Nesburg connects at the buzzer to complete comeback

**Charlevoix 50,
TC St. Francis 48**

CHARLEVOIX -- What a finish!

With 1:13 remaining in the game, Charlevoix trailed 48-37 and any hopes of a comeback looked all but gone.

Someone forgot to mention that to the Rayders.

Charlevoix went on a 13-0 run over that time span, capped by a Natalie Nesburg floater off the glass with 0.7 seconds left on the clock for an unbelievable, 50-48 Lake Michigan Conference victory on February 2.

"I felt we came out and were a step behind on the defensive end and turned the ball over and didn't really execute what we had practice offensively," Charlevoix coach Liz Shaw said. "The second half we made adjustments and held St. Francis to three points in the third and were able to get some crucial buckets from our bigs."

"The last quarter TCSF went into a stall but we were able to get the ball back on steals and missed free throws, but it was the last 1:13 that will stay in the memories of Rayder fans and the payers forever," coach Shaw added.

The Rayder comeback started with a Abby Cunningham layup conversion as she was fouled for a three-point play with the assist going to Natalie Nesburg.

Charlevoix was forced to foul, sending the Glads to the line for a 1/1 attempt that they were unable to convert, then a rebound and outlet by Elise Stuck to Olivia Jeakle to Rachel Nesburg to Natalie Nesburg for a baseline jumper cutting the lead to six.

Rachel Nesburg then made a steal off the Rayder press, passed the ball to Jeakle, back to Nesburg for a three pointer from the wing, pulling Charlevoix to within one possession.

After another Rayder forced foul and another St. Francis miss, Stuck again grabbed the board and tossed it to Rachel Nesburg, who

drove and missed a layup, got her own rebound and passed it to Jeakle at the top of the key for a triple, knotting the game at 48-48

The Lady Gladiators then went the full length of the court and missed a layup, where Stuck was once again waiting to corral the ball, sent the outlet pass to Natalie Nesburg for a 10 second dribble attack on the right side where she drove, tossed up a soft floater and watched the ball bank in off the glass, sending the Rayder faithful and the team into a frenzy!

St. Francis would not get a shot off with the 0.7 seconds remaining on the clock.

Stuck finished with 16 points, 10 rebounds and three blocks to lead Charlevoix, while Jeakle added 11 points and three assists and Cunningham chipped in with nine points and four rebounds.

Also for the Rayders, Rachel Nesburg netted eight points, three steals and four rebounds and Natalie Nesburg

Added four points and five assists.

Charlevoix 58, TC Central 42

CHARLEVOIX -- In their first contest against Traverse City teams for the week, the Rayders took down Class A Central 58-42, behind a career-high and new school record 43 points from sophomore Elise Stuck.

Stuck also added 10 rebounds, five steals and three blocks.

The Rayders led at the quarter breaks 12-4, 26-19 and 43-23.

"TC Central's main player Margo Woughter was the main focus to stop as she has dominated play for Central," Rayder coach Liz Shaw said. "Natalie And Rachel (Nesburg) were assigned to continuously guard and double team her and held her to an uncharacteristically low 17 points. Elise Stuck dominated the offensive end and outscore the entire TC central squad."

Olivia Jeakle added five points and five rebounds for Charlevoix, while Natalie Nesburg had five assists and three steals and Rachel Nesburg had five rebounds.

Proud of how we responded in the third quarter, tying the game at 37. The guys fought and were aggressive at getting to the free throw line. Kalkaska is a tough matchup, really happy with our team effort."

Mason Gardner turned in yet another great overall performance, scoring 17 points and hauling in 12 rebounds and handling a majority of the ball handling duties.

"During halftime, we noticed we had the size advantage, that led us to change our offensive approach to get our guards to post up," Gardner said. "We started off off pretty hot by taking that advantage in the third, give a lot of props to coach Redman realizing that and adjusting us to exploit their weakness."

"The crowd was also a huge push, keeping our guys motivated."

