## Ramblers Top Red Devils, Fall to Gladiators

### Mid game surge moves Ramblers past Red Devils

**Boyne City 57,**  
**East Jordan 35**

**EAST JORDAN** -- A strong second half by Boyne City was what the Ramblers needed to pull out a 57-35 Lake Michigan Conference victory over East Jordan on January 19.

The contest was much closer than the final score, as

the Red Devils came out and gave Boyne all they could handle, leading after one quarter 10-8.

It was the middle two quarters where the Ramblers separated the teams as Boyne outscored East Jordan 42-9 over the 16 minutes.

"We played really good basketball in the second and third quarter, great team effort," Boyne City coach Nick Redman said. "Credit EJ for coming out fighting. (Coach) Nate Dzwik had them ready to play."

Boyne got 14 points from senior Mason Gardner, while Dillon Sulak added 13, Dylan Williams chipped in eight and Max Vondra had seven as nine players scored for the Ramblers.

Cooper Stevenson, scored 10 points and Keegan McDuffie added eight points to lead the Red Devils.

East Jordan falls to 0-9 overall, 0-5 LMC, while Boyne City improves to 6-3, 3-2.

On Friday, January 26, East Jordan plays at Traverse City St. Francis, while Boyne City hosts Grayling.

### Slow start too much to overcome for Boyne

"We came out on fire in the first quarter and played a very good first half," coach Hines said. "Offensively, we executed well, found the open player, shared the ball and shoot very well. Very proud of the effort tonight as we played great team basket-

ball."

EJ led at the quarter breaks 23-8, 46-25 and 59-37. "Jayden Weber and Karah Dunson both had great first halves, Jayden scoring 15 of her 20 points in the first half and Karah also scoring 15 in the first half!" Hines noted. "Karah hit four three point-

ers in the first half and appears to be coming out of her shooting slump. Probably our best game of the season and we seem to be playing more consistent basketball."

Weber finished with 20 points, eight rebounds and three steals to lead EJ, while Dunson added 16 and Abby Peterson, Madeline Malpass and Rebecca Drenth all chipped in with seven points each.

Malpass also grabbed eight boards and Kendall McNitt had five and six assists and three steals, while Peterson had four assists, Lilly Black three as the Red Devils improved to 6-5 overall, 3-2 LMC.

For the Ramblers (3-7, 0-5), Raegan May had 14 points, while Brooklyn Fitzpatrick, Jordan Noble and Brooklyn Fitzpatrick added eight points each, with Fitzpatrick adding six rebounds and Stadt making six steals and five assists.

MIO -- The Charlevoix wrestling team took part in the annual Josh Cartier Invitational on January 20 with five members placing in the top four.

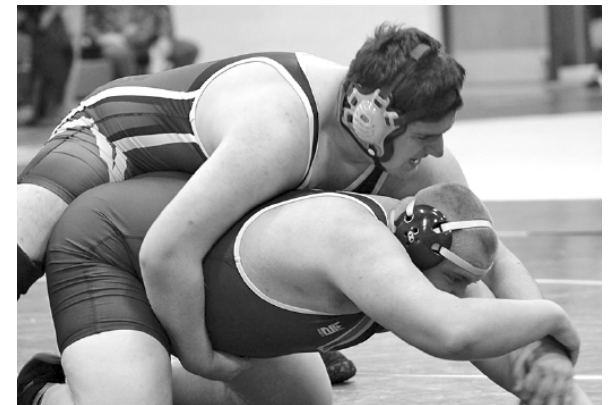
