Results of elk and bear hunt drawings available

If you applied for a bear or elk license during the May 1-June 1 application period, you can now view your results.

Check hunt drawing results online or call a DNR Customer Service Center or 517-284-WILD to find out if you were successful. If you used a DNR Sportcard to apply, please call us at 517-284-WILD to get your results.

More than 7,100 bear licenses and 200 elk licenses were available for the 2018 fall hunting seasons.

There are 203 leftover licenses remaining for the Bergland third-period bear hunt, available to Michigan residents only. Points will be reset to zero for those who buy a leftover bear license, except for comprehensive lifetime license holders. Leftover licenses will be sold as follows:

July 9, 10 a.m.: Comprehensive lifetime license holders who were not selected for a license can get a free leftover license.

July 16, 10 a.m.: Unsuccessful ap-

plicants can purchase a leftover license.

July 23, 10 a.m.: Any remaining licenses will be available to the general public.

Successful applicants can transfer or donate their drawing success to an unsuccessful youth applicant or any person with an advanced illness. Transfer forms and additional information are available at michigan.gov/hunttransfers. Unsuccessful youth applicants and those with an advanced illness can

register for a donated (transferred) bear or elk hunt through the same webpage until July 10.

Additional drawing statistics can be found at michigan.gov/elk and michigan.gov/bear.

If you weren't successful in the drawing, you can still apply for the Pure Michigan Hunt for chances at 2019 hunting licenses, including bear and elk – for \$5 each chance. Learn more at michigan.gov/pmh.

Fish survey this summer at Pictured Rocks

Visitors this summer to the Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore, on the south shore of Lake Superior, might see DNR staff surveying a number of waterbodies in the area. It's all part of an effort to better understand what kind of fish make their home in these waters.

"Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore welcomes more than 1.5 million visitors every year, and many of those folks have questions about fish locally," said Cory Kovacs, DNR fisheries biologist out of the DNR's Newberry office. "We started sampling in 2017, and that information is important in helping us inform the public about what's here, as well as in making decisions about managing those fish populations."

In 2017, staff sampled Chapel Creek, Hurricane River, Miner's

River, Rhody Creek, Towes Creek and Mosquito River. This year, they'll head to Grand Sable Lake, Chapel Lake, Beaver Lake, Seven-mile Creek and Lowney Creek. Crews will use netting gear in lakes and electrofishing gear in streams. Visitors should use caution if encountering those crews on the water.

Additionally, the DNR has always worked with the National Park Service to sample water and take stream water temperatures, and will do that again this year, too. Five streams were selected for temperature monitoring in 2018.

Muskegon Angler gets record Black Buffalo

OTTAWA COUNTY – The Department of Natural Resources confirmed the catch of a new state record black buffalo on June 12.

The fish, a member of the sucker family, was caught by Brandonn Kramer of Muskegon at 11:30 p.m. on Friday, May 25, on the Grand River in Ottawa County. Assistance was provided by Kramer's friend and fishing cohort, Shawn Grawbarger also of Muskegon. The fish weighed 46.54 pounds and measured 39.75 inches. Kramer was bowfishing when he landed the record fish.

The record was verified by Jay Wesley, a DNR fisheries manager for Lake Michigan.

The previous state record black buffalo was caught by Sage Colegrove of Muskegon on the Grand River in Ottawa County on April 12, 2015. That fish weighed 44.54 pounds and measured 38.5 inches.

State records in Michigan are recognized by weight only. To qualify for a state record, fish must exceed the current listed state record weight and identification must be verified by a DNR fisheries biologist.

DNR: Your actions can affect bear movement

It's pretty impressive to think a black bear can find a meal about anywhere in the forest – food is not the limiting factor for bear locations.

"Bear, like other wildlife, are smart and make finding food their job," said Michigan Department of Natural Resources bear specialist Kevin Swanson. "If they come across an easy and reliable meal like a bird feeder, they will take advantage of it and will likely return for more."

Bear are omnivores, meaning they eat both plants and meat, with the majority of their consumption being roots, berries, nuts, and insects and their larvae.

Bear can be found in more than half of Michigan, with an estimated population of over 12,000 adult bear (2,000 in the northern Lower Peninsula and 10,000 in the Upper Peninsula).

"Bears that are fed typically lose their natural fear of humans and can become a threat to people's safety," added Swanson. "In some cases, bears may even have to be euthanized."

Reliable, calorie-rich food sources, such as bird feeders, can draw bears from their natural habitat. You can help your neighborhood and community by removing bird feeders and other attractants. Garbage cans, dumpsters, barbecue grills, restaurant grease bins and bee hives also can attract bears to an area that people frequent.

For your safety, NEVER intentionally feed a bear – it is in your, as well as your neighbors' and the bear's, best interest. It is critical that bear retain their natural fear of humans.

Bear numbers and their locations are controlled through regulated hunting. Michigan's bear hunting season has multiple opening dates that vary based on the location. For most locations, you must enter an application process to receive a bear license. Learn more about the bear preference point system.

Wanted: Sightings of state's largest trees this summer

Whether you're out in the woods or skateboarding through city streetscapes this summer, keep your eyes open – you may spot one of Michigan's largest trees!

The 14th Big Tree Hunt runs through Sept. 3, 2019. Started by ReLeaf Michigan in 1993, it takes place every two years and helps catalog the state's biggest trees. Your assignment: Seek out the most majestic trees in your area and report

them, because tree-spotters can earn certificates and prizes.

"This is a really fun reason to get out and enjoy nature," said Melinda Jones, executive director of ReLeaf Michigan. "It also helps raise awareness and enjoyment of the trees in our landscape."

The Big Tree Hunt is one way to discover candidates for the National Register of Big Trees, which so far includes 19 Michigan trees.

The biggest tree spotted on the last hunt is a sycamore in Lenawee County with a 315-inch girth.

ReLeaf Michigan is a nonprofit that encourages planting trees. Additional Big Tree Hunt sponsors include the DNR, the Arboriculture Society of Michigan, the Consumers Energy Foundation, the DTE Energy Foundation and the Michigan Botanical Club. Learn more about the DNR's Urban and

DNR FISHING TIP

How to catch your own nightcrawlers

Are you interested in catching and keeping your own nightcrawlers? It's fairly easy to do so, just follow these simple steps.

1. Know where to look. Scout areas (such as parks, playgrounds, open grassy areas) after a good rain. Look for nightcrawler castings (the little piles of dirt they leave behind) and then plan a visit following the next good rain.

2. Know when to collect. Nightcrawlers are best caught an hour or so after dark.

3. Bring the right equipment. Nightcrawlers are sensitive to vibrations so wear light-weight shoes. They're also sensitive to bright light so consider rigging your flashlight with a red cover over the lens.

4. Store them properly. Upon catching, just lay them on top of some storage bedding — don't mix them in. This will allow you to remove sick or dead nightcrawlers more easily.