Gardner, a modest player has stepped up his game as of late and when asked about that he responded; "I believe that I haven't changed as a player in all of my years on varsity. I'm a team first

Senior, Josh Carlson paced the Rayders with 16 points, while Cam Meuslik and Luke Stuck each added 11

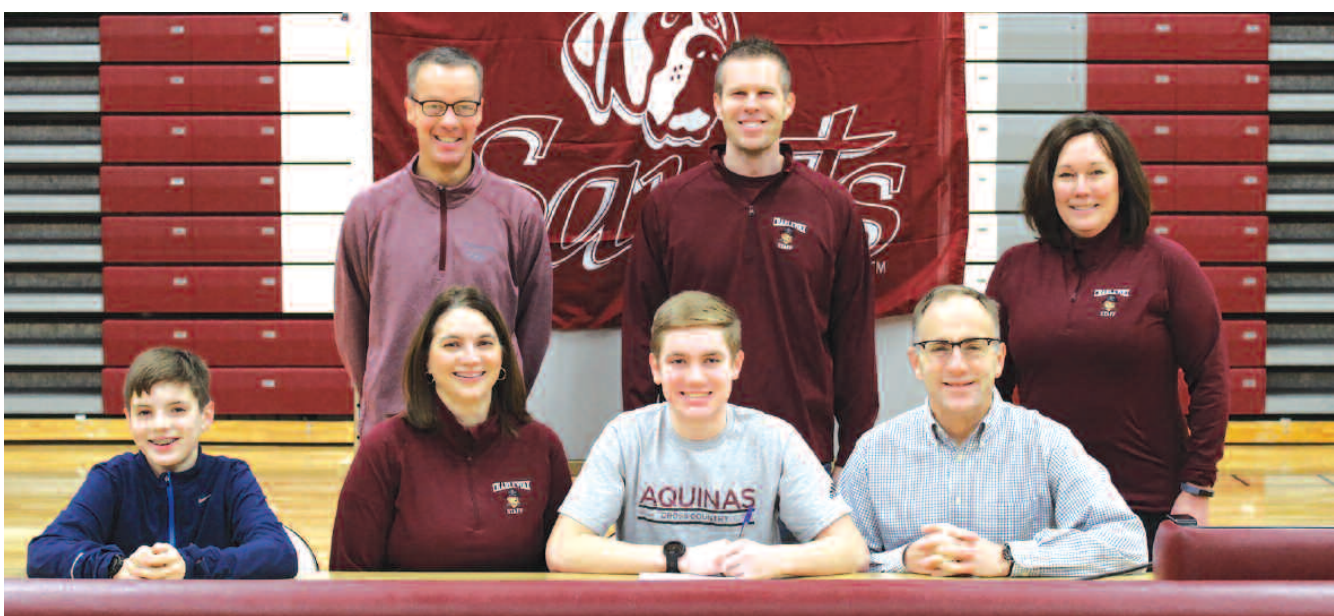

Charlevoix to Lake City 48-27 and Kalkaska 42-30, and defeated the Elks 6-3.

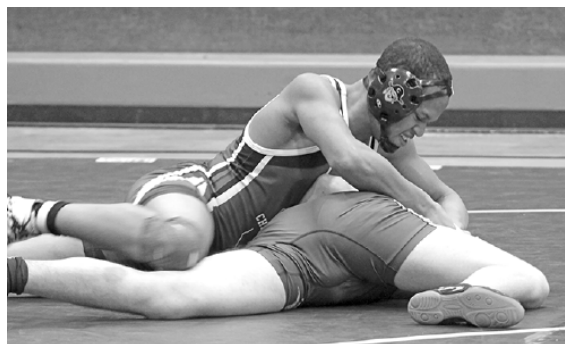

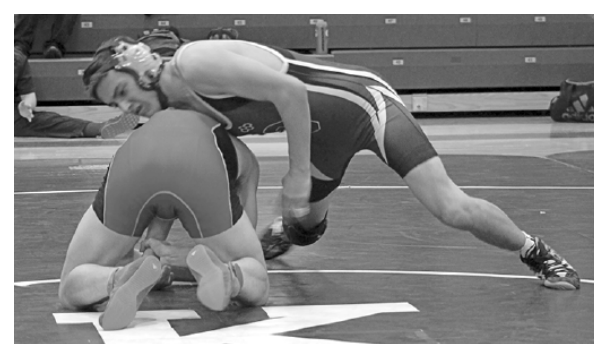
