Boyne stuns Ludington

Advances to Class B regional final

BOYNE CITY 55, LUDINGTON 44

PETOSKEY — There is definitely something about playing this time of year that brings out the best in the Boyne City boys basketball program.

The Ramblers continued their winning ways in March, this time in the Class B regional semifinal, where they knocked off Ludington, last year's runner-up to the state title.

While it wasn't an easy task to begin with, the Ramblers made it just a little tougher on themselves, going down early to the Orioles 18-4 and trailed by seven at the half.

Once the second half began, it was a totally different ball game. Boyne City turned it on, like they have so many times this year, taking their first lead since 3-0 at the 1:33 mark of the third on an Eric Carson jumper from a few feet out for a 31-30 advantage.

The next Ludington possession, Dillon Sulak would make a steal and convert the layup on the other end for a 33-30 Rambler lead and it just kept going from there.as Boyne would extend their lead to as big as 13 points.

The Orioles would attempt to comeback, but could get it no closer than seven points the rest of the

Boyne would get 15 points from Mason Gardner, while Carson, Sulak and Jacob Ager all contributed with 11 points each.

For Ager, it would be his first action of the season, after having shoulder surgery in November.

The Ramblers improve to 18-6 on the season and face off against Standish-Sterling Central on March 14. Game results were not available at press time.

Ramblers boys claim first ever Class B district crown

BOYNE CITY 76, GLADSTONE 66

GLADSTONE — The Boyne City boys basketball team seems to turn up their level of play once the MHSAA tournament rolls around, and even though they are now in Class B, nothing has changed.

On Friday, March 9, the Ramblers took the long road trip to Gladstone for the Class B district title game and when it was all said and done, Boyne would walk off the court with another piece of hardware and their fourth straight district championship as they defeated Gladstone 76-66.

With the victory, Boyne advanced to regional play at Petoskey High School on Monday, March 12.

A one point lead (18-17) by the Ramblers after the first quarter would turn into a seven point deficit at halftime as the Braves closed out the second quarter on a 7-0 run.

"We got off to great start. Max (Vondra) got us going scoring 10 points in first quarter," Boyne coach Nick Redman said. "Early foul trouble on Eric (Carson) and Mason (Gardner) hurt how we finished half ending up down."

Trailing 37-30 at the break, Boyne coach didn't have to say much during intermission to get the team ready to finish the final 16 minutes of the game.

"At half we talked about being more aggressive and giving it everything we had and winning the third quarter. the guys stepped up and did that," Redman added. "We talked about playing to win and leaving it all on the floor."

The Ramblers came out blazing hot in the third, outscoring the Braves 18-10 in the quarter to take a 48-47 advantage into the fourth. For the early part of the final eight minutes of regulation, Boyne and Gladstone went back and forth with neither team able to create any separation.

"We knew they would have trouble defending us and we also knew we would have to score to beat them," the coach noted. "After winning third quarter and leading going into fourth we believed we were going to win and just attacked them and finished strong. amazing team effort. Just an incredible team

effort against a very good team in their gym."

It would be at about the five minute mark that the Ramblers would begin to take control, going on a 10-4 run over a three minute span to pull ahead 62-55 with just over two minutes on the clock.

The final two minutes would see Boyne outscore the Braves 14-11, connecting on a few easy looks and converting from the charity stripe.

"Couldn't be more proud of how these guys fought to win first Class B district in school history, they left it all on the floor," Redman said. "Thank you to the students and community that traveled there to support us, we couldn't have done it without them."

Dillon Sulak would lead the team with a career-high 20 point effort, while Gardner added 19, Vondra finished with 15 and Dylon Williams chipped in with 10 points, including eight down the stretch.

Boyne downs Blue Devils to reach title game

BOYNE CITY — Something that has become somewhat of a trend this season is that the Boyne City boys basketball team will compete for the full 32 minutes and finish strong down the stretch.

That would be the case once again in the district semifinal as the Ramblers overcame a one point halftime deficit and turned it into a 53-38 victory over Sault Ste. Marie on March 7.


"The only thing we wrote on the board at halftime was 'Mental Toughness'," Boyne coach Nick Redman said. "We talked about how that could either make you or break, and in the first half it was breaking us. The kids responded wall."

The effort in the second half was was led by some big shots from Max Vondra as the Rambler sophomore knocked down a trio of triples during Boyne's fourth quarter run that saw them start to pull away.

After a slow start to the game, which saw the Blue Devils take a 6-5 opening quarter lead, Sault Ste. Marie extended that advantage to 19-18 entering the half behind the efforts of their star, Brandon Paul.

A back and forth third quarter would close with a Rambler flurry as Boyne reeled off six of the last seven points to pull ahead 32-29 entering the final eight minutes of play.

Boyne would continue to clamp down on defense in the fourth and got things rolling offensively as







FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019 PROPOSED BUDGET CITY COMMISSION MEETING MAY 1, 2018

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS OF THE CITY, AND SETTING FORTH THE AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED TO DEFRAY THE EXPENDITURES AND SETTING FORTH A STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REVENUES BY SOURCE IN EACH FUND; TO ADOPT THE CITY'S BUDGETS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019; TO ADOPT THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR PUBLIC RECORDS AND SERVICES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019; AND TO ADOPT WATER AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL RATES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019.


