to difficult. Take exit 259 off I-75 and then north on M-93 (Hartwick Pines Rd.).

Birchwood Farms Golf and Country Club: Several miles of easy to moderate groomed trails meander through this lovely setting north of Harbor Springs. Travel on M-119 and

turn east on Middle Rd. The trailhead is adjacent to the clubhouse.

Petoskey State Park: The well-blazed trails and paved roads make for a smooth glide at the park on M-119. When snow covered, skiing amongst the beach dunes is exhilarating, especially in the glittering moonlight. An almost 2-mile loop is possible if you

ski the campground trail from the Dunes Campground to the Tannery Creek campground. You can also access the Little Traverse Wheelway via the short bike trail. The restrooms are a bonus!

Louis M. Groen Nature Preserve: This almost 800 acre nature preserve is operated by Otsego County Parks and Recreation. The preserve was

donated by Louis M. Groen. There are 8 miles of groomed trails and is free to use. Entrance is located of Gingell Road just west of Johannesburg.

Little Traverse Conservancy Preserves: The LTC has significantly broadened their groomed cross country trail offerings. Their website (www.landtrust.org) has a vast amount of information and interactive maps, or you can upload the smart phone app, LTC Explorer. A favorite cross country destination is the fabulously forested 600-acre Goodhart Farms Nature Preserve on Robinson Rd. in Goodhart.

Regardless of which area you choose few things are more exhilarating, yet tranquil, than shushing down a trail on cross country skis in Up North Michigan!

Michigan Outdoor Fun Fact:

One hour of vigorous cross country skiing burns over 850 calories!




