

BOYNE CITY — In the Boyne City girls basketball team's final regular season home game this season, the team put it all together, leading from the opening tip through the final buzzer as they defeated the visiting Red Devils 47-40 on February 16 in Lake Michigan Conference play.

The win for the Ramblers, helped erase the memory of a 23 point loss to East Jordan earlier this season.

"We controlled the ball better offensively, this time, where we didn't the first time we played," Rambler coach Julie Redman said. "Defensively, we played stronger and fought through their screen better, and just played good man (defense)."

The Ramblers jumped out early, taking an 8-0 lead before cruising to an

11-5 first quarter advantage and extended that lead to 27-16 at the half.

East Jordan was able to get their shots going in the third quarter as they closed the gap to five points (36-31) as tne teams entered the fourth quarter.

"Boyne City came ready to play basketball tonight,"

"We talked alot about slowing the game down and not rush any of our plays,' Boyne senior Katie Hoth said after playing in her final regular season home game. "I expected myself to have a good game and go out with a bang, and it's exciting that the team came through and we worked together."

Hoth would finish with a team-high 13 points and grabbed four boards, Reagan May added 10 points and six rebounds and Brooklyn Fitzpatrick chipped in with nine points and nine boards.

Annika Bergquist added six steals and was credited with outstanding an defensive effort and her vocal leadership.

"As a whole, everything clicked with the team and we were able to control the game we wanted to play,' Bergquist noted. "Communication is huge in the sport of basketball and knowing that and who I am, allows me to take on that leadership

Jayden Weber finished with 13 points and 15 rebounds for East Jordan, while Kendall McNitt added eight and Abby Peterson had seven. Madeline Malpass also had four rebounds.




