Ramblers late surge comes up short

PETOSKEY 53, BOYNE CITY 45

PETOSKEY — Always up for a challenge, the Boyne City boys basketball team took on Class A and Big North Conference champion Petoskey in both teams season finale on February 27.

“Outstanding team effort, the guys really fought,” Boyne coach Nick Redman said. “Petoskey’s length gave us problems early, getting deflections and contesting shots.”

The Ramblers found themselves down by 17 with just about two minutes remaining in the third quarter, but Boyne dug deep, clamped down on defense and finally got their shots going, closing out the quarter on an 8-2 run to pull within 37-26 headed into the final quarter of regulation.

Boyne would not stop there as the fourth quarter got underway, the hard working Ramblers kept chipping away at what looked to be an insurmountable lead against a very good opponent. A Max Vondra triple from the left wing would pull the team to within three points, 37-34.

Petoskey, unable to stop the Rambler momentum, went to a spread offense as they tried to chew up some clock and eventually pushed their lead back up to seven, but back-to-back three’s from Vondra, sandwiched around a pair of Northmen free throws, would bring Boyne to within a basket, but that is as close as they would get as Petoskey closed the game out, making 7-of-8 tosses from the charity stripe and a late uncontested layup with time ticking off would give the Northmen the 53-45 win.

“The guys came out in the second half and adjusted,” Redman added. “Proud of how they fought and gave themselves a chance to win against a very good team. We got better tonight.”

The contest started slow, with both teams feeling their opponent out as Petoskey took a 9-6 advantage at the end of the first. The two teams battled neck in neck for a better part of the second quarter, but it would be an 8-0 run by the Northmen to close the half, taking a 23-15 lead at intermission.

Leading Boyne on the night was Dylon Williams with 13 points, while Vondra added 11 and Mason Gardner had 10.

Seth Mann had 19 and Danny Kolp 13 points, to pace the Northmen.

EAST JORDAN —
Talk about saving the best for last.

The East Jordan boys basketball team closed out the regular season with their second win of the year, rolling past the visiting St. Ignace Saints, 65-39 on March 1.

The Red Devils took an early 16-10 first quarter lead

and extended it to 33-25 at the half. But it was a huge third and fourth quarter, highlighted by a huge run that sent EJ home with the victory.

“Another great effort by the entire team that showed by us having 12 assists and out rebounding St. Ignace 47-25,” Red Devils coach Nate Dzwik said. “We got a stop at the end of the half that gave the kids a lot of energy and we went on a 19-0 over the last four minutes of the third quarter and first two minutes of the fourth quarter and that was due to the defensive effort of a couple of steals and easy layups, some great rebounding and great looks by Chandler Bartig

who had his best game of the year.”

Cooper Stevenson led EJ with 20 points, 12 rebounds and three blocks, while AJ Bartlett added 12, Jackson Raymond had 11 points, seven boards and three blocks.

“Another game in which we limited turnover to 14 for the game,” coach Dzwik added. “The team played with a lot of confidence after the game on Tuesday and that just rolled and expanded as the game went on. It’s exciting for the kids because they are playing well and with a ton of confidence as we head into the tournament.”

Also for East Jordan,

Ethan Zeeryp chipped in with eight points and three assists and Bartig dished out six assists.

EAST JORDAN 68, ROSCOMMON 57

ROSCOMMON — Chalk one up in the win column. That’s exactly what the Red Devils boys basketball team did for the first time this season after coming up just shy in multiple occasions.

EJ put together a complete game, limiting their turnovers to a season low, nine for the contest.

“The kids really dug down on the defensive end, they hit six three pointers in the first

half and the kids really responded at the half to focusing on the couple of shooters and getting good closeouts to them and not letting them have open shots,” coach Nate Dzwik said. “While leading most of the game I think there was a possession in which Roscommon had the ball with 1:25 left in the third quarter and the defense locked down and didn’t let them inside the three-point line and closed out to stop easy shots, they finally took a 25 foot shot and didn’t score.”

Coach Dzwik also credited the Red Devil guard play with recognizing that the team had a size advantage with Cooper Stevenson and

Ethan Zeeryp and were able to get the pair the ball in positions that gave them good looks at the basket.

“It was a great win for the kids and they were really excited, but weren’t content with how they played and found things they needed to work on,” Dzwik added.

The Red Devils led 19-17 at the end of one quarter, 37-34 at the half and entered the fourth quarter up 52-47.

Stevenson led EJ with an 18 point, 10 rebound, three assist effort, while Zeeryp added 14 and six.

Jackson Raymond finished with 12 points, and Chandler Bartig dished out a pair of assists.

STATE FINALS WRESTLING

DETROIT — On March 3, the MHSAA held their Individual Wrestling Final at Ford Field, home of the Detroit Lions.

Taking part in the event was Charlevoix's own Jeremy Chernauckas. Jeremy finished a strong career at Charlevoix High School going 1-2 in the tournament falling just short of the podium.

Chernauckas fell in his first match 3-10 against Erie Mason's Troy Reissig. In round two, Jeremy battled back to defeat Sandusky's Cody Hartz 4-3.

In the blood round he came up short to Pine River's Brock Nelson 3-7. Nelson would go on to place 3rd overall in the tournament.

"Jeremy stepped up as senior and led the team in almost every statistical category," Rayder coach Mike Hinkle said "He reached

BOYNE CITY — It was a proud moment for the Gardner family on Monday, March 5.

Boyne City senior, Mason Gardner signed his letter of intent, and will lace up his basketball shoes for another four years and take to the hardwood for Alma College.

Gardner said he always thought about playing basketball as a kid and as he matured and got older, he knew he wanted to continue that path and was quick to praise his dad, Gary.

"I give a lot of props to my dad, taking me into the high school late at night, especially during my freshman and sophomore year, just every single night coming in here," Mason said. "It's just a dream come true right now."

When asked what drew him to Alma, he responded, "Alma represents a lot of what I believe in when I look at basketball, in that it doesn't really build character, it reveals it, it really shows the kind of person you really are."

"The reason I love the program so much is they don't really care about wins or losses, they just care about if you go hard or not and if you're giving 100 percent every single time, and that's something I strongly believe in."

"I'm super happy for him, someone who's done things the right way and has the opportunity to play the game he loves for four more years, and have the opportunity to get a great education at the same time," Boyne City coach Nick Redman said. "It should be a life changing experience for him and we're all super proud of him."

"What has really separated him this year, was the way he responded and grew into a great leader for our team, and

I think that's going to carry over to the future for him, that's the beauty of sports," Redman added. "He's always been a really athletic kid and a great and a very unselfish kid. I think that leadership he learned this year will be beneficial for him down the road."

Redman also noted that he believes that Mason is only going to grow as a player at Alma.

"He's one of the kids that has been super active, a multi-sport kid, doing drama, and when he really settles in and focuses at the college level playing one sport, your going to see his skill level rise."

For his parents, seeing Mason realizing his dream was a special moment.

"It makes me very proud,

Mason has always talked about wanting to play ball at the next level, and I'm proud to see that he's able to do that," his dad Gary said. "He's done this all by himself just through his ability and the person that he is. He's always about the team and wants to work for the team and I think that's what Alma really saw in him the most, his ability to adapt and work well with others."

His mother, Mechelle didn't hesitate when asked about the opportunity Mason will receive to further his education and continue his playing days.

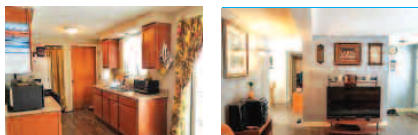
